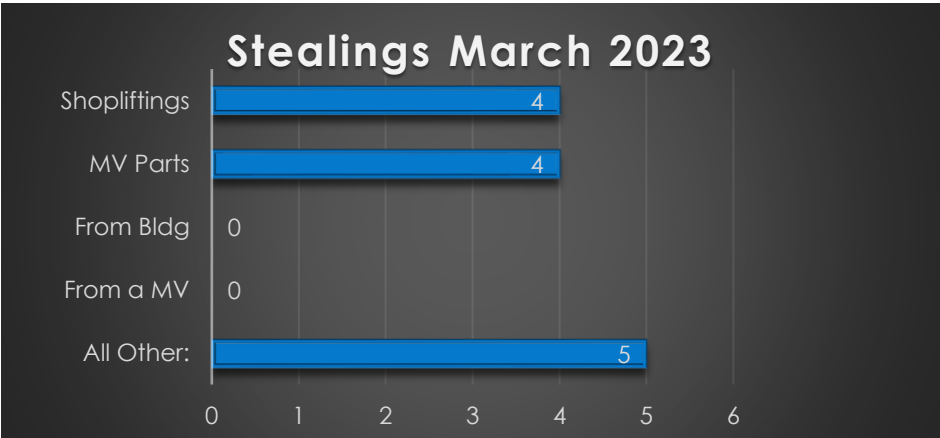
Calls for Service Breakdown:

Calls are broken down by day of the week and hour of the day.



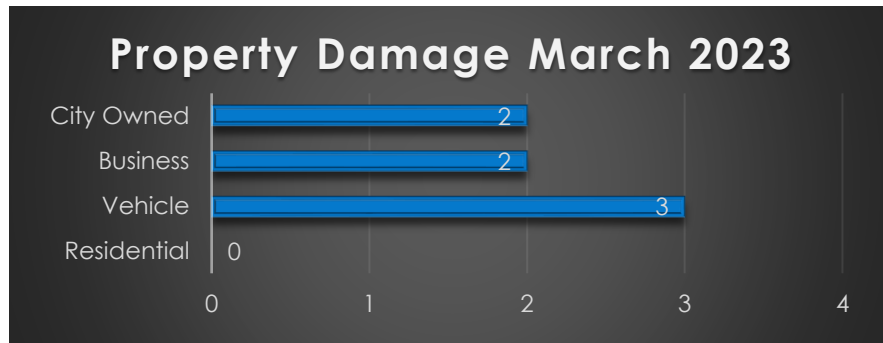
Stealing:

Property Damage:

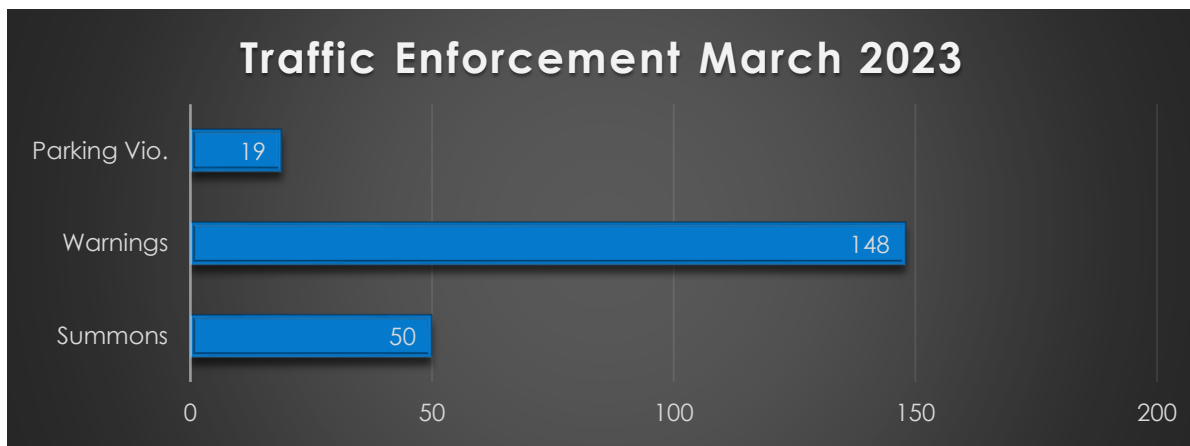
There were 7 Property Damage offenses during the month of March 2023. They are broken down into the following categories.



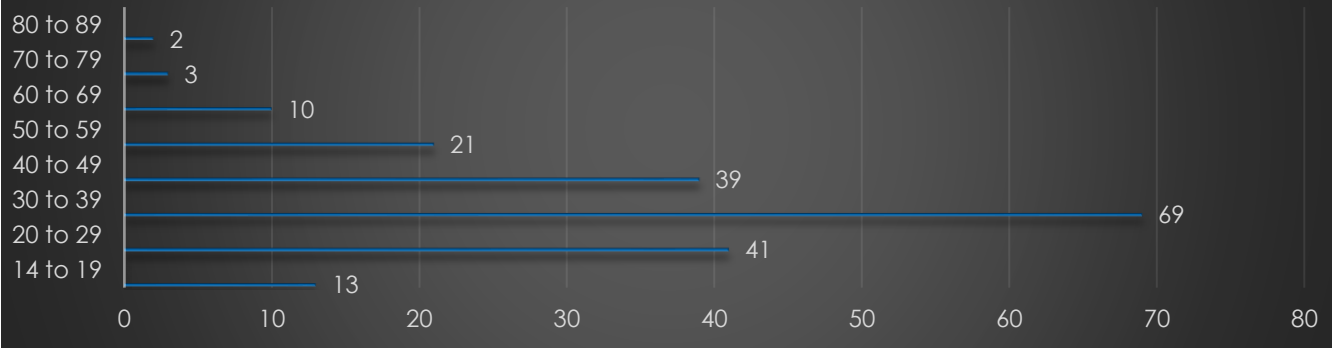
Traffic Enforcement:

Violators by Age March 2023



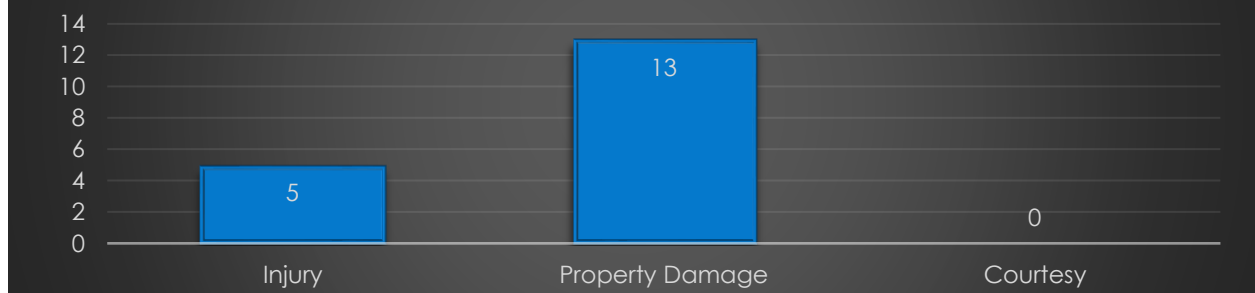

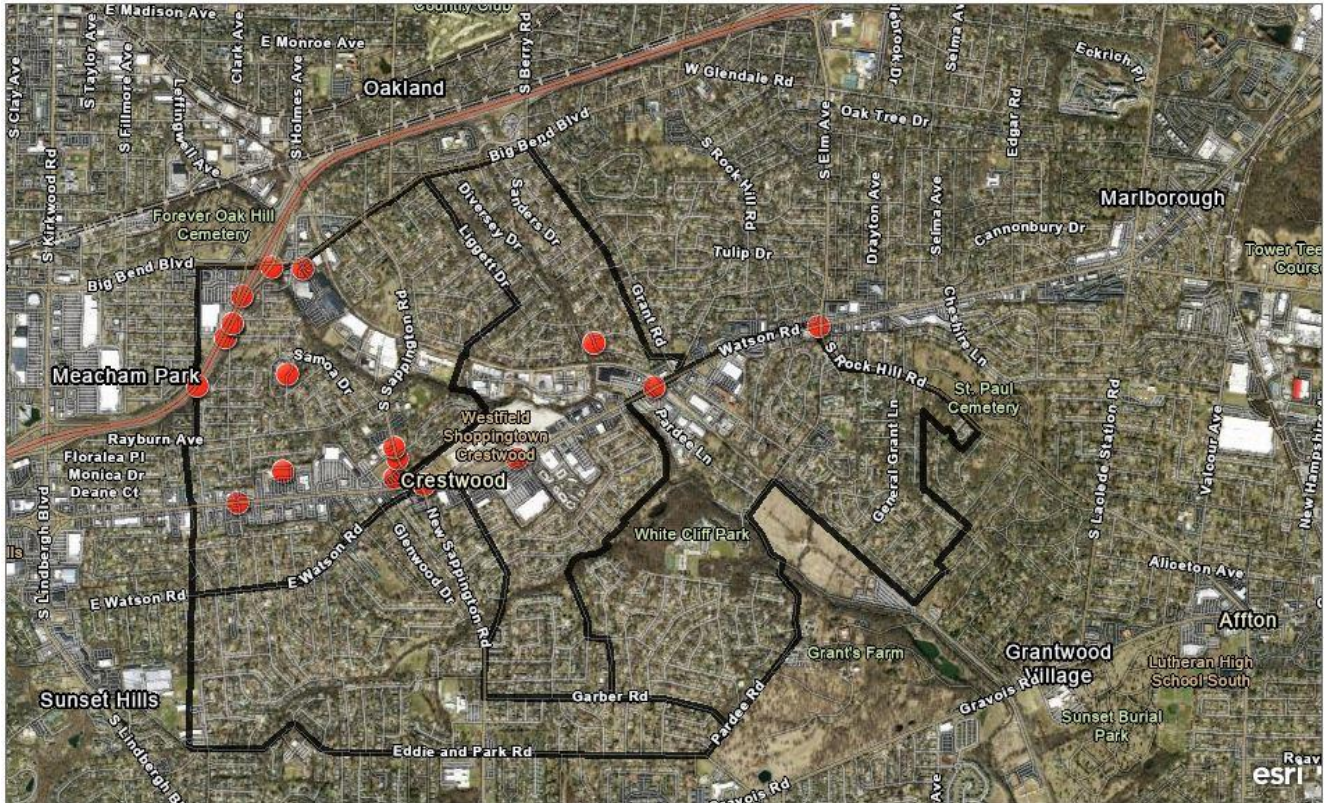

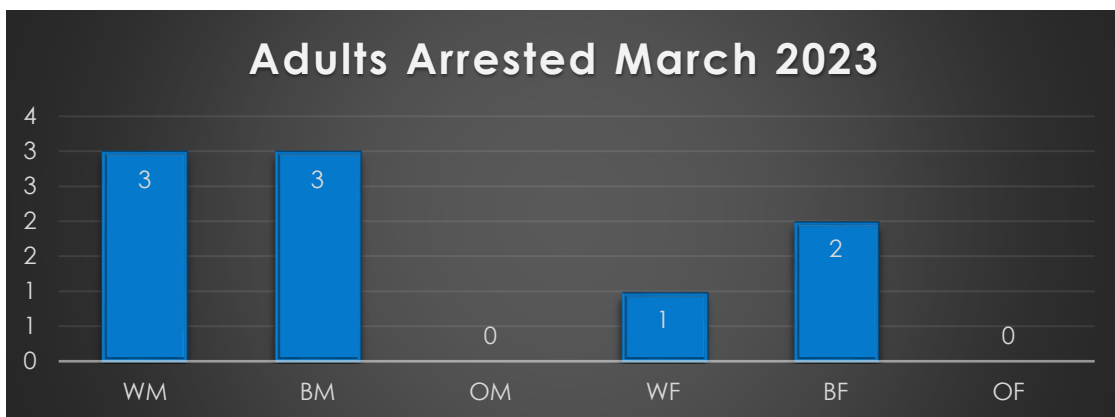

Detective Bureau Performance:

As of March 2023, a total of 27 cases are still marked *Active*. Not counting those that are still *Active*, the clearance rate for the bureau in March was **64.1%**, which is slightly down from 69.6% in February. That percentage has begun to normalize after clearing cases from 2022 in January and February of 2023. The below charts reflect the work of the Detective Bureau YTD.
