

Detective Bureau Performance:

In July, 61 supplemental reports and 5 original reports were written and 3 physical arrests were made. 2 cases were *Cleared by Arrest*, 6 were *Cleared Exceptionally*, 1 was cleared by other means, and 12 were inactivated. A total of 19 cases are still marked *Active*. Not counting those that are still *Active*, the clearance rate for the bureau up to and including July was **48.2%** percent. That percentage is slightly down from 50.5% in June.



In the nation, in 2019, 45.5 % of violent crimes and 17.2 % of property crimes were cleared by arrest or exceptional means according to the Criminal Justice Information Services Division.

Ward Incident Summary:



Ward 1:

In July 2022, four stealing offenses and one property damage offense that was reported as damage to a vehicle occurred in Ward 1. One burglary was reported along with two motor vehicle thefts that occurred on Grant Ridge Ln and Conover Dr. There was one minor assault that occurred inside Forestview Apartments and two fraud reports were taken for an online scam when trying to purchase a vehicle on Facebook and fraudulent use of a credit card. There were two traffic accidents that occurred on Watson Rd and officers responded to 33 calls for suspicious activity on 16 different streets. There were also 4 animal related calls, 27 people related calls, and 74 miscellaneous police calls reported.

Police handled 151 calls for service in Ward 1 in July 2022.

Ward 2:

In July 2022, there was one burglary reported at a business on Watson Rd and there were four stealing offenses reported. There was 1 property damage report taken for damage to outdoor landscaping. Three fraud reports were taken for fraudulent use of credit cards. Police responded to 9 traffic accidents that occurred on Big Bend Blvd, I-44, Detjen Dr, Leawood Dr, Liggett Ave, Sappington Rd and Watson Rd. There were 46 suspicious activity calls responded to on 14 different streets in Ward 2, along with 4 animal related calls, 33 people related calls and 102 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 203 calls for service in Ward 2 in July 2022.

Ward 3:

In July 2022 there were four stealing reports taken and one motor vehicle theft was reported on Watson Rd. Police responded to three traffic accidents on General Grant Ln, Watson Rd, and Whitecliff Ln. There were 18 calls for suspicious activity on 8 different streets, and 3 animal related calls. One juvenile offense was also reported along with 34 people related calls and 50 miscellaneous police calls in Ward 3.

Police handled 114 calls for service in Ward 3 in July 2022.

Ward 4:

In July 2022 officers responded to three traffic accidents on Crestwood Executive Center Dr, East Watson Rd, and Laurel Hill Dr. We received 12 calls for suspicious activity on 9 different streets, 28 people related calls, 2 animal related calls, and 34 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 79 calls for service in Ward 4 in July 2022.
