Low Income Trash Enrollment Program Eligibility

- A program application must be filed with the City Clerk’s Office before being forwarded to the Public Works Department. Pricing for the program is \$5.23 per month or \$15.69 quarterly.
- To qualify for this program, residents must meet or fall below the St. Louis County low income threshold. Participants must have an income (from all sources) of less than \$43,050 for one person or \$49,200 for two people. Please ask for assistance if there are additional persons in your household.
- **Senior residents** must qualify for the low income threshold *and* be at least 60 years of age or older. For the regular senior citizen rate of 10% off, residents must be 65 years old and contact Waste Connections at 636-321-2100 to set up that discount.
- **Disabled residents** must qualify for the low income threshold *and* provide a signed doctor’s note stating their disability for verification.
