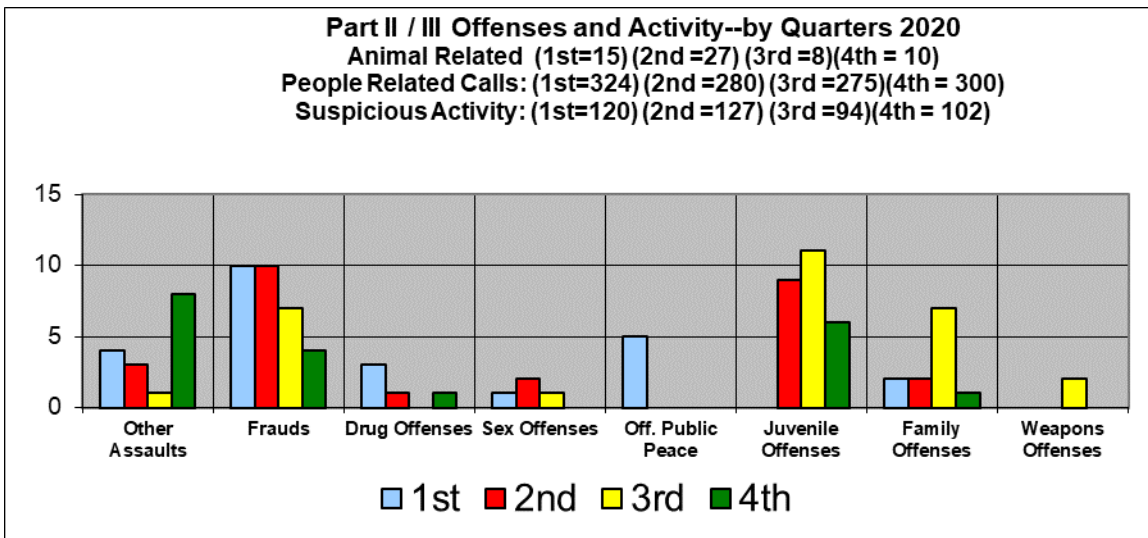
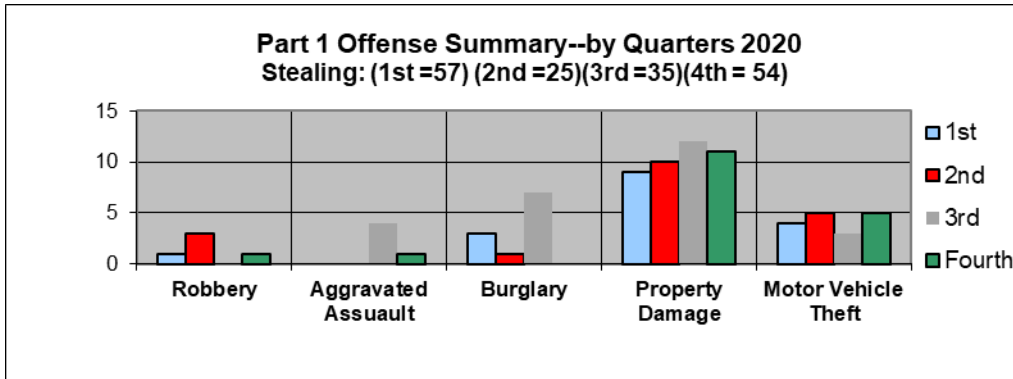
This chart shows the level of Part 1 crimes reported during the Fourth quarter of each year from 1997 through 2020.



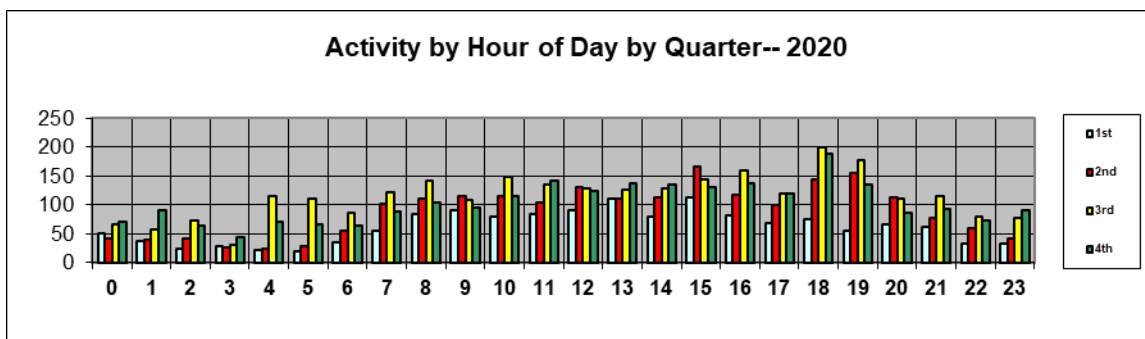
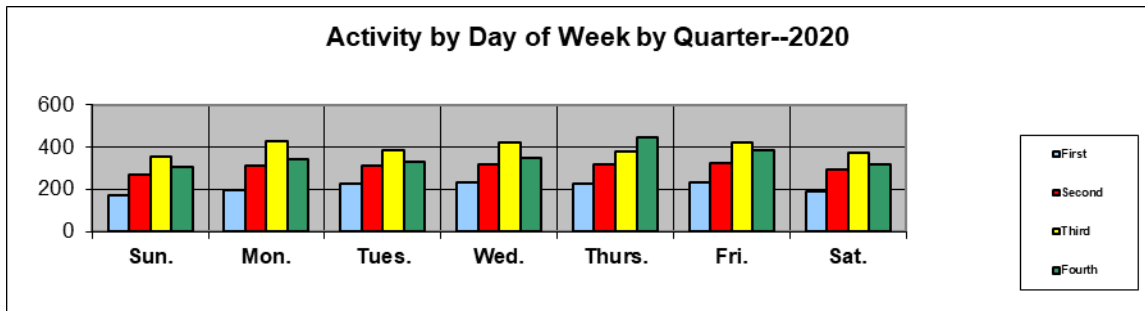
This chart shows the level of Part 2 crimes / activity reported during the Fourth quarter of each year from 1997 through 2020.

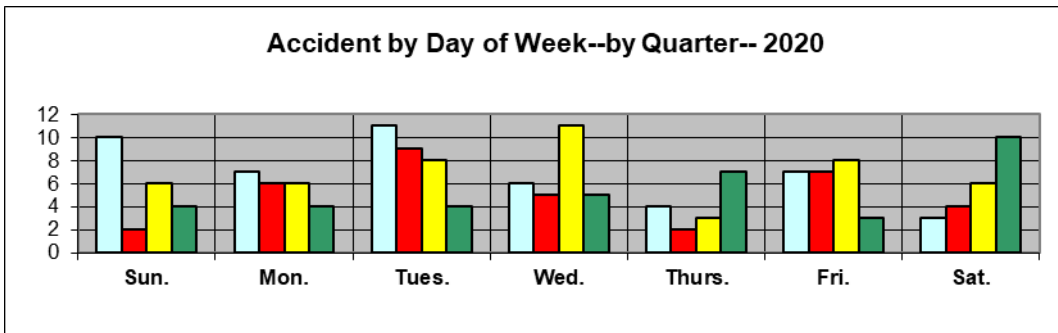

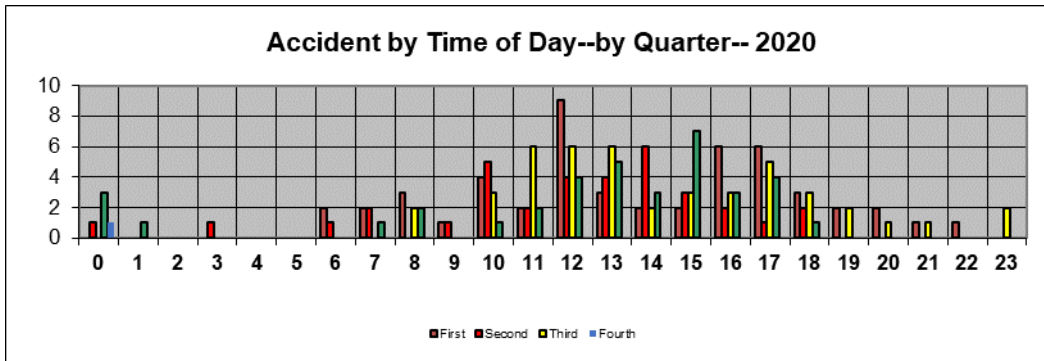

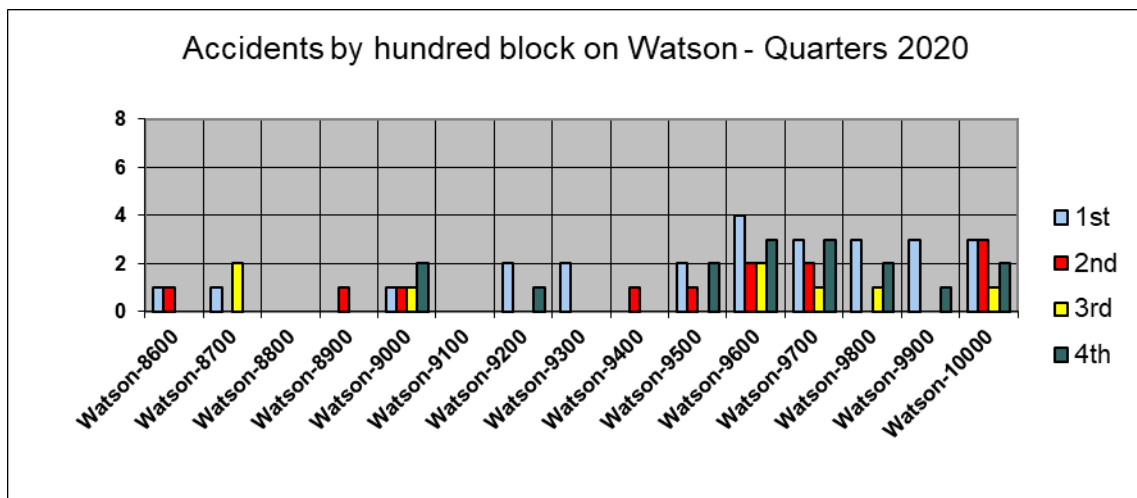

Communications:

In the Fourth Quarter, Communications handled 4,479 telephone contacts and 1,047 9-1-1 calls. This is a daily average of 50 telephone calls and eleven 9-1-1 calls.



The police radio system was utilized 27,429 during the Fourth quarter of 2020, approximately 298 per day.
