PUBLIC PROTECTION CLASSIFICATION REVIEW



- > ISO collects & evaluates information from communities across the U.S. on their structure fire suppression capabilities.
- > The data is analyzed using a Fire Suppression Rating Schedule (FSRS).
- > A Public Protection Classification (PPC) grade is then assigned to the community.
- > A community's investment in fire mitigation is a proven and reliable predictor of future fire losses.



- > Statistical data on insurance losses bears out the relationship between excellent fire protection and low fire loses.
- Insurance companies use PPC information for <u>marketing</u>, <u>underwriting</u>, <u>and to help establish fair premiums for homeowners</u> <u>& commercial fire insurance</u>.
- ➤ In general, the price of fire insurance in a community with a good PPC grade is substantially lower than in a community with a poor PPC grade.



- > A community's PPC grade depends on the following factors:
 - Needed Fire Flows for fire suppression
 - Emergency Communications
 - Fire Department
 - Water Supply
- > A community's PPC grade will range from 1 to 10.
- Class 1 represents an Exemplary Fire Suppression Program.
- Class 10 indicates that the area's fire suppression program does not meet ISO's minimum criteria.





PPC Grade

The PPC grade assigned to the community will depend on the community's score on a 100-point scale:

PPC	Points		
1	90.00 or more		
2	80.00 to 89.99		
3	70.00 to 79.99		
4	60.00 to 69.99		
5	50.00 to 59.99		
6	40.00 to 49.99		
7	30.00 to 39.99		
8	20.00 to 29.99		
9	10.00 to 19.99		
10	0.00 to 9.99		



- Crestwood Fire Department has historically been rated with a Public Protection Classification = 4.
- ➤ Our last PPC rating was completed in 2007 which also resulted in a PPC = 4.

- **Emergency Communications:**
 - CCE911 Dispatch Center
- >Fire Department:
 - Deployment
 - Company Personnel
 - Training
 - Operational Considerations SOG's, Risk Reduction & Fire Prevention
- ➤ Divergence
 - Better balance in all categories resulted in reducing the negative effect

NATIONWIDE STATISTICS



- ►ISO surveys nearly 50,000 Fire Departments:
 - Only 132 are rated a Class 1 (0.3%)
 - Only 1,060 are rated a Class 2 (2.0%)
- Crestwood Fire Department as a Class 2 ranks in the 98th percentile nationwide!

THE FUTURE...



- > Crestwood Fire Department received 89.97 total points.
- > The cut-off for a Class 1 is 90.00 total points.
- ➤ We are only 0.03 hundredths of a point from a Class 1!

A NOTE OF CAUTION...



- The demolition of the old mall buildings had a significant positive effect on our final PPC rating because ISO bases some of its calculations on the ability of the Fire Department to mitigate a structure fire in the (5) largest buildings in a community.
- ➤ When the mall was demolished, our (10) largest buildings were eliminated.
