City of Crestwood to Celebrate First Prop A Project with Ribbon Cutting at Crestwood Park

CRESTWOOD, MO – The City of Crestwood will host a ceremonial ribbon cutting **9 a.m. Tuesday, May 6**, to celebrate the completion and opening of two new playgrounds at **Crestwood Park, 9700 Meadowfern Drive**. The event marks a major milestone in the implementation of Prop A, the City's \$33 million bond initiative approved by voters in 2023.

The community and media are invited to join the celebration, which will include remarks from City officials, as well as representation from the Crestwood Park Board and Long Elementary School. Students from Long Elementary will also be in attendance, as they played a key role in the playground planning process by helping select the final design.

Crestwood Park's new playgrounds are part of Prop A, which also includes:

- Construction of a new community center at Whitecliff Park (groundbreaking ceremony to be held Friday, May 23)
- Transformation of the existing community center into a pickleball and family games complex
- A nature playscape and walking trail loop at Whitecliff Park
- A pedestrian bridge connecting Whitecliff Park to the Lodgepole neighborhood
