**Call to Order:**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Board President Bland led everyone in the pledge of allegiance.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Police Board President Bland requested a motion to approve the May 16, 2016 minutes. Mr. Prior made a motion and Mr. Kreilich seconded the motion. Motion carried and was declared passed.

**General Business:**

**Police Department Report: (Chief Arnoldy)**

Chief Arnoldy discussed the following:

May Report:

- 3 burglaries from residences on Cassia, Whitehaven and Royal Arms.
- 37 stealing offenses mostly from unlocked vehicles.
- 7 shopliftings
- 15 property damages, some being to unlocked cars

June Report:

- 17 stealings
- 9 shopliftings

- 6 property damages with one being graffiti in Crestwood Park.
- 2 stolen vehicles – a 2006 Silverado truck from the Jim Butler lot that has not been recovered. The second being a Honda motorcycle taken from a residence on Apex and recovered two days later on 700 block of Samoa, investigation ongoing.

**Missouri Police Chief Accreditation Process:**

- Still waiting to begin in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter.

**Appreciation from Residents:**

- There has been an out pouring of residents sending cards and visiting the Police Department with food, showing support and understanding for what they are going through daily during these trying times.

**Vehicle Purchases:**

- Outfitting of the cars was completed and both put in service in June. A 2014 car was unmarked.

**Aldermanic Report:**

**Alderman Charboneau:**

- B.O.A. adopted Robert’s rules for meeting procedures, new time limits and agenda order will be implemented.
- Ordinance regarding a crosswalk at Eddie & Park / Robyn Road
- An artist was commissioned to develop glass artwork in the Stix, Baer and Fuller store, many years ago in the old Crestwood Mall location. Rather than allow them to be destroyed, the City purchased the panels. The panels were inspired by Mrs. Charles Lindbergh’s book and will be displayed at City Hall.

- Due to the current events of late, Deputy Chief Compton designated new temporary orders to better protect the officers in field operations. Soft body armor is mandatory and deployment will involve backup with a third car to protect the scene if necessary.
