Re: Notice of Unlawful Occupancy – Vacate Premises by Wed, Jan. 28

Dear Occupant,

On January 8, 2026 you received a letter serving as formal notice of unlawful occupancy of the structure known and numbered as 8500-8506 Park Crestwood. You are hereby ordered to vacate the premises immediately and to seek alternative housing. Continued occupancy of the building after receipt of this notice constitutes a violation of § 7-191 of the Municipal Code of the City of Crestwood, Missouri (the “Code”), and may subject you to prosecution, fines, and/or arrest.

At 12 p.m. Wednesday, January 28, representatives from the City of Crestwood will inspect each unit of the building to ensure the premises are vacant. If you are still occupying your unit, you will be evicted and cited.
