**General Business:**

**Police Department Report:**

Deputy Chief Compton discussed the following:

- 2 burglaries, 1 an attempt at Rich & Charlie's, glass broken to front door, no entry gained. The other was a bicycle stolen from an open garage on Vauk Lane.
- 3 assaults, all were domestic violence with people who knew each other.
- 20 stealings, 10 of which were shopliftings, 5 drive offs, 3 stealings from vehicles, 2 unclassified.
- 1 property damage to a residence.

**Missouri Police Chief Accreditation Process:**

Sgt. David Gray continues to make progress issuing General Orders for the Department.

**Hiring Process for Officer and Dispatcher:**

There are currently two positions open for Police officer. Previously 12 people had applied but didn't get through backgrounds. The new hiring process started in April with 15 new applicants, 6 of which are strong candidates. A Dispatcher position that was available has now been filled.

**Personnel:**

Hannah Wilson has completed training and will be working on her own in Dispatch. A newly hired Officer Alan Sutton will be starting with the Department on May 4, 2017.

**Sally Port Project:**

The contract has been completed and work should begin soon.

**V-Academy Training:**

It is a very helpful tool and Officers are consistently using this option to assist in completing required training hours.

**2017 Vehicles:**

The new cars are equipped and waiting for gun rack adjustments.
