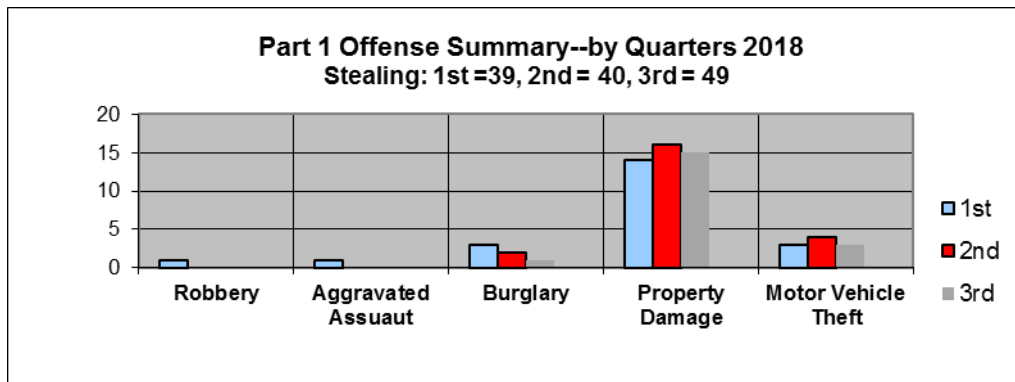
Comparison of Quarters and Years: Part 1 Crimes / Part 2 Crimes:

This chart shows the level of Part 1 crimes reported during the Third quarter of each year from 1997 through 2018.

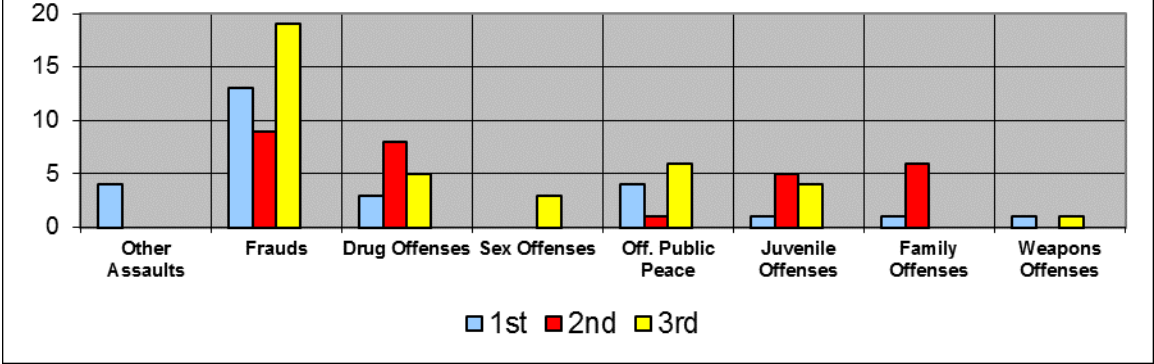




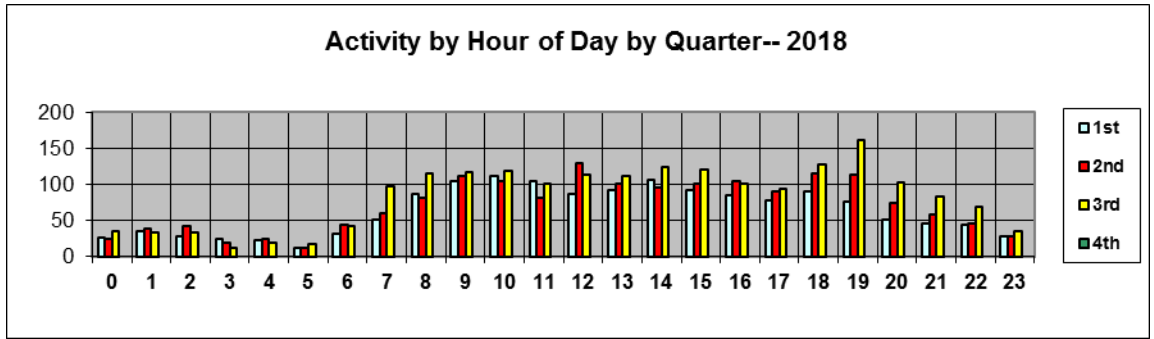
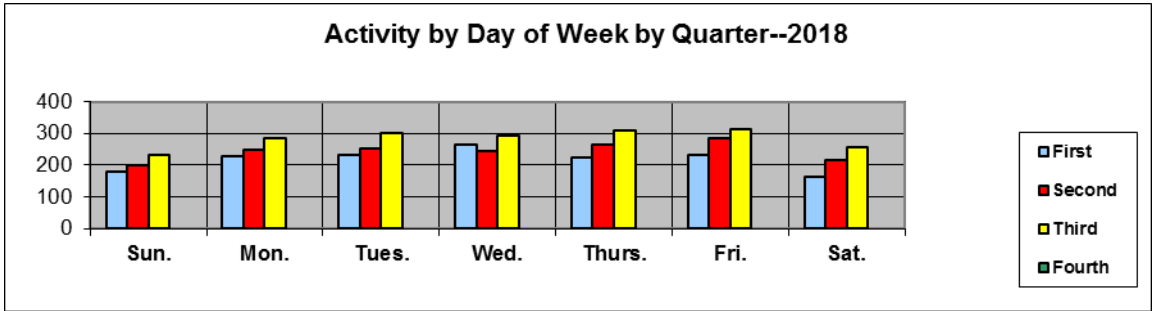

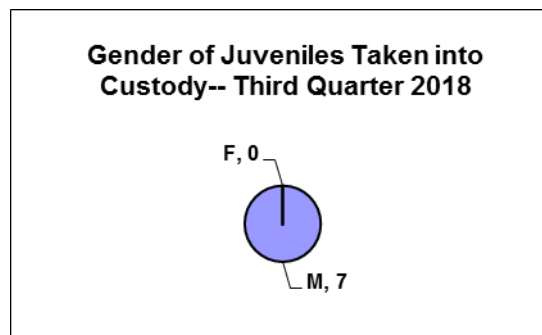
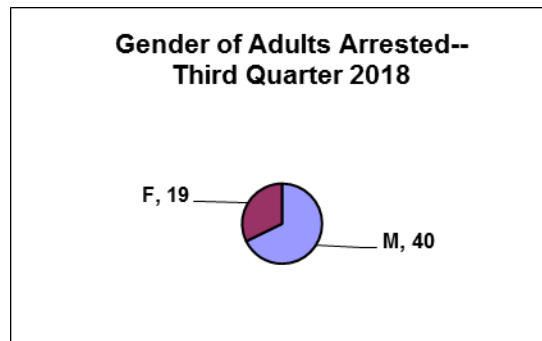
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

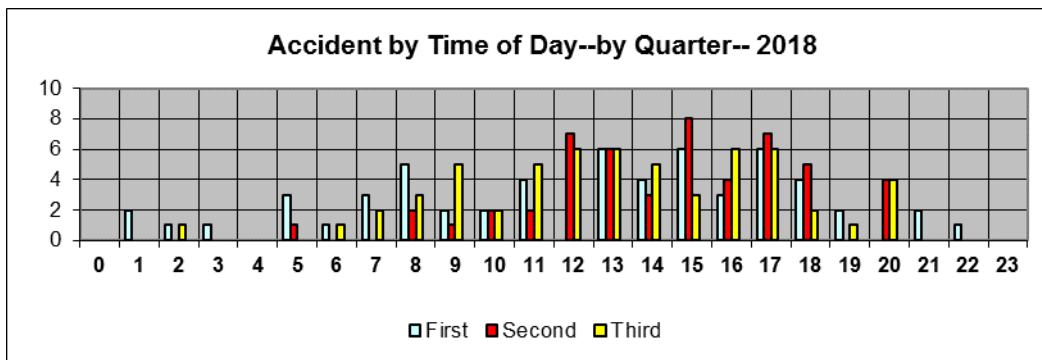

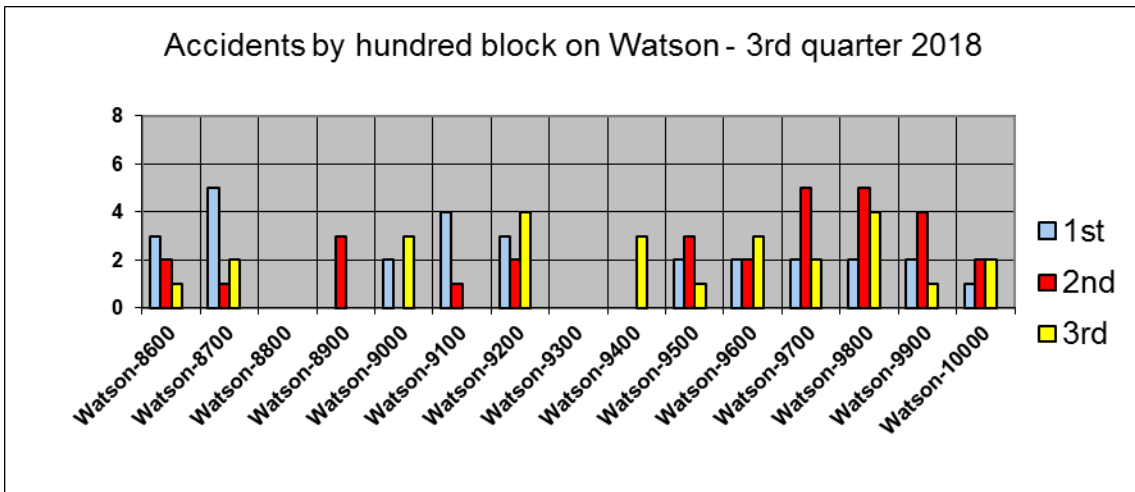

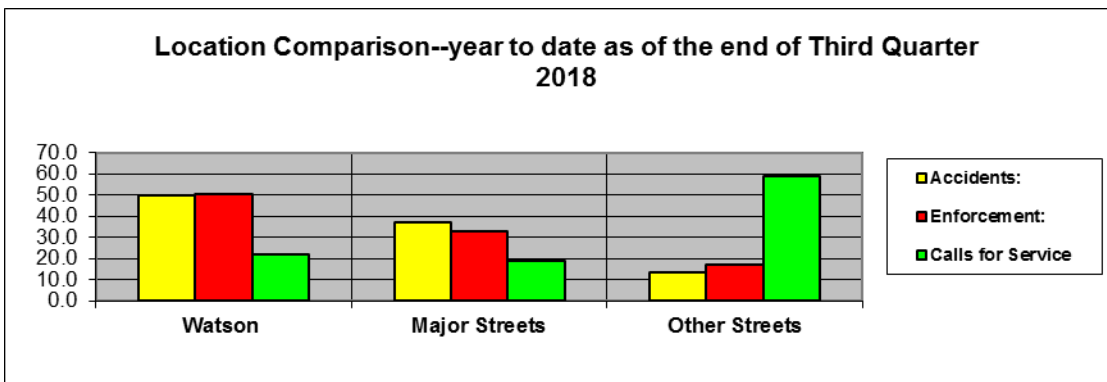
