Approval of Minutes

Board of Aldermen Report

Alderman Stadter reported that items addressed at the last Board of Aldermen meeting included the approval of the site plan for Planet Fitness, postponing a site plan for AGI leasing and finishing a bill amending restrictions on commercial vehicles on residential streets. A toll road permit was granted for the Knights of Columbus. There was a 1st reading of an ordinance enabling the City of Crestwood to join the "Show Me PACE" program and there was discussion of an ordinance amending the public service fee schedule.

New Business

Mr. Krauska suggested a planting around the sign at The Barn restaurant. It was decided to plant bulbs and mums on October 8.

The August Yard of the Month winners were decided.
