NIBRS Crime Overview

Crestwood Police Department submits all crimes reported to the FBI's National Incident-Based Reporting System or NIBRS. This has become the standard for law enforcement crime data reporting in the United States. NIBRS captures details on each single crime incident—as well as on separate offenses within the same incident—including information on victims, known offenders, relationships between victims and offenders, arrestees, and property involved in crimes. The broad scope of the information collected in NIBRS provides greater specificity in reporting offenses, collects detailed information, helps give context to specific crime problems and provides greater analytic flexibility. Below is the NIBRS data for the Crestwood Police Department from the Fourth Quarter and YTD total for 2025.


