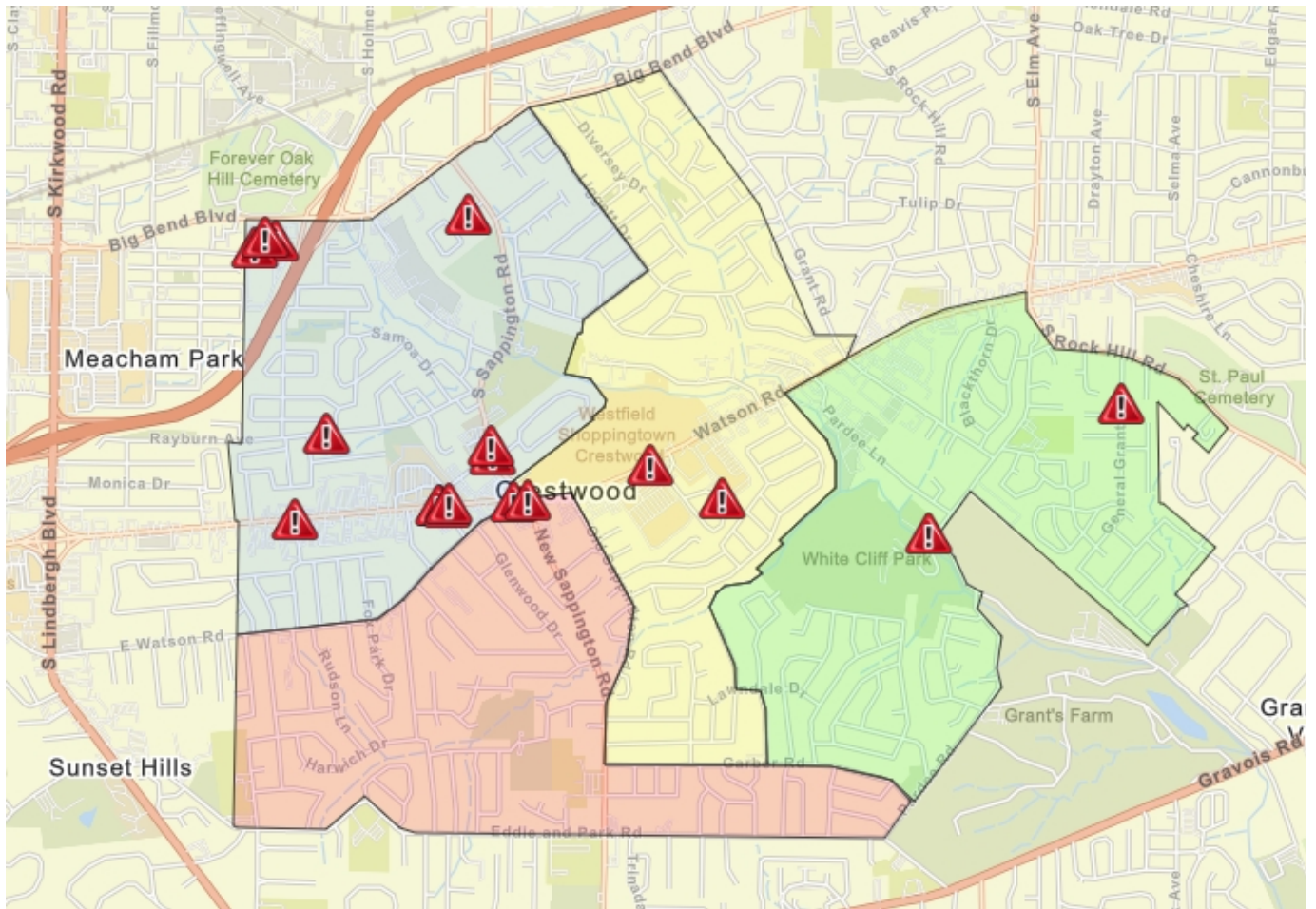

Detective Bureau Performance:

In June, 54 supplemental reports and 0 original reports were written and 3 physical arrests were made. 3 cases were *Cleared by Arrest*, 7 were *Cleared Exceptionally*, 2 were cleared by other means, and 8 were inactivated. A total of 22 cases are still marked *Active*. Not counting those that are still *Active*, the clearance rate for the bureau up to and including June was **50.5%** percent. That percentage is slightly down from 50.7% in May.

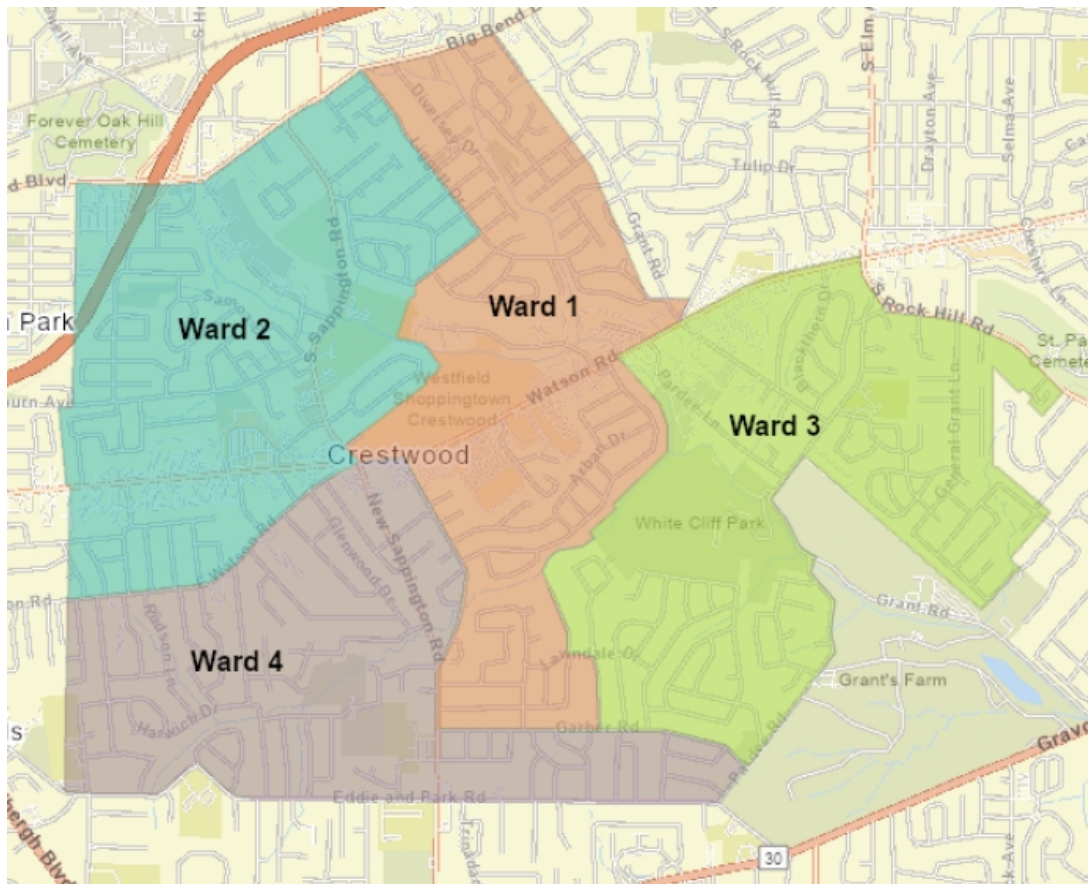

In the nation, in 2019, 45.5 % of violent crimes and 17.2 % of property crimes were cleared by arrest or exceptional means according to the Criminal Justice Information Services Division.

Ward Incident Summary:



Ward 1:

In June 2022, five stealing offenses and one property damage offense that was reported as damage to a vehicle occurred in Ward 1. Two fraud reports were taken at banks along Watson Road where subjects attempted to cash stolen checks. One driver was arrested for driving while intoxicated on Park Crestwood Dr. There was one traffic accident that occurred on Watson Rd and officers responded to 14 calls for suspicious activity on 9 different streets. There were also 2 animal related calls, 27 people related calls, and 55 miscellaneous police calls reported.

Police handled 108 calls for service in Ward 1 in June 2022.

Ward 2:

In June 2022, there was one burglary reported at a business on Watson Rd and there were eight stealing offenses reported. There were 2 property damage reports taken, one was for damage to a vehicle and the other was for damage to a window of a garage. One motor vehicle theft was reported from a business on Watson Rd and two fraud reports were taken for fraudulent use of credit cards. Police responded to 12 traffic accidents that occurred on Big Bend Blvd, Chatwood Terrace, Detjen Dr, Glenwood Dr, Rayburn Ave, Sappington Rd and Watson Rd. There were 23 suspicious activity calls responded to on 10 different streets in Ward 2, along with 1 animal related call, 1 juvenile offense, 34 people related calls and 88 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 173 calls for service in Ward 2 in June 2022.

Ward 3:

In June 2022 there were three stealing reports taken and one motor vehicle theft was reported on Flamingo Dr. One driver was arrested for driving while intoxicated on Grant Rd and police responded to two traffic accidents on General Grant Ln and Whitecliff Ln. There were 9 calls for suspicious activity on 4 different streets, and 4 animal related calls. Seven juvenile offenses were also reported along with 32 people related calls and 43 miscellaneous police calls in Ward 3.

Police handled 102 calls for service in Ward 3 in June 2022.

Ward 4:

In June 2022 there was one stealing offense reported and officers responded to two traffic accidents on Sappington Rd and Watson Rd. We received 11 calls for suspicious activity on 11 different streets, 25 people related calls, 3 animal related calls, and 31 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 73 calls for service in Ward 4 in June 2022.
