## Calls for Service breakdown:

Crestwood Police Department responded to a total of 436 calls for service during the month of April. Those calls are broken down into offense/call natures and separated by wards.

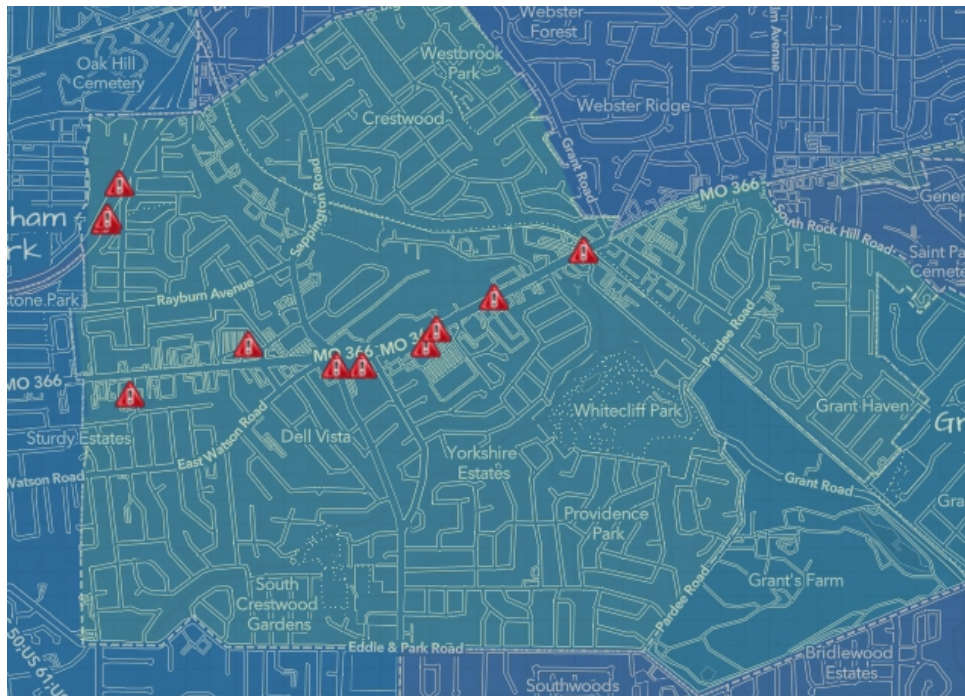

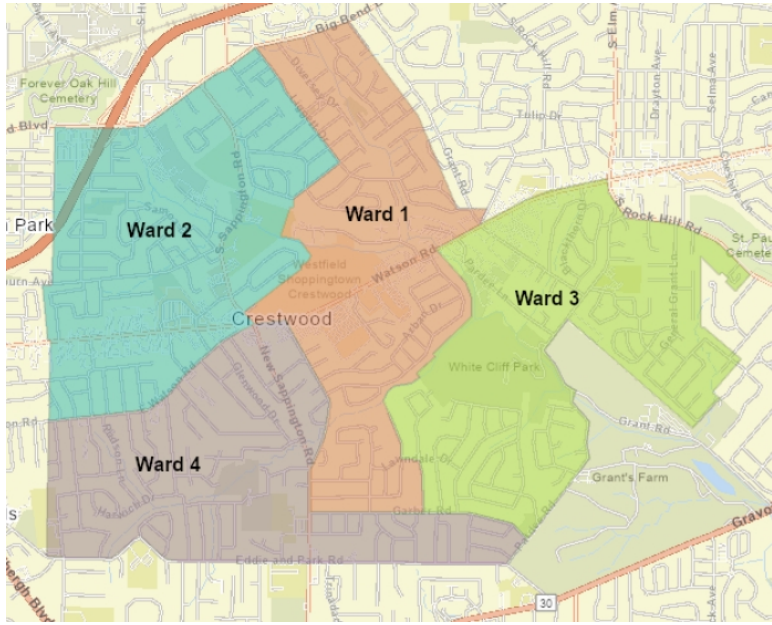
## Detective Bureau Performance:

In April, 102 supplemental reports and 30 original reports were written and 3 physical arrests were made. 3 cases were *Cleared by Arrest*, 13 were *Cleared Exceptionally*, 3 were cleared by other means, and 32 were inactivated. A total of 19 cases are still marked *Active*. Not counting those that are still *Active*, the clearance rate for the bureau up to and including April was **37.3%** percent.

In the nation in 2019, 45.5 % of violent crimes and 17.2 % of property crimes were cleared by arrest or exceptional means according to the Criminal Justice Information Services Division.

## Ward Incident Summary:



### Ward 1:

In April 2022 there were 5 stealing offenses that occurred in Ward 1, and one property damage occurred on Signature Ln that was reported as damage to a vehicle. One motor vehicle theft was reported on Park Crestwood Dr where a person known to the victim took their vehicle without permission. There was one minor assault that occurred between two workers at a business on Watson Industrial Park Dr and One fraud report was taken on Park Crestwood Dr for identity theft. One individual was arrested for Driving while intoxicated on Conover Ln and three traffic accidents occurred along Watson Rd. Officers responded to 18 calls for suspicious activity on 9 different streets. There were also 2 animal related calls, 21 people related calls, and 54 miscellaneous police calls reported.

Police handled 108 calls for service in Ward 1 in April 2022.

## **Ward 2:**

In March 2022 in Ward 2, there were three stealing offenses reported and one motor vehicle theft occurred on Samoa Dr. There were 10 property damage reports taken in Ward 2 all for damage to vehicles. One fraud report was made by residents on Crestwood Dr for telephone scams. One driver was arrested for driving while intoxicated on Watson Rd and police responded to 5 traffic accidents that occurred on I-44, and Watson Road all with no injuries. There were 33 suspicious activity calls responded to on 17 different streets in Ward 2, along with 1 animal related call, 3 juvenile offenses, 26 people related calls and 100 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 184 calls for service in Ward 2 in April 2022.

## **Ward 3:**

In April 2022 in Ward 3, there were two stealing reports taken. One fraud report was made by residents on Royal Arms Ct for internet fraud. One traffic accident occurred in Ward 3 on Watson Rd that was reported with no injuries. Officers responded to 7 calls for suspicious activity on 7 different streets, and 3 animal related calls. One juvenile offense was also reported along with 32 people related calls and 30 miscellaneous police calls in Ward 3.

Police handled 77 calls for service in Ward 3 in April 2022.

## **Ward 4:**

In April 2022 in Ward 4, there was one stealing offense reported as stealing from a motor vehicle on Rusdon Ln. Two traffic accidents occurred on Watson Road and were reported as non-injury. Officers responded to 12 calls for suspicious activity on 7 different streets, 20 people related calls, and 32 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 67 calls for service in Ward 4 in April 2022.
