Subject: May 2021 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of May 2021. In May 2021, there were 22 Part I offenses and 396 Part II offenses / incidents, for a total of 418. This compares with 14 Part I offenses and 363 Part II offenses / incidents for a total of 377 in May 2020.

There was one vehicle stolen during the month involving a person not returning a vehicle they had possession of.

There was seven property damage offense involving damage to vehicles and mailboxes in residential areas.

Stealing offenses numbered 15 in May 2021.

Part I offenses numbered 22 in May 2021.

Part II offenses / Police activity:

In May 2021, there was two minor assault offense reported involving persons known to each other. Fraud offenses numbered two involving identity theft and two involving stolen credit card usage. There were seven drug related offenses. There were three DWI arrests made. There were nineteen traffic accidents, three animal calls and six juvenile offense handled by police. There were 85 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 47 suspicious activity reports and two family offenses. There were 218 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II offenses / Police activity totaled 396 in May 2021.

Ward Incident Summary:

In May 2021 in Ward One, there were six stealing events that occurred at locations on Ayres Drive and Paddock Court. There was one motor vehicle theft that involved a subject that refused to return a leased vehicle. There was one fraud offense that occurred at a bank along Watson Road involving a scam transaction. There were five subjects arrested after traffic stops along Watson Road that were in possession of controlled substances. There were six traffic accidents and one animal related call handled by police. Police responded to thirteen people related calls and nineteen suspicious activity calls which occurred on fourteen different streets. Police investigated two juvenile offenses. There were 45 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 99 calls for service in Ward one in May 2021.

In May 2021 in Ward Two, there were three stealing events that occurred at addresses on Watson Road and Ewers Drive.

There was four property damage offense that occurred at addresses on Starling Drive, Crestwood Drive and Tahiti Drive involving damage to vehicles and mailboxes. There were two assaults that occurred on Big Bend Blvd and Pinellas Drive involving persons known to each other with minor injuries reported. There was one fraud offense reported on Fox Park Drive involving identity theft. There was one subject arrested for possession of a controlled substance after a traffic stop along Big Bend Blvd. There was one driving while intoxicated arrest made on Watson Road. There were five traffic accidents and one animal call investigated. There were twenty-six people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered fourteen and occurred on eleven different streets. There was one juvenile offense investigated. There were 83 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 142 calls for service in Ward two in May 2021.

In May 2021 in Ward Three, there were three stealing events that occurred on Pennant Lane and Royal Arm Court. There was one property damage offense that occurred on Robert Deves Drive involving damage to a mailbox. There were two fraud offenses that occurred at a gas station on Watson Road involving credit cards. There was one drug offense on Watson Road, subject issued summons for being in possession of a controlled substance. There was one intoxicated driver arrested on Watson Road.


Five traffic accidents and one animal call were handled by police. The police responded to 30 people related calls and one juvenile offense. There were seven suspicious activity calls that occurred on six different streets. There were 36 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 88 calls for service in Ward three in May 2021.

In May 2021 in Ward Four, There were stealing offenses that occurred on Sky Crest Drive, Crest Oak Drive and Tea Rose Lane. There was one property damage offense that occurred on Lindenhurst Drive involving eggs thrown at the residence. One driving while intoxicated arrest was made on Sappington Road. There were three traffic accidents and two juvenile offenses investigated. Police responded to sixteen people related calls and two family offenses. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on six different streets. There were 54 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 89 calls for service in Ward four in May 2021.









May 2021**





**Gender of Adults Arrested-
May 2021**





Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:




Activity Comparison:
