Subject: October 2021 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of October 2021. In October 2021, there were 23 Part I offenses and 458 Part II offenses / incidents, for a total of 481. This compares with 22 Part I offenses and 296 Part II offenses / incidents for a total of 318 in October 2020.

During the month there was one robbery and four burglary offenses reported. The robbery occurred at a business on Big Bend. The burglaries occurred on Watson Rd, Pardee Lane and Mary Glen Dr. Three were business burglaries involving property damage and the last was a residential burglary where a subject entered through an unlocked door. There were six property damage offenses for the month of October. Four of the property damage offenses were windows being broken out of businesses. One was reported as damage to a mailbox, and the sixth property damage was eggs being thrown at parked vehicles.

Stealing offenses numbered eleven in October 2021.

Part II offenses / Police activity:

In October 2021, there were two minor assaults one occurred at a business on Watson Rd and the other on Briarton Dr. Fraud offenses numbered three, two involving online identity theft, and one involving a fraudulent check. There were two drug offenses that occurred following traffic stops and there was five DWI arrests made. There were eleven traffic accidents, 14 animal calls and four juvenile offenses handled by police. There were 121 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 80 suspicious activity incidents and there were 216 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II offenses / Police activity totaled 458 in October 2021.

Ward Incident Summary:

In September 2021 in Ward 1, there were two burglaries one involved a business on Watson Rd another involving a maintenance room in Forstview Apartments. There were four stealing offenses that occurred in Ward 1 including one catalytic converter theft, one stolen license tab, and two shopliftings that occurred at businesses along Watson Road. There were five reports of property damage in Ward 1 during the month of October. The property damage was reported as windows broken out of businesses, damage to a mailbox and eggs being thrown at parked vehicles. There was one motor vehicle theft that occurred on Clover Lane where vehicle was later recovered in another jurisdiction. There was one fraud occurrence along with one drug offense and one DWI. One traffic accident occurred along with officers responding to 21 suspicious activity calls on eight different streets. There were also three animal related calls, two juvenile offenses, 24 people related calls, and 55 miscellaneous police calls reported during the month. Police handled 121 calls for service in Ward 1 in October 2021.

In October 2021 in Ward 2, there was one robbery that occurred at a business on Big Bend Blvd. It was reported that a subject entered the business took a large amount of merchandise from the store, assaulted an employee and left the area. There were four stealing offenses that occurred on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd and Greenview Dr. There was one assault that occurred on Briarton Dr and one fraud offense involving a fraudulent check for a large sum of money being deposited into an account. Officers arrested an individual for a DWI on Big Bend Blvd. Two traffic accidents occurred on Watson Rd and I-44. There were 29 suspicious activity calls responded to on twelve different streets in Ward 2. There were also two animal related calls, 40 people related calls, one juvenile offense, and 101 miscellaneous police calls reported during the month.



Police handled 183 calls for service in Ward 2 in October 2021.

In October 2021 in Ward 3, there were two burglaries reported. One of the burglaries occurred at a business on Watson Rd and the other was the burglary of an unoccupied residence on Pardee Ln. There were three stealing offenses that occurred on Heather Dr and Watson Rd. One property damage report was taken for eggs being thrown at parked vehicles. One assault occurred at a business on Watson Rd and one fraud offense was reported involving identity theft. There was one DWI arrest made and there were five

traffic accidents that occurred on Watson Road, Pardee Road and General Grant Lane. Officers responded to thirteen calls for suspicious activity on seven different streets. There was also five animal related calls, one juvenile offense, 36 people related calls and 33 miscellaneous police calls during the month. Police handled 102 calls for service in Ward 3 in October 2021.

In October 2021 in Ward 4, there were was one drug offense that occurred on Crestwood Executive Center Dr and two DWI arrests. There were three traffic accidents that occurred in Ward 4 on Sappington Rd and Hartsdale Dr. Officers responded to 17 calls for suspicious activity on 15 different streets along with four animal related calls. There were 21 people related calls, and 27 miscellaneous police calls. Police handled 75 calls for service in Ward 4 in October 2021.


CAD Activity by Ward and Sector:













The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:




**Gender of Adults Arrested--
October 2021**





Incidents by Day of Week--October 2021




Incidents by Hour of Day--October 2021
