Crestwood Mayor Gregg Roby Resigns

CRESTWOOD, MO June 5, 2018 – Crestwood Mayor Gregg Roby announced his resignation, effective Friday, June 8th, to concentrate on his health and family.

In his resignation letter to the Board of Aldermen, Mayor Roby says, “It has been my honor to serve with each of you and will remember all the great strides we have made as a board. I wish each of you great success in your continued efforts to make Crestwood a community we can all be proud of. I am confident that Crestwood will flourish over the coming years under your leadership. I am proud to call you all friends and thank you for your support over the last 4 years.”

Crestwood’s Charter provides that the President of the Board of Aldermen serve as Acting Mayor until a special election can be held. Alderman Tony Kennedy currently serves as Board President and will become Acting Mayor on Friday, June 8. A special election for the office of Mayor of the City of Crestwood is tentatively planned for Tuesday, November 6.
