Subject: September 2020 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of September 2020. In September 2020, there were 19 Part I offenses and 327 Part II / III offenses, for a total of 316. This compares with 24 Part I offenses and 424 Part II / III offenses for a total of 488 in September 2019.

Aggravated Assault: an assault offense occurred involving an adult male discharging a firearm inside a vehicle. The projectile struck a female passenger of the vehicle. Assault 2nd degree charges are being sought. The assault occurred between two subjects known to each other.

Robbery: There was one robbery in the city during September. A man was attacked by other men on a parking lot in the 8900 block of Watson Road. The man's property was stolen at that time. The victim most likely knew the persons who robbed him. No apparent injuries to the victims, detectives are investigating.


Burglary: A resident of Westhaven had suspects enter his garage where property was stolen. Detectives are investigating these offenses.

Property damage: There were five property damage offenses that occurred during September, most of these involved parked motor vehicles and one mailbox.

Stolen vehicle: There was one stolen vehicle from a business on Watson Road, it was recovered a short time later by police.

Stealing offenses numbered ten in September 2020.

Part I offenses numbered 19 in September 2020.

Part II / III offenses:

In September 2020, there were three fraud offenses involving forgery and internet scams. There were seven traffic accidents, five animal calls and one juvenile offense handled by police. There were two family offenses investigated. There were 86 people related calls addressed. Police investigated twenty one suspicious activity reports. There were 172 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II / III offenses totaled 297 in September 2020.

Ward Incident Summary:

In September 2020 in Ward One, there were three stealing events that occurred at businesses along Watson Road and Liggett Drive and Madeira Drive. There were two property damage offenses on Coffey and Liggett Drive involving damage to parked vehicles. There was one fraud offense involving an internet scam on Madeira Drive. There were two traffic accidents and three animal related calls. Police handled twenty-five people related calls and one family offense call. There was one juvenile offense and eight suspicious activity calls that occurred on five different streets. There were 38 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 84 calls for service in Ward one in September 2020.

In September 2020 in Ward Two, there were four stealing events that occurred at addresses on Watson Road and on Big Bend Blvd. One property damage offense involving a mailbox occurred on Rayburn Avenue. One fraud offense was reported on Lodge Drive in reference to an attempt to access a resident's bank account. There were four traffic accidents and one animal related call. There were twenty-five people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on four different streets. There were 52 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 95 calls for service in Ward two in September 2020.



In September 2020 in Ward Three, there was one robbery at a business on Watson Road. A man was attacked by other men on a parking lot in the 8900 block of Watson Road. The man's property was stolen at that time. The victim most likely knew the persons who robbed him. No apparent injuries to the victims, detectives are investigating. There was one stealing event that occurred on Flamingo Drive. There was one motor vehicle theft that at a business on Watson Road, it was recovered a short time later by police. One fraud offense occurred to a resident on Trillium Drive in reference to identity theft. The police responded to twenty-one people related calls. There were six suspicious activity calls that occurred on three different streets. There were 50 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 81 calls for service in Ward three in September 2020.

In September 2020 in Ward Four, an assault offense occurred involving an adult male discharging a firearm inside a vehicle. The projectile struck a female passenger of this vehicle. Assault 2nd degree charges are being sought. The assault occurred between two subjects known to each other. There was one burglary that occurred on Westhaven Court after a garage door was left open, suspects entered the garage and stole property from within. There were two stealing offenses reported from Watson Woods and Westhaven Court. There were two property damages reported on Crest Oak and Red Oak Drive involving damage to a mailbox and damage inside a residence. There was one traffic accident, fifteen people related calls and one animal related call handled during the period. There were two juvenile offenses, and one family offense investigated by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered one. There were 32 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 56 calls for service in Ward four in September 2020.





Arrest Information:

The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:



Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:




Activity Comparison:
