NIBRS Crime Overview

Crestwood Police Department submits all crimes reported to the FBI's National Incident-Based Reporting System or NIBRS. This has become the standard for law enforcement crime data reporting in the United States. NIBRS captures details on each single crime incident—as well as on separate offenses within the same incident—including information on victims, known offenders, relationships between victims and offenders, arrestees, and property involved in crimes. The broad scope of the information collected in NIBRS provides greater specificity in reporting offenses, collects detailed information, helps give context to specific crime problems and provides greater analytic flexibility. Below is the NIBRS data for the Crestwood Police Department from the First Quarter of 2025.



As of the end of First Quarter 2025, a total of 14 cases are still marked *Active*. Not counting those that are still *Active*, the clearance rate for the bureau at the end of March was 74.4%, which is up from 63.4% at the end of first Quarter 2024, and up from the previous quarter at 65.8%.
