Crestwood to Break Ground on New \$21.3 Million Community Center May 23

CRESTWOOD, MO – The City of Crestwood will mark a major Proposition A milestone with a groundbreaking ceremony for the new \$21.3 million Community Center at 4 p.m. Friday, May 23, at the future site of the facility—on the field directly across from the existing Community Center in Whitecliff Park, 9245 Whitecliff Pk Ln.

The new Community Center is the largest project funded by Proposition A, a voter-approved \$33 million bond issue dedicated to enhancing parks and recreation amenities throughout Crestwood. The new facility will serve as a modern, multipurpose space for residents of all ages and interests.

Project Timeline and Key Features

Construction will begin in the weeks following the groundbreaking and is expected to take 18 to 24 months. Planned features of the new Center include:

- A larger multi-use gymnasium
- An elevated indoor walking/jogging track
- Event and meeting spaces with a fireplace and outdoor balcony
- A larger fitness area with expanded and improved equipment
- Dedicated spaces for dance, yoga, cardio, and other wellness programs

Splashtacular Summer Kickoff to Follow

Immediately following the ceremony, the City will host its annual Splashtacular Summer Kickoff from 5 to 8 p.m. at the Crestwood Aquatic Center, located just across the parking lot from the Community Center site. The family-friendly event features free pool access, a live DJ, food trucks, games, and activities for all ages.
