Subject: June 2021 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of June 2021. In June 2021, there were 26 Part I offenses and 379 Part II offenses / incidents, for a total of 405. This compares with 21 Part I offenses and 379 Part II offenses / incidents for a total of 400 in June 2020.

There was one robbery during the month of June that occurred at a gas station along Watson Road. A male subject came into the store and handed the clerk a note demanding money, he left the store and short time later he was apprehended by our officers.


There were two business burglaries that occurred on Watson Road, one being an attempted burglary. The other was a residential burglary that occurred at a vacant home under construction.

There were two vehicles stolen during the month both were recovered at a later date in other jurisdictions.

There was one property damage offense involving overnight damage to a vehicle on Ferndale Drive.

Stealing offenses numbered nineteen in June 2021.

Part I offenses numbered 26 in June 2021.

Part II offenses / Police activity:

In June 2021, there were five minor assaults reported all involving persons known to each other. Fraud offenses numbered two involving identity theft and two involving stolen credit card usage. There were two drug related offenses. There were two DWI arrests made. There were eighteen traffic accidents, fourteen animal calls and four juvenile offense handled by police. There were 102 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 28 suspicious activity reports and there were 199 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period. One weapons offense occurred in the city during the month.

Part II offenses / Police activity totaled 379 in June 2021.

Ward Incident Summary:

In June 2021 in Ward One, there was one burglary that occurred overnight at a business on Watson Road. There were four stealing events that occurred at locations on Watson Road and Big Bend. There were two drug related offenses both along Watson Road.

There were five subjects arrested after traffic stops along Watson Road that were in possession of controlled substances. One DWI arrest occurred during a traffic stop in the 9500 block of Watson Road. There were two traffic accidents and five animal related call handled by police. Police responded to twenty one people related calls and seven suspicious activity calls which occurred on seven different streets. There were 37 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 83 calls for service in Ward one in June 2021.

In June 2021 in Ward Two, there was one attempted burglary that occurred on Watson Road. There were ten stealing events that occurred at addresses on Watson Road, Big Bend, Sturdy Drive, Crestwood Drive, Twincrest Drive, Joann Place, and Sappington Road. There was one motor vehicle theft that occurred on Watson Road. There were three assaults that occurred on Apex Drive and Fox Creek Court involving persons known to each other with minor injuries reported. There were three fraud offenses reported one was an internet scam and the other two were fraudulent credit card use. There were eight traffic accidents and five animal calls investigated. There were twenty two people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on nine different streets. There were 90 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 153 calls for service in Ward two in June 2021.



In June 2021 in Ward Three, there was one overnight burglary that occurred at a home under construction on Ulysses Court. There were three stealing events that occurred on Desmond Drive and Watson Road. There was one motor vehicle theft that occurred at a business on Watson Road. There was one intoxicated driver arrested on Grant Road. Four traffic accidents and three animal calls were handled by police. The police responded to 33 people related calls and four juvenile offenses. There were nine suspicious activity calls that occurred on four different streets. There were 41 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 102 calls for service in Ward three in June 2021.

In June 2021 in Ward Four, There were two stealing offenses that occurred on Belmar Court and Meadowfern Drive. There was one fraud that occurred involving online credit card fraud. There were four traffic accidents and one animal related call investigated. Police responded to twenty six people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and occurred on two different streets. There were 31 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 67 calls for service in Ward four in June 2021.






Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:
