Subject: April 2021 Public Report

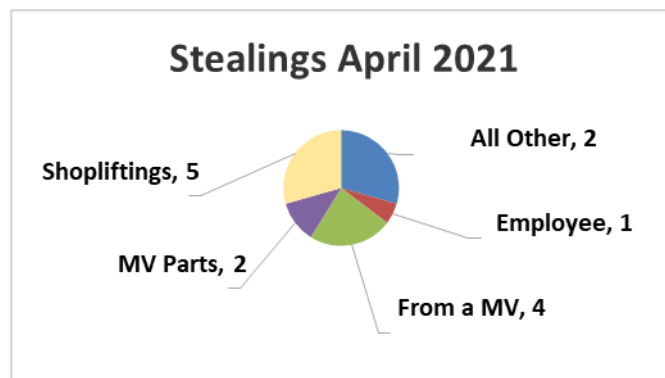
This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of April 2021. In April 2021, there were 25 Part I offenses and 290 Part II offenses / incidents, for a total of 315. This compares with 9 Part I offenses and 250 Part II offenses / incidents for a total of 259 in April 2020.

There were three property damage offenses that occurred. Two of the offenses involved vandalism, the other was property damage to a vehicle.

There were a total of 5 vehicles stolen in April 2021, four were motor vehicles and one was a trailer that had an ATV attached on it.

Stealing offenses numbered 17 in April 2021.

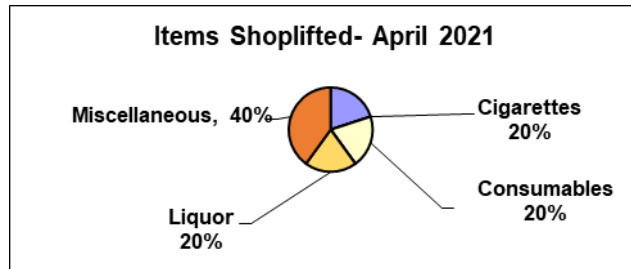

Part II offenses / Police activity:

In April 2021, there were four fraud offenses involving three residents and one business. There were five drug related offenses. There were eleven traffic accidents, two animal calls handled by police. There were 85 people related calls addressed. Police investigated 27 suspicious activity reports, two family offenses and one weapons offense. There were 153 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II offenses / Police activity totaled 290 in April 2021.

Ward Incident Summary:

In April 2021 in Ward One, there were four stealing events that occurred at an address on Watson Road and Hutchins Drive. There were two fraud offenses that occurred on Briarton Drive and Hutchins Drive involving an internet scam and phony debit card transactions. There were two drug offense found after traffic stops involving possession of illegal drugs and paraphernalia. There were three traffic accidents and one animal related call handled by police. Police responded to seventeen people related calls and six suspicious activity calls which occurred on four different streets. There were 43 miscellaneous police service calls. There was one family offense and one weapons offense investigated.

Police handled 80 calls for service in Ward one in April 2021.

In April 2021 in Ward Two, there were eight stealing events that occurred at addresses on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd and Rosaire Drive. There were three stolen vehicle offenses investigated, two of these thefts occurred at business along Watson Road and the other theft occurred at an address on Attucks Avenue. There were two fraud crimes reported at addresses on Watson Road and Greenview Drive involving credit card fraud. There was one drug offense found after a traffic stop involving possession of illegal drugs and paraphernalia. There were four traffic accidents investigated. There were twenty-two people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on eight different streets. There were 64 miscellaneous police service calls.

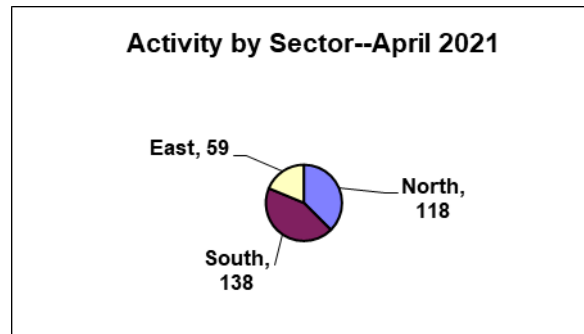
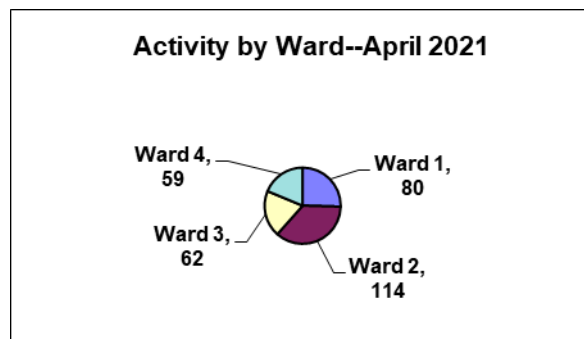
Police handled 114 calls for service in Ward two in April 2021.

In April 2021 in Ward Three, there were four stealing events that occurred on Watson Road, Grant Road and General Grant Lane. There was one vehicle theft that occurred at a business along Watson Road involving a commercial vehicle. There were two drug offenses found by police after traffic stops on Watson Road involving possession of illegal drugs and paraphernalia. Four traffic accidents and one animal related call were handled by police. The police responded to 22 people related calls for service. There were seven suspicious activity calls that occurred on five different streets. There were 21 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 62 calls for service in Ward three in April 2021.

In April 2021 in Ward Four, one stealing offense occurred on Parkshire Drive where a package was stolen from a front porch. There was one vehicle theft that occurred on Sappington Greens Lane. Police recovered the vehicle with no apparent damage. Three property damage offenses were reported to police involving vandalism and property damage to a vehicle. Police responded to twenty-four people related calls for service and one family offense. Suspicious activity calls numbered four and occurred on four different streets. There were twenty-five miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 59 calls for service in Ward four in April 2021.

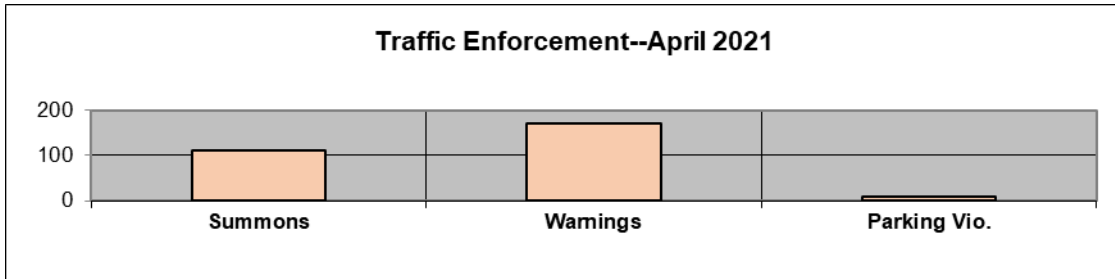

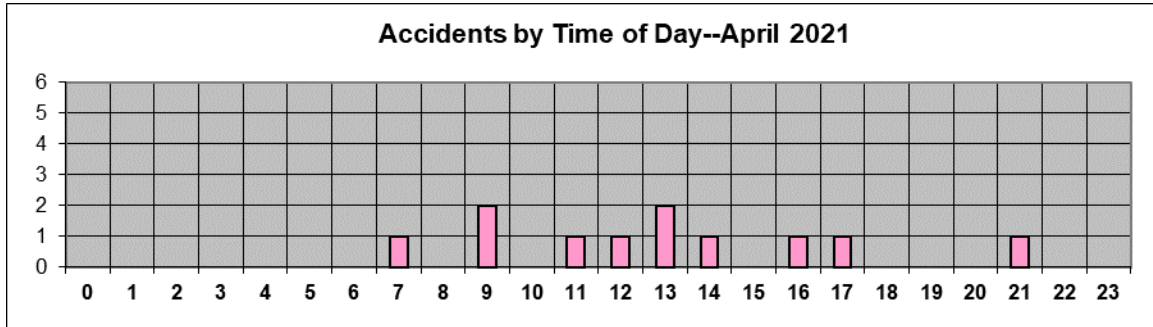

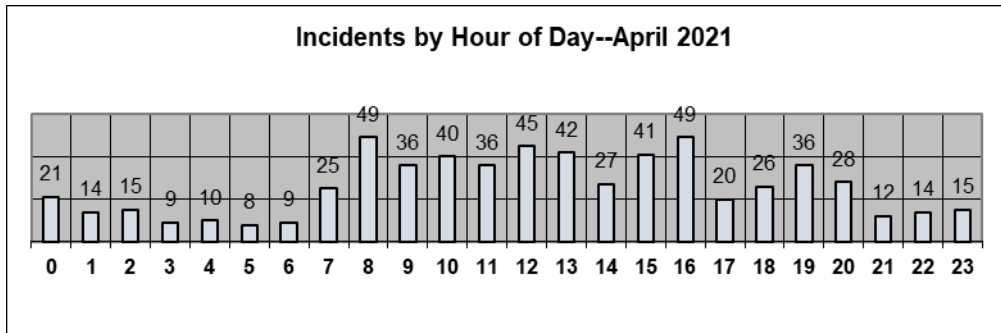
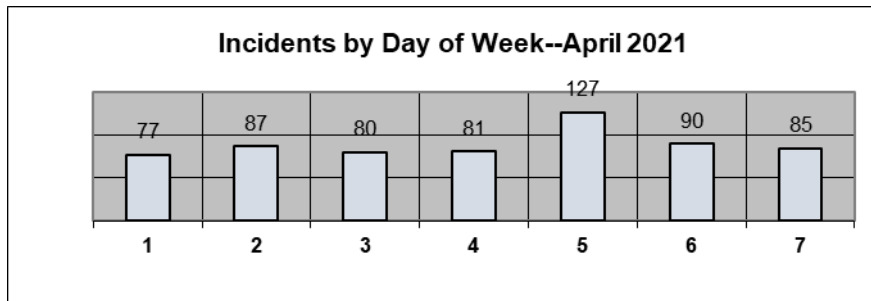
Fourteen persons were taken into custody in April 2021.

The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:



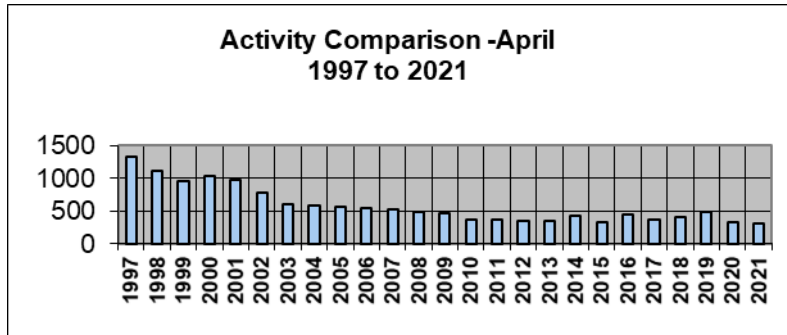

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



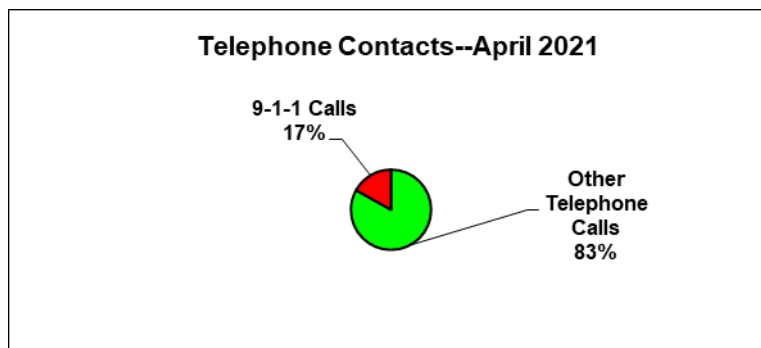
Activity Comparison:
