Special conditions of this permit are listed below:

- 1) Permittee must meet the requirements of Crestwood Municipal Code, Chapter 9, Section 9-37, (13). Which states the following;
*Civic, public or community organizations may purchase and use fireworks for pyrotechnical displays, upon the issuance of a permit by the Mayor. All applications for permits shall be in writing and filed at least 30 days in advance of the date of the display or discharge. Any applicant for permit shall provide proof of insurance in an amount determined to be adequate for the payment of all damages which may be caused to person or property by reason of such display and to protect, indemnify and hold the **City of Crestwood** harmless against any claims for damages arising out of any such display. Upon provision of insurance as herein required and a determination by the Code Official that all necessary safeguards against hazards are being provided, the Mayor shall issue a permit.

- 2) Permittee must supply the Crestwood Department of Fire Services with the specifics of the fireworks display for approval and abide by the Fire Department's direction.
- 3) At least two (2) fire extinguishers are to be on site. The equipment shall be charged and in good working order.
- 4) The pyrotechnician performs within the guidelines set forth in the NFPA Standard 1123.
- 5) Permittee must notify the nearby residential and business properties of the fireworks display at least five days prior to the event.
- 6) All displays will be detonated from the designated shooting area only.**
- 7) The shell boxes shall be buried 2/3 the height of the container housing the shells.
- 8) The shell boxes used for detonation shall be constructed of wood or metal, no cardboard containers will be allowed.
- 9) The location of the viewing area shall be approved by the Department of Fire Services and secured by the Crestwood Fire Department.
- 10) Only after a final inspection by the Police and Fire Departments will final consent be granted.
