Subject: July 2020 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of July 2020. In July 2020, there were 25 Part I offenses and 380 Part II / III offenses, for a total of 405. This compares with 35 Part I offenses and 428 Part II / III offenses for a total of 414 in July 2019.


Burglary: A fast food restaurant on Watson Road had a window broken out and two men entered the business. At an apartment complex on Watson Road someone was alleged to have entered an apartment without permission. A resident of Maple Grove Drive had their vehicle stolen and the suspect used a garage door opener to access the victim's garage. The detectives are investigating these offenses.

There were two motor vehicle thefts that occurred during July.

Property damage: There were four property damage offenses reported.

Stealing offenses numbered sixteen in July 2020.

Part I offenses numbered 25 in July 2020.

#### **Part II / III offenses:**

In July 2020, there were two fraud offenses involving credit card fraud and forgery. There was one sexual related offense involving delayed reporting. There were sixteen traffic accidents, one animal call and six juvenile offenses handled by police. There were 97 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 44 suspicious activity reports and two family offenses. Two weapons offense calls were also handled by the police. There were 209 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II / III offenses totaled 380 in July 2020.

### **Ward Incident Summary:**

In July 2020 in Ward One, there was a burglary at an apartment complex on Park Crestwood Drive, someone was alleged to have unlawfully entered an apartment. There was one vehicle stolen from Leawood Drive, police recovered the vehicle a short time later. There were four stealing events that occurred on Leawood, Grovena and Watson Road. Three of these thefts involved motor vehicle that were entered and articles stolen from within. There were three traffic accidents and 29 people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered thirteen and occurred on ten different streets. There were 55 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 104 calls for service in Ward one in July 2020.

In July 2020 in Ward Two, there was one burglary that occurred at a restaurant on Watson Road, two men entered the business unlawfully looking for valuables. There were eight stealings at addresses on Watson, Big Bend and Watson Industrial Drive. There was one property damage that occurred on Fox Creek Court involving damage to a residence from a projectile. A vehicle was stolen occurred at a restaurant located on Watson Road. There was one fraud report that occurred at a bank on Watson Road, police contacted the suspect in the drive thru and are investigating further. There were four traffic accidents and one animal related call. There were nineteen people related calls and one juvenile offense handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered fourteen and occurred on six different streets. One family offense and two weapons offenses were investigated. There were 79 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 133 calls for service in Ward two in July 2020.



In July 2020 in Ward Three, a property damage offense occurred on Pardee Road and at White Cliff Park. There was one fraud that affected a resident of Ft. Donelson Drive involving bad checks. There were six traffic accidents investigated. The police responded to 39 people related calls and investigated four juvenile related offenses. There were five suspicious activity calls that occurred on five different streets. There were 39 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 97 calls for service in Ward three in July 2020.

In July 2020 in Ward Four, there was one burglary that occurred after a garage door remote was used to open a residence on Maple Grove Drive, suspects stole the belonging of the owner after entering the garage. There were four stealing offenses that occurred Glenwood, Del Vista, Meadowfern and Laurel Crest Drive. A property damage report was taken on Del Vista Drive involving a motor vehicle. There was one alleged sex offense that was reported that occurred years ago and was investigated by detectives. There were three traffic accidents and eighteen people related calls handled during the period. There was one juvenile offense investigated by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets. There were 36 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 71 calls for service in Ward four in July 2020.



The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:


**Activity Report:**

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:




### **Activity Comparison:**
