Subject: August 2020 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of August 2020. In August 2020, there were 18 Part I offenses and 349 Part II / III offenses, for a total of 367. This compares with 24 Part I offenses and 407 Part II / III offenses for a total of 431 in August 2019.

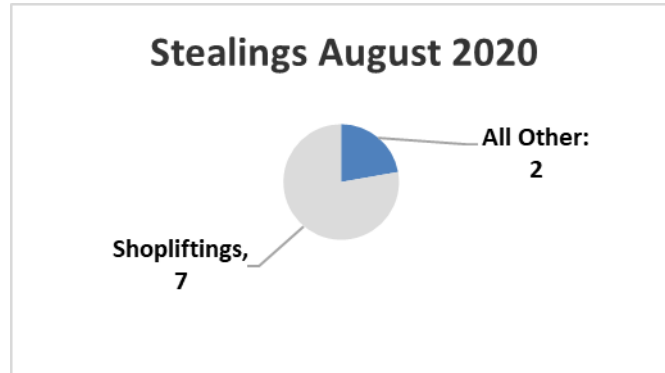
Robbery: There were a total of three robberies in the city during August. One was at a gas station on Big Bend, another at a gas station on Watson Road and one at a department store on Watson Road. No apparent injuries to the victims, detectives are investigating.

Burglary: Residents of Lavant and Lowill had suspects open their vehicles parked outside their houses, suspects then used a garage door opener in those vehicles to access the victim's garage where property was stolen. Detectives are investigating these offenses. One other burglary occurred at a car dealership, thieves broke into the business and stole car keys, and then they stole numerous vehicles from the parking lot.

There were three property damage reports taken during August, one of these offenses involved extensive damage to a grassy area at Whitecliff Park.

Stealing offenses numbered nine in August 2020.

Part I offenses numbered 18 in August 2020.

Part II / III offenses:

In August 2020, one assault occurred between two subjects known to each other. There were two fraud offenses involving credit card fraud and forgery. There was one driving while intoxicated incident. There were twenty-five traffic accidents, two animal calls and four juvenile offenses handled by police. There were 92 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 29 suspicious activity reports and three family offenses. There were 190 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II / III offenses totaled 349 in August 2020.

Ward Incident Summary:

In August 2020 in Ward One, There were six stealing events that occurred at businesses along Watson Road. There was one property damage offense where political signs were damaged. There were seven traffic accidents and twenty people related calls. There was one juvenile offense and seven suspicious activity calls that occurred on three different streets. There were 50 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 93 calls for service in Ward one in August 2020.

In August 2020 in Ward Two, there were two robberies that occurred, one on Watson Road at a department store and one on Big Bend Blvd. at a gas station. There were no apparent injuries to the victims. There were three stealing events that occurred at addresses on Watson Road and on Big Bend Blvd. There was one minor assault that occurred involving persons known to each other, no arrest was made at that time. There were two fraud reports that occurred at an address on Big Bend Blvd. and on Etherton Drive involving a fraud Apple Pay account and a credit card. Police intervened when an intoxicated driver was found in his car sleeping. There were eleven traffic accidents and one animal related call. There were twenty-eight people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on four different streets. There were 67 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 124 calls for service in Ward two in August 2020.

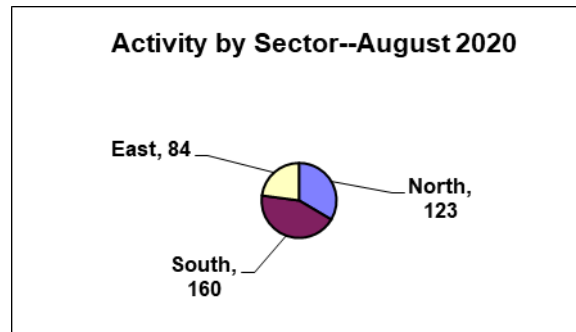
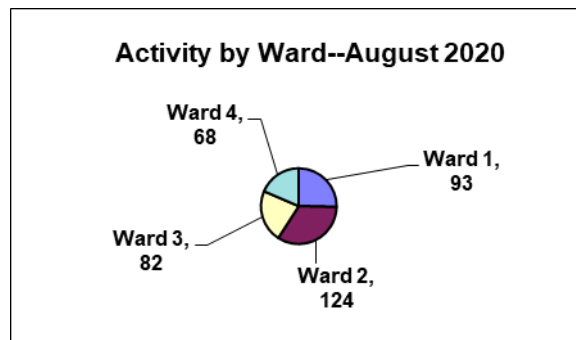
In August 2020 in Ward Three, there was one robbery that occurred at a gas station on Watson Road, men took \$800 in cigarettes after forcing the clerk into a small room. There were two burglary's that occurred, one at a car dealership on Watson Road where multiple vehicles were subsequently stolen and on Lavant Drive were thieves entered a garage and stole property of the owner. There was one property damage offense that occurred at White Cliff Park. There were three traffic accidents investigated. The police responded to 24 people related calls and one animal call. One juvenile offense was investigated by police. There were twelve suspicious activity calls that occurred on nine different streets. There were 37 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 82 calls for service in Ward three in August 2020.

In August 2020 in Ward Four, there was one burglary that occurred after a garage door remote was used to open a residence on Lowill Lane, suspects stole two of the owner's vehicles. A property damage report was taken on Del Vista Drive involving projectiles being thrown at a residence, \$3000 in damage reported. There were four traffic accidents and twenty people related calls handled during the period. There were two juvenile offenses investigated by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and occurred on two different streets. Two family offenses were also investigated. There were 36 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 68 calls for service in Ward four in August 2020.

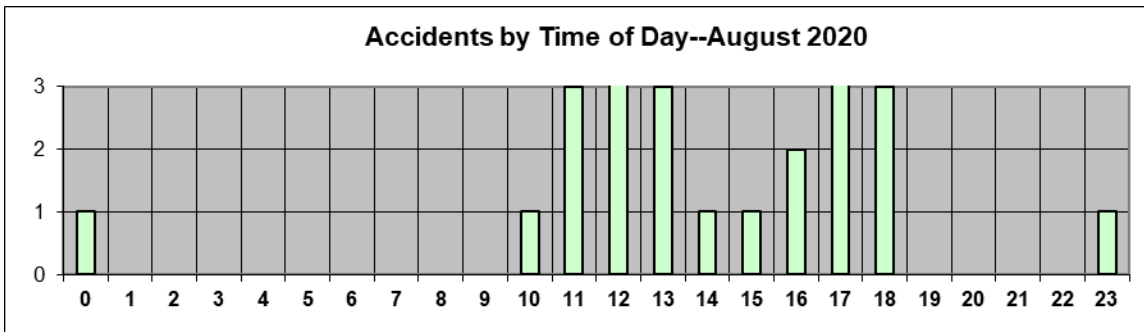

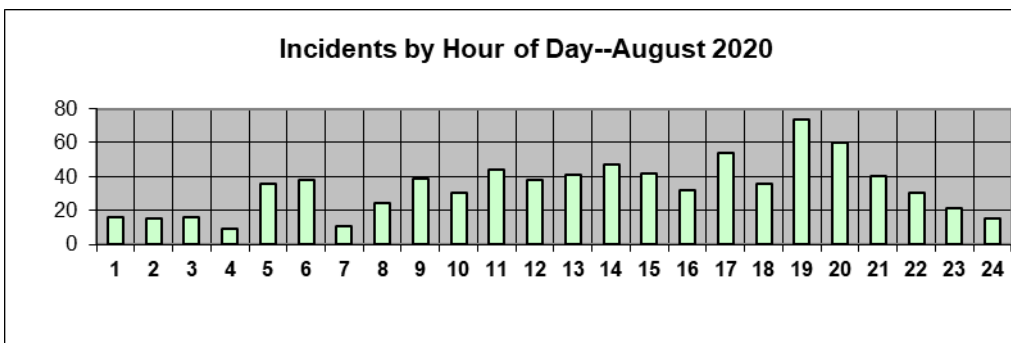
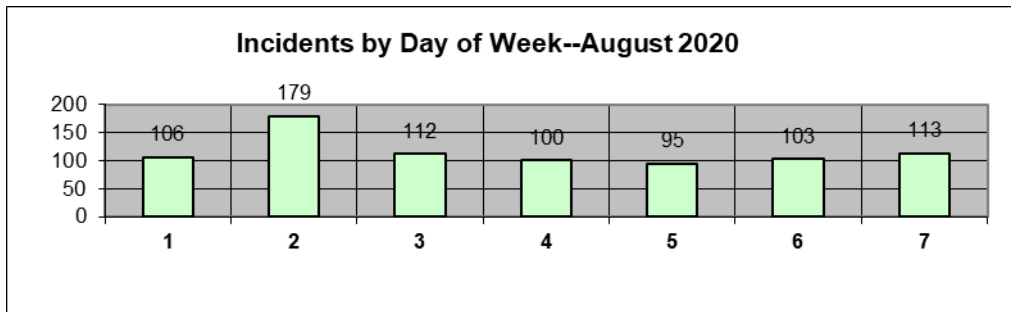
Six persons were taken into custody in August 2020.

The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:



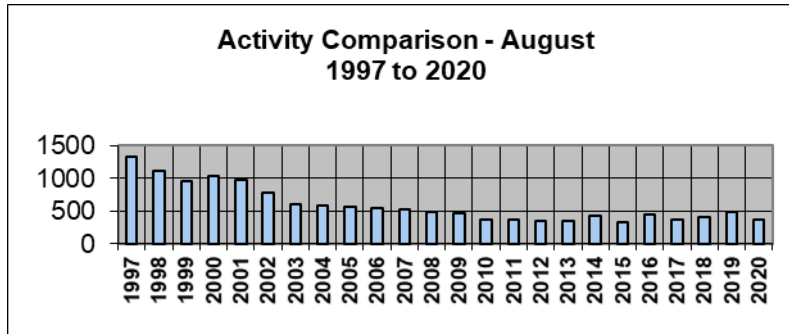

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



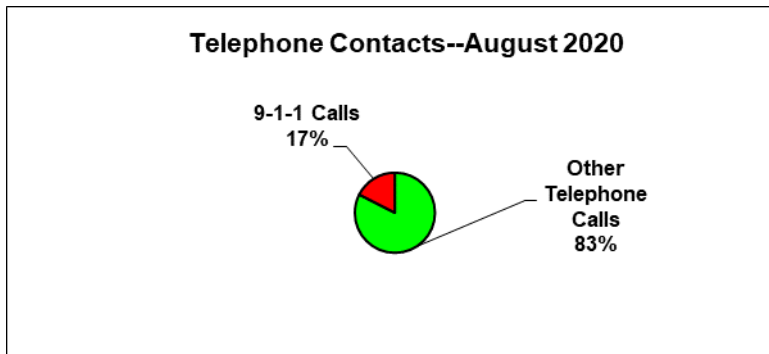
Activity Comparison:
