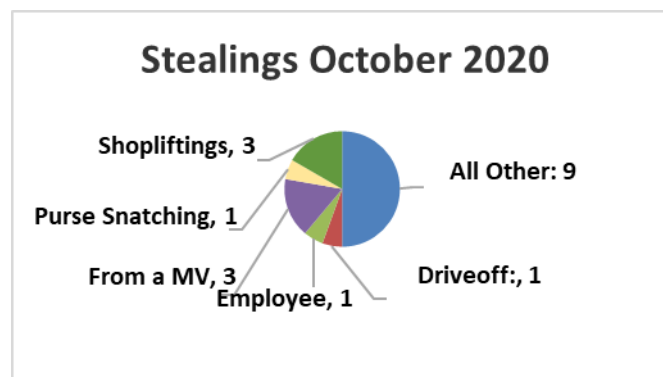
Subject: October 2020 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of October 2020. In October 2020, there were 22 Part I offenses and 296 Part II / III offenses, for a total of 318. This compares with 24 Part I offenses and 394 Part II / III offenses for a total of 418 in October 2019.

Stolen vehicles: There were two stolen vehicles, one from an apartment complex and one from a residential area. Both vehicles were recovered by police, an arrest was made in one of the thefts.

Stealing offenses numbered 18 in October 2020.

Stealings were of the following classifications in October 2020:



Part I offenses numbered 22 in October 2020.

Part II / III offenses:

In October 2020, there were four fraud offenses involving forgery, ID theft and internet scams. There were two drug related offenses. There was one sex offense investigated. There were eleven traffic accidents, five animal calls and three juvenile offenses handled by police. There was one family offense investigated. There were 97 people related calls addressed. Police investigated twenty two suspicious activity reports. There were 150 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II / III offenses totaled 296 in October 2020.

Ward Incident Summary:

In October 2020 in Ward One, there were five stealing events that occurred at businesses along Watson Road, Ridgewood Drive, Woodbine Drive, and Lodge Pole Lane. There were two stolen vehicles, one from Mary Glen Drive and one from Woodbine Drive. Both vehicles were recovered by police, an arrest was made in one of the thefts.

There was one property damage offense on Mary Glen Drive involving damage to a resident's vehicle. There were three fraud offenses involving an internet scam and ID theft. One sex offense was investigated that was alleged to have occurred at a business on Watson Road. There were two drug offenses that occurred, two arrests were made for possession of illegal drugs. There were four traffic accidents. Police handled eighteen people related calls and four suspicious activity calls. There were 40 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 80 calls for service in Ward one in October 2020.

In October 2020 in Ward Two, there were five stealing events that occurred at addresses on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd and Elmont Lane. One fraud offense was reported from a bank on Watson Road in reference to an attempt to access a resident's bank account. There were three traffic accidents and four animal related calls. There were twenty-six people related calls and two juvenile calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on five different streets. There were 53 miscellaneous police service calls.

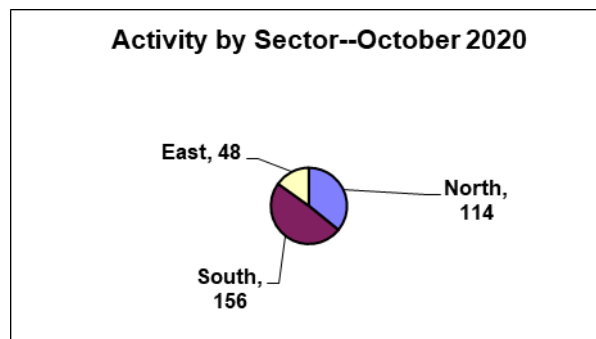
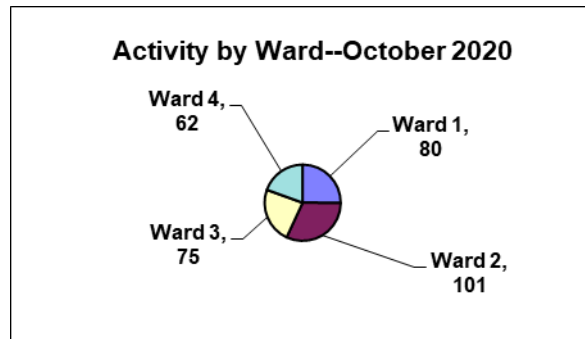
Police handled 101 calls for service in Ward two in October 2020.

In October 2020 in Ward Three, there were three stealing events that occurred on Garber Road, Lavant Drive and Ewers Drive. There were two traffic accidents investigated. One animal related call was handled by police. The police responded to thirty three people related calls. There were four suspicious activity calls that occurred on three different streets. There were thirty two miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 75 calls for service in Ward three in October 2020.

In October 2020 in Ward Four, there were five stealing offenses reported from Harwich Drive, Crest Oak Lane and Craigwood Terrace. There was one property damage reported on Garber Road involving damage to the victim's tires. There were two traffic accidents, twenty people related calls and one juvenile offense handled by police. One family offense was investigated by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven. There were twenty-five miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 62 calls for service in Ward four in October 2020.

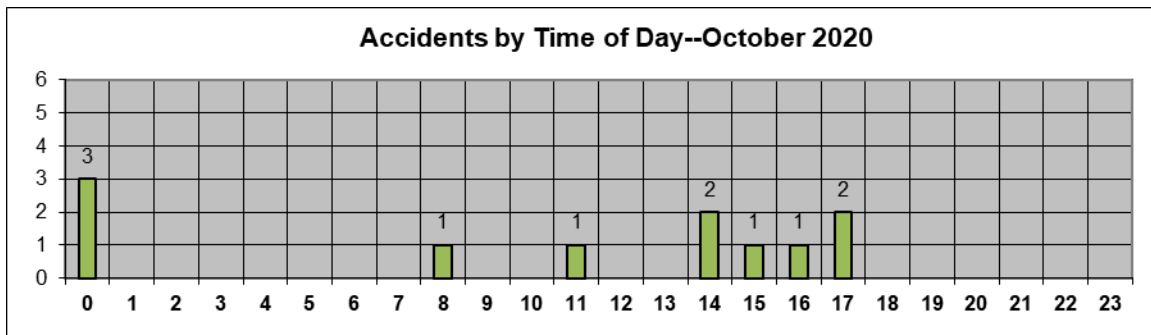

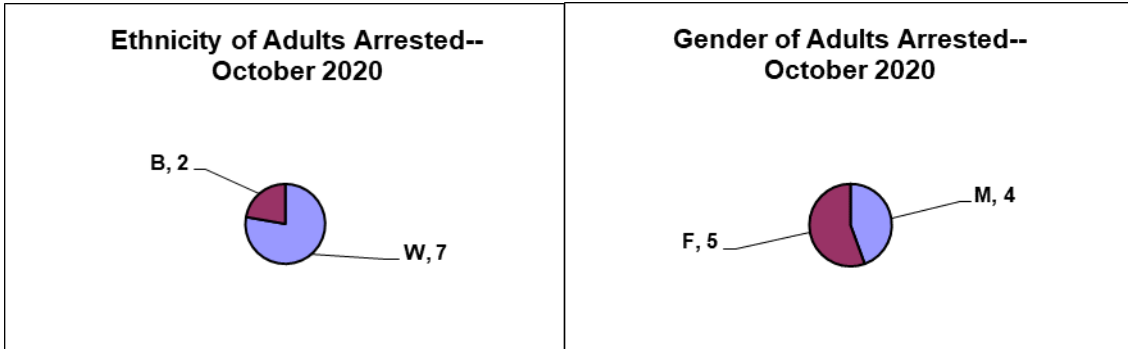

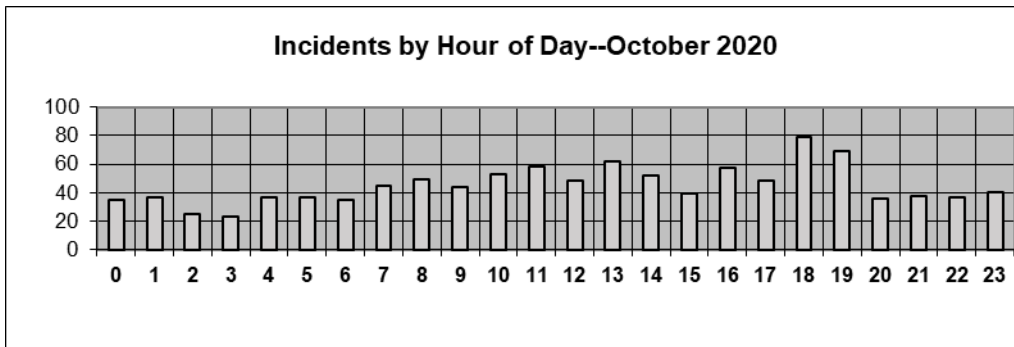
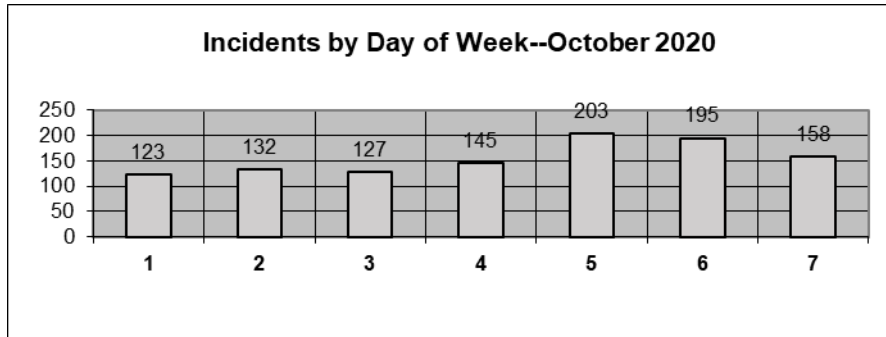
Nine persons were taken into custody in October 2020.

The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:



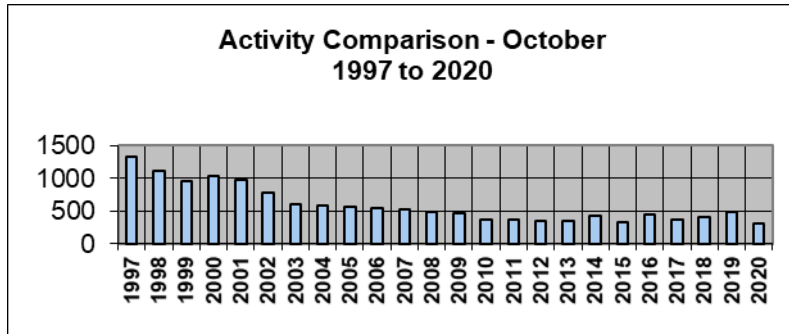

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



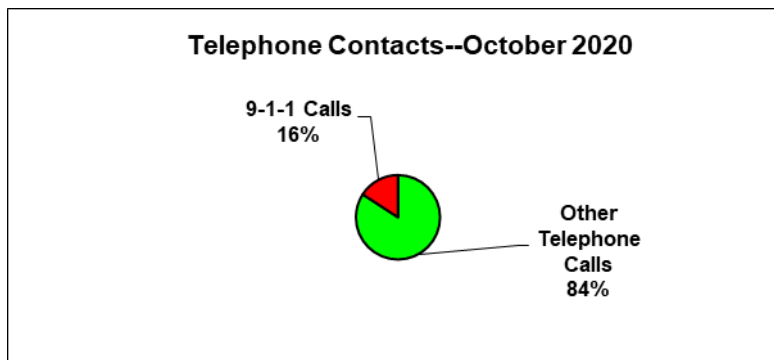
Activity Comparison:
