Municipal Judge

The City of Crestwood, Missouri is inviting qualified persons to apply for the position of Municipal Judge for the City of Crestwood, Missouri.

About Crestwood and it's Municipal Court

The City of Crestwood, population 11,905, has an excellent location as an "inner ring" suburb of St. Louis, Missouri, with direct access to downtown St. Louis as well as the rest of the St. Louis Metropolitan Area. Located just 15 miles southwest of the downtown area, Crestwood is in South St. Louis County, and residents enjoy access to all of the services and amenities offered within Crestwood and the St. Louis region.

The Crestwood Municipal Court is a division of St. Louis County Circuit Court. The Municipal Court adjudicates violations of various local ordinances, including driving while intoxicated, assaults, domestic violence, traffic offenses, stealing, housing, zoning, and other municipal violations.

Crestwood's Municipal Court seeks to provide the public with a place to obtain a fair and impartial judgment on any alleged violation of a city ordinance.

The Municipal Court generally holds two sessions per month, except when there is a trial docket, in which case there are three sessions that month.

In addition to the Municipal Judge, the Municipal Court is staffed by a Court Administrator and a part-time assistant. A Provisional Judge is also available to cover in the event of illness, absence, or conflicts-of-interest.

The Municipal Judge will be expected to maintain Crestwood's compliance with the Missouri Supreme Court's minimum operating standards.

The Ideal Candidate

The Municipal Judge must be a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar Association, and at least twenty-one (21) years of age.

The City seeks applicants with legal experience in municipal law, prosecution, criminal defense, and possessing judicial experience or training.

Crestwood's Municipal Judge must be well-versed in all of the changes that have taken place as a result of recent Municipal Court reforms.

Residency within the City of Crestwood is required, and it is strongly preferred that Crestwood's next Municipal Judge not serve as a judge or prosecutor for other municipalities.

Compensation and Benefits

Compensation is established by the Board of Aldermen, and is set at \$1,000 paid monthly.

Selection

The Municipal Judge is appointed by the Mayor of Crestwood, with the consent and approval of the Board of Aldermen.
