Subject: March 2020 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of March 2020. In March 2020, there were 21 Part I offenses and 359 Part II / III offenses, for a total of 380. This compares with 24 Part I offenses and 366 Part II / III offenses for a total of 390 in March 2019.

Property damage: There were six property damage offenses reported.

Stealing offenses numbered fifteen in March 2020.

Stealings were of the following classifications in March 2020:




Shopliftings accounted for six of the fifteen stealing events in March 2020. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores.

Part I offenses numbered 21 in March 2020.

Part II / III offenses:

In March 2020, there were three minor assaults reported that occurred on Joann, Buxton and Big Bend Blvd. There were five fraud offenses involving identity theft and forgery that occurred on Detjen, Fern Glen, Hutchins, Townhill and the Crestwood Executive Center. There was one drug offense involving felony drug charges where an arrest was made. There were five offenses against public peace reported. There were eighteen traffic accidents and seven animal calls handled by police. There were 110 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 39 suspicious activities reports and two family related offenses. There were 169 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II / III offenses totaled 359 in March 2020.

Ward Incident Summary:

In March 2020 in Ward One, there were 4 stealings that occurred at on Briarton and Watson roads. There were three reported property damage offensives that occurred on Watson and Conover. One assault occurred and an arrest was made on Buxton Drive. One fraud occurred on Hutchens Drive. One offense against public peace occurred on Park Crestwood with an arrest. There were six traffic accidents and 31 people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on four different streets. There were 37 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 95 calls for service in Ward one in March 2020.

In March 2020 in Ward Two, there were eight stealings at several addresses on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd. and Sturdy Drive. There was one property damage offense that occurred on Watson Road. There were two assaults reported on Buxton and Big Bend Blvd. that resulted in arrests. There were three frauds reported that occurred on Detjen, Townhill and Fern Glen Drive. One offense against public peace occurred on Crestwood Drive with an arrest being made. There were seven traffic accidents and four animal related calls. Twenty-eight people related calls were handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered sixteen and occurred on nine different streets. There were 69 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 139 calls for service in Ward two in March 2020.



In March 2020 in Ward Three, there were three stealing offenses that occurred at addresses on Watson and Grant roads. Property damage occurred on Whitecliff Lane and Grant Road. A suspect was arrested at an address on Watson Road with a felony level of narcotics. There were two offenses against public peace arrests made on Watson Road. There were two traffic accident and 32 people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered thirteen and occurred on seven different streets. There was one family offense that occurred on Buxton Drive involving domestic violence. There were 39 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 95 calls for service in Ward three in March 2020.

In March 2020 in Ward Four, there was one fraud offense that occurred at the Crestwood Executive Center. There was one offense against public peace that occurred on Richter Lane. There were three traffic accidents investigated by police. Nineteen people related calls were handled during the period. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and occurred on two different streets. There was one family offense that occurred on Garber Road. There were 24 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 51 calls for service in Ward four in March 2020.







March 2020**




**Gender of Adults Arrested
March 2020**




Incidents by Day of Week--March 2020






Activity Comparison:

Communications:

Communications handled over 1760 telephone contacts and 371 9-1-1 calls in March 2020. This is a daily average of 57 telephone contacts and twelve 9-1-1 calls.



Radio Communications:

The Crestwood Police utilized the police radio system 10,210 times during the month of March.
