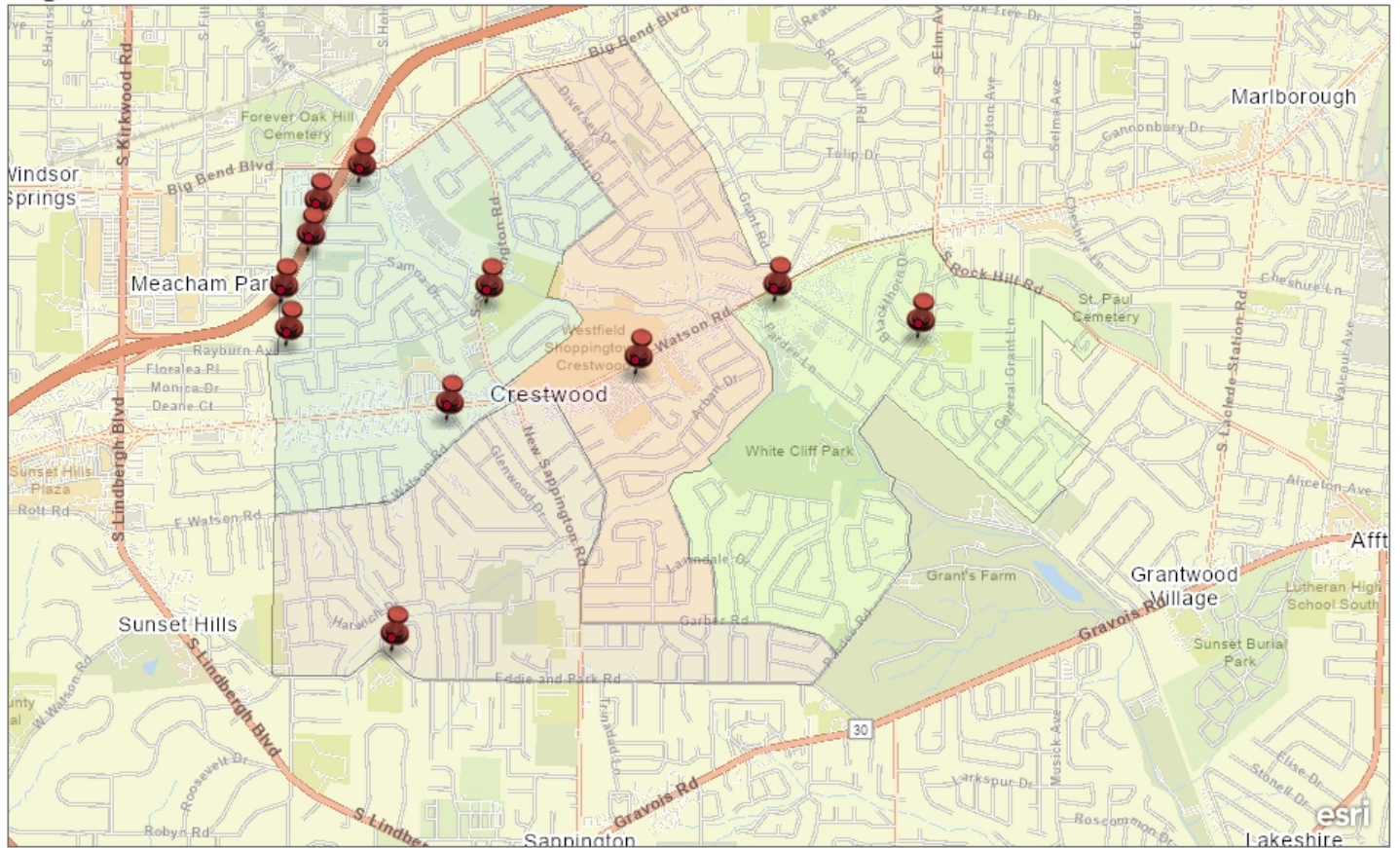

Detective Bureau Performance:

In August, 63 supplemental reports and 0 original reports were written and 3 physical arrests were made. 2 cases were *Cleared by Arrest*, 10 were *Cleared Exceptionally*, 2 were cleared by other means, and 8 were inactivated. A total of 17 cases are still marked *Active*. Not counting those that are still *Active*, the clearance rate for the bureau up to and including August was **50.7%** percent. That percentage is slightly up from 48.2% in July.

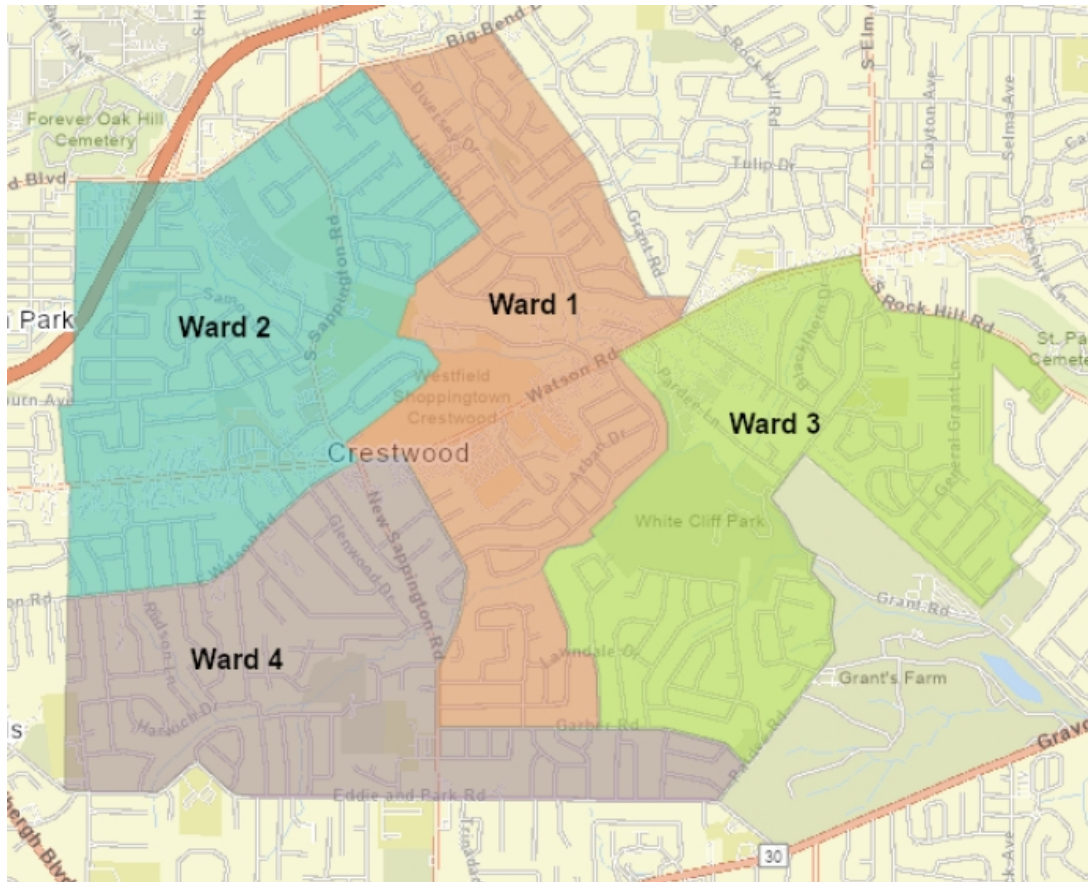

In the nation, in 2019, 45.5 % of violent crimes and 17.2 % of property crimes were cleared by arrest or exceptional means according to the Criminal Justice Information Services Division.

Ward Incident Summary:



Ward 1:

In August 2022, one stealing offenses and one property damage offense that was reported as damage to a vehicle occurred in Ward 1. Two motor vehicle thefts occurred on Watson Rd at two separate businesses. There was one minor assault that occurred at a business on Watson Industrial Park Dr and one fraud report was taken for fraudulent use of a credit card. One driver was taken into custody for a drug offense on Watson Rd near Watson Industrial Park Dr. Officers responded to 21 calls for suspicious activity on 11 different streets during the month of August. There were also 2 animal related calls, 1 juvenile offense, 32 people related calls, and 56 miscellaneous police calls reported.

Police handled 119 calls for service in Ward 1 in August 2022.

Ward 2:

In August 2022, there were five stealing offenses reported and three property damage reports taken. Two of them were for damage city property in Spellman Park and one report was for damage to a vehicle. Five motor vehicle thefts were reported on Glenwood Dr, Sessions Ave, Townhiill Dr and Lodge Dr. One minor assault occurred at Sam's Club on Big Bend Blvd and two fraud reports were taken for fraudulent use of a credit card and a fraudulent prescription. Police responded to 8 traffic accidents that occurred on Big Bend Blvd, I-44, Arrowwood Dr, and Watson Rd. There were 24 suspicious activity calls responded to on 13 different streets in Ward 2, along with 2 animal related calls, 1 family offense, 2 juvenile offenses, 29 people related calls and 111 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 193 calls for service in Ward 2 in August 2022.

Ward 3:

In August 2022 there were three stealing reports were taken and one motor vehicle theft was reported on Watson Rd. Police responded to two traffic accidents on Watson Rd, and Flamingo Dr. There were 22 calls for suspicious activity on 12 different streets, and two animal related calls. Officers responded to 31 people related calls and 60 miscellaneous police calls in Ward 3.

Police handled 121 calls for service in Ward 3 in August 2022.

Ward 4:

In August 2022 officers took three reports for property damage, two reported were damage to vehicles and the third was damage to freshly poured concrete. There was one motor vehicle theft in Ward 4 that occurred on Del Vista Dr. Two traffic accidents occurred on Watson Rd, and Beth Dr. We received 13 calls for suspicious activity on 9 different streets, 20 people related calls, 1 animal related call, and 22 miscellaneous police calls.

Police handled 62 calls for service in Ward 4 in August 2022.
