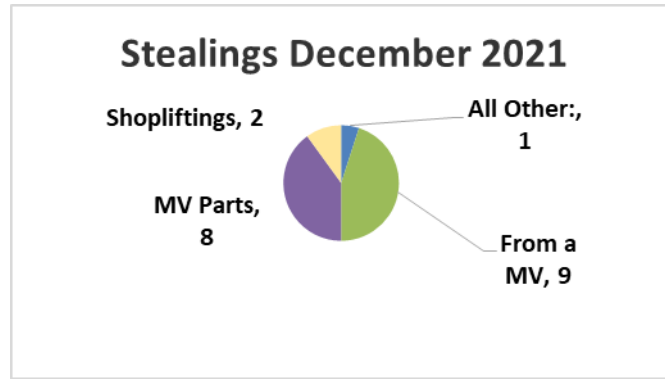
Subject: December 2021 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of December 2021. In December 2021, there were 23 Part I offenses and 388 Part II offenses / incidents, for a total of 422. This compares with 22 Part I offenses and 311 Part II offenses / incidents for a total of 333 in December 2020.

During the month there was one property damage offense reported as damage to a vehicle. There were two motor vehicle thefts that occurred on Blackthorn Dr and Red Oak Dr.

Stealing offenses numbered 20 in December 2021.

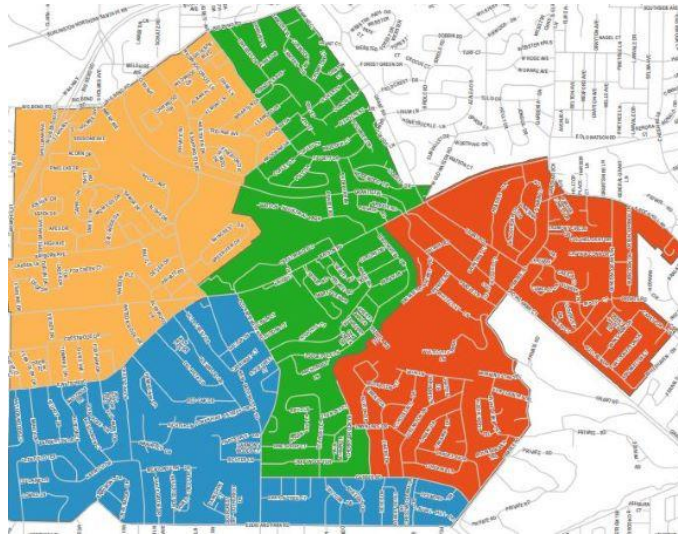

Part I offenses numbered 23 in December 2021.

Part II offenses / Police activity:

In December 2021, there was one assault and five fraud offenses involving counterfeit bills, check fraud, identity theft and online credit card fraud. There was one drug offense and one arrest made for driving while intoxicated. There were sixteen traffic accidents, and 11 animal calls handled by police. There were 115 people related calls addressed during the month of December. Police investigated 76 suspicious activity incidents and there were 173 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department during the period.

Part II offenses / Police activity totaled 399 in December 2021.

Ward Incident Summary:

In December 2021 there were six stealing offenses that occurred in Ward 1. Three of the stealing offenses were catalytic converter thefts that occurred in Watson Industrial Park, one was an attempted shoplifting from Westlake Ace Hardware. Another was a car clouting that occurred at AAA on Watson Rd and the sixth stealing offense occurred on Leawood Dr where prescription medication was stolen out of a vehicle. There were three fraud reports taken in Ward 1 involving counterfeit bills and identity theft. One traffic accident occurred on Watson Rd. along with officers responding to 19 suspicious activity calls on eleven different streets. There was also one animal related call, 22 people related calls, and 52 miscellaneous police calls reported during the month. Police handled 104 calls for service in Ward 1 in December 2021.

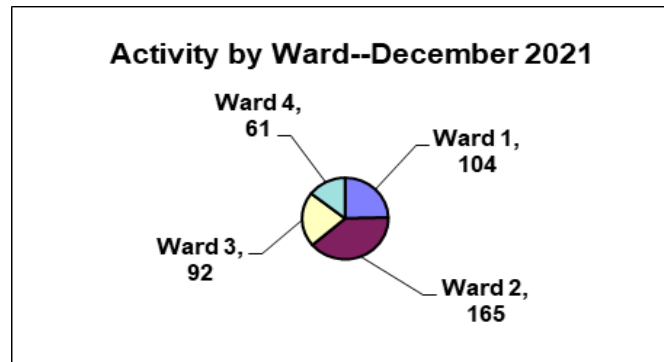
In December 2021 in Ward 2, there were 5 stealing offenses that occurred two of those were car cloutings that occurred on Briarton Dr and Grovena Dr. Another stealing offense was a stolen front license plate, a carton of cigarettes was shoplifted from Circle K in the 9900 block of Watson and a purse was taken out of a shopping cart at Kohl's. One assault occurred on Chatwood Terrace where both the victim and suspect were known to each other and one drug offense occurred on Watson Rd. Eight traffic accidents occurred on Watson Rd, I-44, Ponderosa Dr and Sappington Rd. There were 30 suspicious activity calls responded to on nine different streets in Ward 2. There were also five animal related calls, 31 people related calls, and 84 miscellaneous police calls reported during the month. Police handled 165 calls for service in Ward 2 in December 2021.

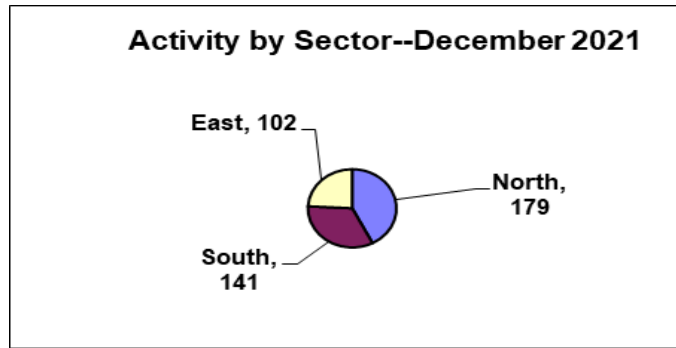
In December 2021 in Ward 3, there were seven stealing offenses reported. The stealing offenses included three car cloutings in Whitecliff Park, and four stolen catalytic converters taken from Watson Rd and Royal Arms Ct. One motor vehicle theft occurred in Ward 3 on Blackthorn Dr in which the vehicle was later recovered and returned to the owner. One fraud offense was reported involving a check that was stolen from the mail, had been altered and cashed. One subject was arrested for driving while intoxicated in

Ward 3 on Watson Rd. There were six traffic accidents that occurred on Pardee Ln, Whitecliff Ln, Whitehaven Dr, Sunray Ln and Pardee Rd. Officers responded to 12 calls for suspicious activity on nine different streets in Ward 3. There was also three animal related calls, 35 people related calls and 26 miscellaneous police calls during the month. Police handled 92 calls for service in Ward 3 in December 2021.

In December 2021 in Ward 4, there were two stealing offenses reported on Glen Rose Dr and Eddie and Park Rd. One property damage was reported on Crest Oak Ln where a vehicle was vandalized. One motor vehicle theft occurred on Red Oak Dr and there was one fraud report taken involving online credit card fraud. There was one traffic accident that occurred in Ward 4 on Pardee Rd. Officers responded to 15 calls for suspicious activity on thirteen different streets along with two animal related calls. There were 27 people related calls, and 11 miscellaneous police calls. Police handled 61 calls for service in Ward 4 in December 2021.

CAD Activity by Ward and Sector:



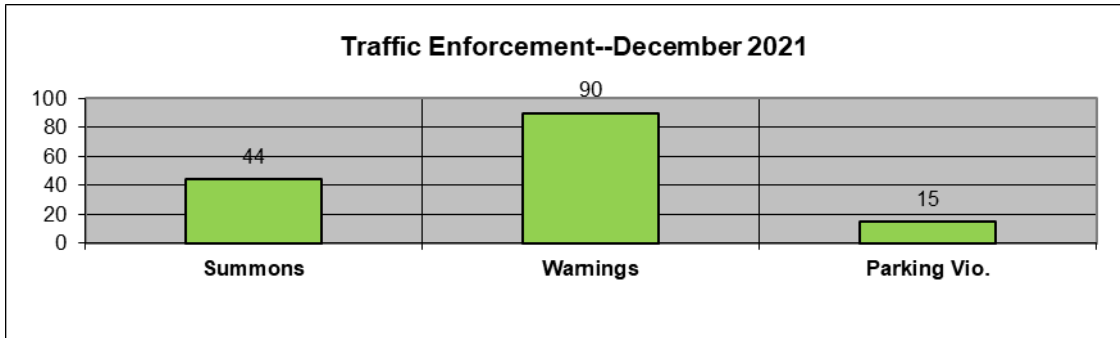

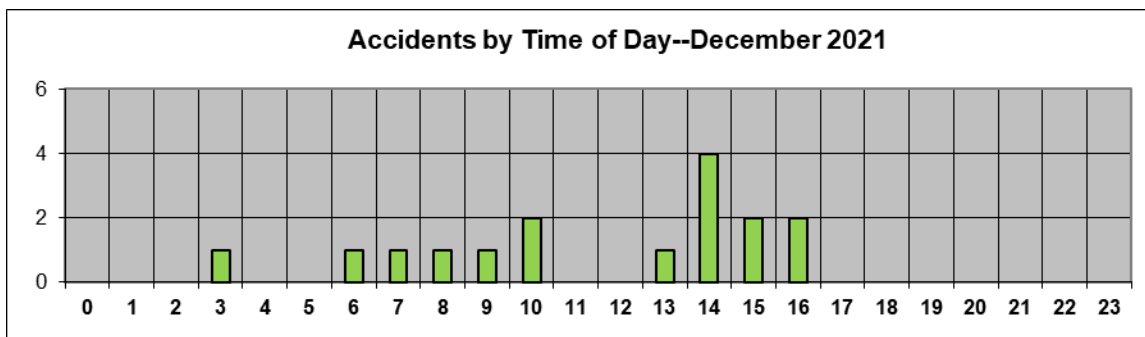

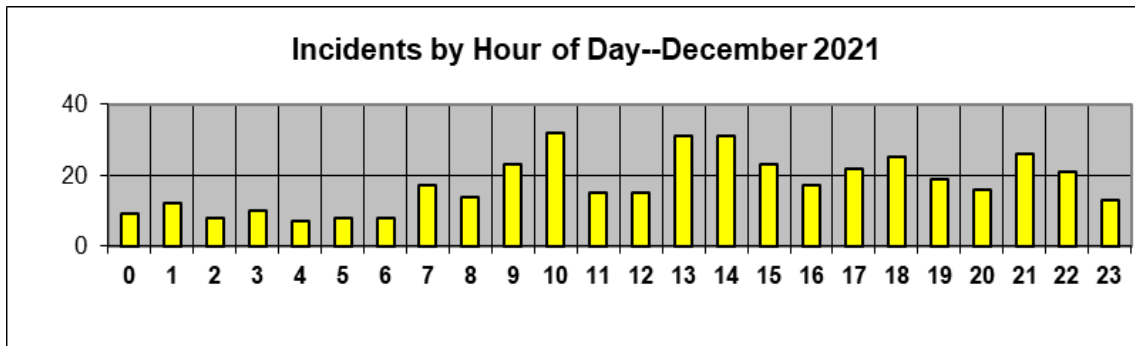

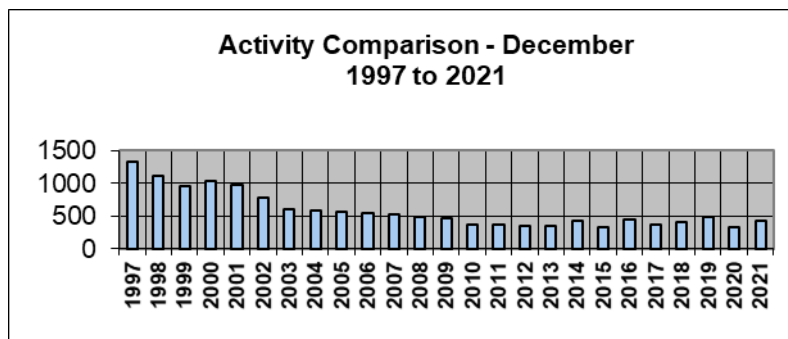
Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:
