Subject: January 2020 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of January 2020. In January 2020, there were 31 Part I offenses and 333 Part II / III offenses, for a total of 364. This compares with 22 Part I offenses and 324 Part II / III offenses for a total of 346 in January 2019.

Robbery: There was one robbery that occurred at a gas station on Big Bend Blvd, a shoplifter assaulted a store employee while stealing 12 bottles of liquor.


There were three burglaries. One occurred on Watson Rd. involving a burglary of a vacant business. Another occurred on East Watson Rd. involving a Church where electronics items were stolen. An address on Montego Dr. had multiple items stolen from the residence totaling \$520.

Property damage: There was one property damage offense reported on Fieldcrest Dr. as someone damaged a large glass door with a piece of wood.

Attempt stolen vehicle: Someone attempted to steal a vehicle on Rayburn Ave. by breaking a window and damaging the ignition. Another vehicle was entered on Chatwood Ter. with nothing apparently taken.

Stealing offenses numbered twenty-six in January 2020.



Part I offenses numbered 31 in January 2020.

Part II / III offenses:

In January 2020, there were three fraud offenses involving identity theft and bad checks. There was one sex offense reported that after investigation was found to have occurred outside of the city. There were sixteen traffic accidents and four animal calls handled by police. There were 107 people related calls investigated. Police addressed 31 suspicious activities reports. There were 171 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II / III offenses totaled 333 in January 2020.

Ward Incident Summary:

In January 2020 in Ward One, there were 4 stealings that occurred at on Watson Road and Diversey Dr. There was one property damage offense that occurred on Fieldcrest Dr. where someone damage a resident's glass door. There was one fraud offense at a bank on Watson Rd. where a male and female suspect passed a check for over \$1,000. There were six traffic accidents and nineteen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on five different streets. There were 45 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 85 calls for service in Ward one in January 2020.

In January 2020 in Ward Two, a robbery offense occurred when a shoplifting suspect assaulted a store employee at a gas station on Big Bend Blvd, they were stealing twelve bottles of Vodka at the time. There were two burglaries at addresses on East Watson Rd. and Montego Dr. One involving a Church where electronics items were stolen, the other at a residence where multiple items were stolen totaling \$520. There were nineteen stealings at several addresses on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd. and one on Chatwood Terr. A resident of Montego became the victim of a forgery when unknown suspects removed \$5,000 from their Watson Road bank account. A person came to the police station and reported a child was the victim of a sexual assault, investigation determined that the offense did not occur in the city. There were seven traffic accidents and one animal related call. Twenty-six people related calls were handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered fifteen and occurred on 10 different streets. There were 74 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 147 calls for service in Ward two in January 2020.



In January 2020 in Ward Three, one burglary was reported that occurred in the 8900 block of Watson Rd. A large store front glass window was shattered and property valued over \$500 was taken. There was one stealing offense that occurred in 8800 block of Watson Rd. A resident of Grantwood Trails was the victim of a fraud involving a bad check. There were two traffic accidents and one animal related call. There were 47 people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on five different streets. There were 25 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 85 calls for service in Ward three in January 2020.

In January 2020 in Ward Four, there were two stealing offenses that occurred on Red Oak Dr. and 50 Crestwood Executive Dr. There was one traffic accident investigated by police. Fifteen people related calls were handled during the period. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and occurred two different streets. There were 27 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 47 calls for service in Ward four in January 2020.





The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:



Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:




Activity Comparison:
