



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BEFORE BOARD OF ALDERMEN

Representatives of the City of Crestwood and Teamsters Local Union No. 610 have negotiated a tentative collective bargaining agreement regarding the terms and conditions of employment for the City's Police Officers and Detectives including probationary Police Officers/Detectives, but excluding the Chief, Deputy Chief, Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants, Dispatchers and Clerical Employees of the Police Department. Before the tentative agreement is presented to the bargaining representative or Board of Aldermen for ratification, Missouri law requires that such tentative agreement be discussed in detail in a public meeting and that such tentative agreement be published on the City's website at least five business days prior to the public meeting.

The terms of the tentative agreement will be presented and discussed during a public hearing scheduled at the beginning of the Board of Aldermen Meeting, which will begin at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 27, 2018, at City Hall. During the public hearing, the public shall be permitted to provide comment on the tentative agreement.
