



RESOLUTION NO. 18-12

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE ELECTION OF FIVE ALDERMEN ON APRIL 2, 2019.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Crestwood, Missouri, the following elections shall occur in the General Election to be held in the City of Crestwood, Missouri, on Tuesday, April 2, 2019, (1) the election of four Aldermen, one from each Ward of the City of Crestwood, for a term of three (3) years, which term shall expire in April, 2022; and (2) the election of one Alderman from Ward Three for the remainder of the unexpired term, which expires in April 2021; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Charter of the City of Crestwood, Missouri and applicable laws of the State of Missouri, the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County, Missouri shall conduct all elections; and

WHEREAS, the General Election of the City of Crestwood, Missouri shall conform to the rules adopted by the Board of Election Commissioners and applicable state law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crestwood, Missouri as follows:

1. There shall be an election in the City of Crestwood, Missouri on Tuesday, April 2, 2019 for the purpose of electing four Aldermen, one from each Ward, for terms of three (3) years, which terms shall expire in April, 2022; and electing one Alderman from Ward Three to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the current unexpired term, which term expires in April, 2021.
2. Candidates may file for an office and have their names printed on the ballot by filing with the City Clerk or her designee: a Notice of Candidacy; a Petition as provided in the Municipal Code, Section 8-5; and paying a filing fee as provided in Municipal Code, Section 8-5.


Candidates may file their Notice of Candidacy and supporting Petition(s) with the City Clerk or her designee beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 11, 2018, and not later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 15, 2019.

In accordance with Section 115.124.2, RSMo., the names of candidates who file a declaration of candidacy prior to 5:00 p.m. on the first day of filing shall appear on the ballot in an order determined by a random drawing. The City Clerk shall record the number drawn with the candidate's declaration of candidacy. The names of candidates filing on the first day of filing for each office on each ballot shall be listed in ascending order of the numbers so drawn. A representative of a candidate who filed under Section 115.355.2, RSMo. may draw a number at random at the time of filing. The names of all candidates who file a declaration of candidacy after 5:00 p.m. on the first day of filing shall be listed after those filing on the first day of filing in the order in which the declarations of candidacy were filed.

3. The election shall be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2019 and the polls shall open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.
4. Only registered voters who are residents of the City of Crestwood will be eligible to vote at said election.
5. At least 15 days before the opening date for filing a Notice of Candidacy, the City Clerk shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City and shall post such Notice in the City Government Center stating:
 - (a) The offices to be filled;
 - (b) The opening filing date and the closing filing date for the filing of Notice of Candidacy and supporting petitions and copies of affidavits;
 - (c) The place for filing the Notice of Candidacy, petition and affidavits.
 - (d) Copies of the Notice of Candidacy may be obtained from the City Clerk.
6. Under the existing laws of the State of Missouri, the Board of Election Commissioners of St. Louis County shall publish once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks, a "Notice of Election", the first publication occurring at least fourteen (14) days prior to the election and the last publication occurring within one (1) week prior to the election.


The Board of Aldermen may adopt other Resolutions to submit additional matters at said Election.
