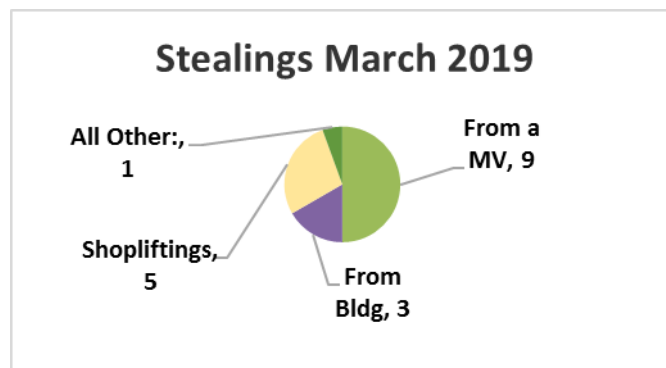
Subject: March 2019 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of March 2019. In March 2019, there were 24 Part I offenses and 366 Part II offenses, for a total of 390. This compares with 21 Part I offenses and 365 Part II offenses for a total of 386 in March 2018.

Burglary: A vehicle and vehicle accessories were stolen from a business located in the 8800 block of Grant Rd. All stolen items were recovered.

Stealing offenses numbered eighteen in March 2019.

Stealings were of the following classifications in March 2019:

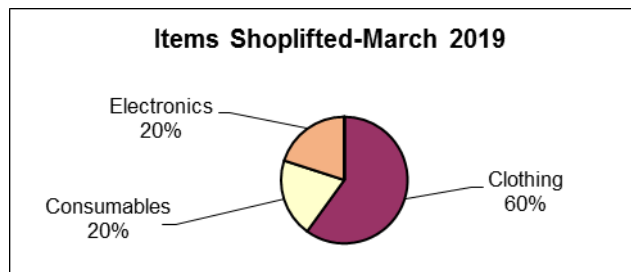


Shopliftings accounted for five of the eighteen stealing events in March 2019. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores.

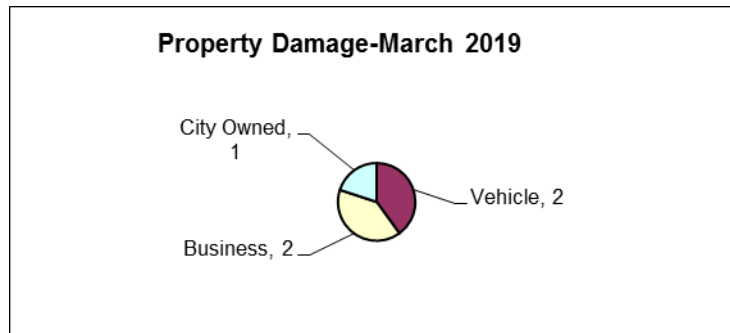

Part I offenses numbered 24 in March 2019.

Part II offenses:

In March 2019, there were two assaults investigated. These assaults involved persons who knew each other. There was eight fraud offense involving identity theft, passing bad checks, forgery and fraudulent use of a credit device. There was one sex offense reported, the police know the parties involved and are investigating. There were eighteen traffic accidents, three of which were leaving the scene offenses. There were ten animal calls and 78 people related calls. There were 29 suspicious activities investigated by police. There was 220 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II offenses totaled 366 in March 2019.

Ward Incident Summary:

In Ward One in March 2019, stealings numbered six, these offenses occurred on the following streets – Watson, Crain, Maderia, Lodge Pole and Silver Crest. Two-property damage offense were reported from Maderia Dr and Watson Industrial Dr. There was one fraud offense involving forgery reported. There was one sex offense involving juveniles being investigated. There were six traffic accidents and four animal related calls. There were seventeen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on six different streets, there were 58 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 107 calls for service in Ward one in March 2019.

In March 2019 in Ward Two, there were six stealings at addresses on Watson Rd and Big Bend Blvd. There was one property damage offense reported that occurred on Acorn Drive. There were two assault reports, one involving domestic assault and the other involving juveniles. There were also four fraud offenses investigated that occurred on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd and Sappington Rd. There were seven traffic accidents and one animal related call. There were twenty-two people related calls handled. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on three different streets. There were 94 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 144 calls for service in Ward two in March 2019.

In March 2019 in Ward Three, a burglary was reported at a business along Grand Rd. Perpetrators entered the business after hours and stole a vehicle. There were four stealing offenses occurring on Royal Arms, Whitecliff, and Pardee Rd. All involving vehicles being broken into. There was one property damage offense that occurred on Queenston Dr. There were two fraud offenses investigated along Watson Road. There were three traffic accident and one animal related calls. People related calls numbered twenty-one. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on four different streets and there were 41 miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 81 calls for service in Ward three in March 2019.

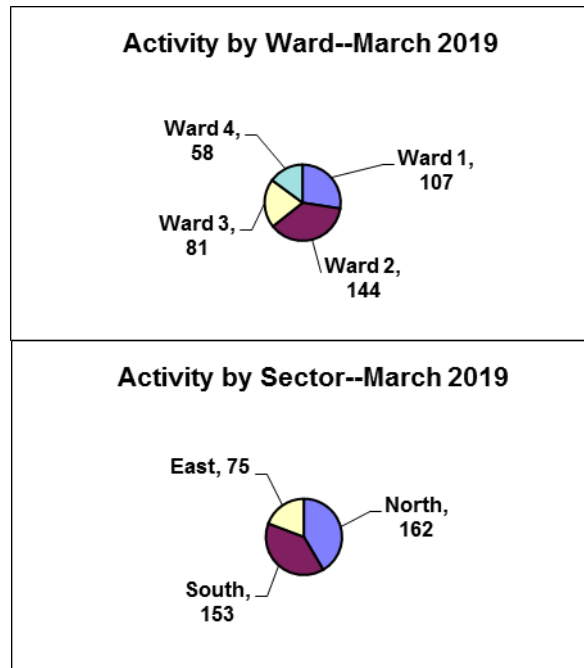
In Ward Four in March 2019, there was one stealing offense from an address on East Watson Rd. There was one property damage offense involving a vehicle break in. There was one fraud case involving forgery on Watson Rd. There were two traffic accidents and four animal related calls. There were eighteen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered four and occurred on two different streets and there were twenty-seven miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 56 calls for service in Ward four in March 2019.

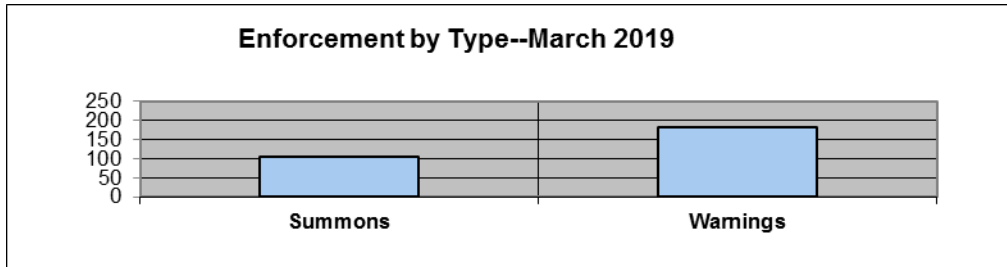

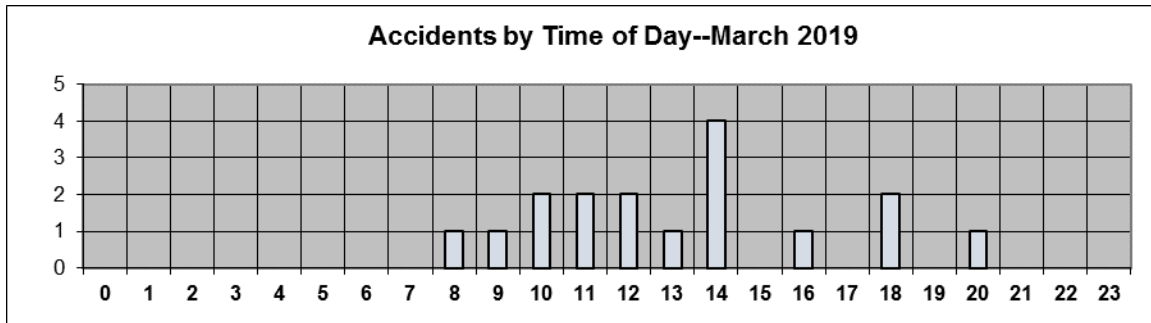

The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:

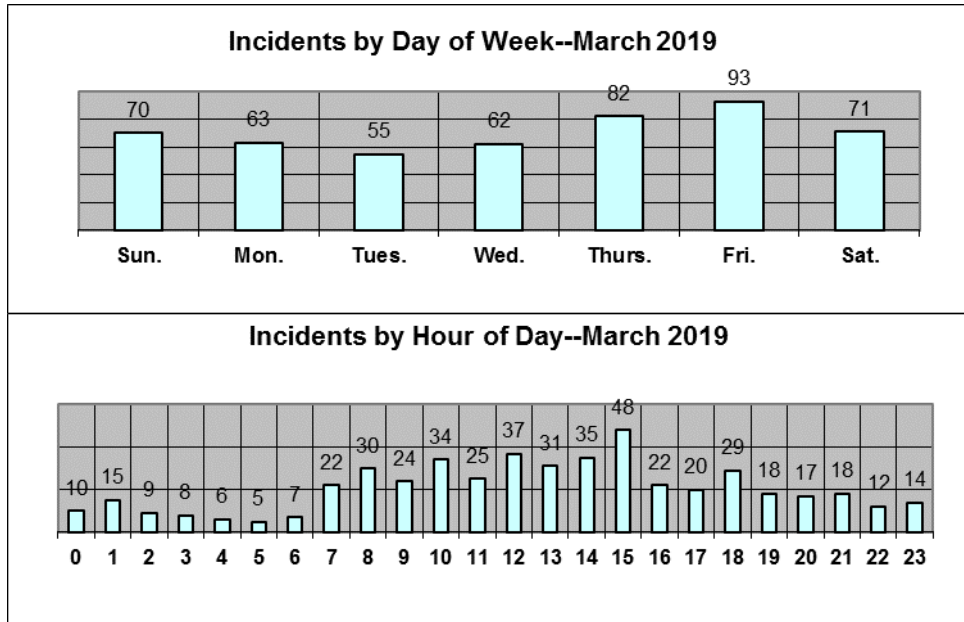

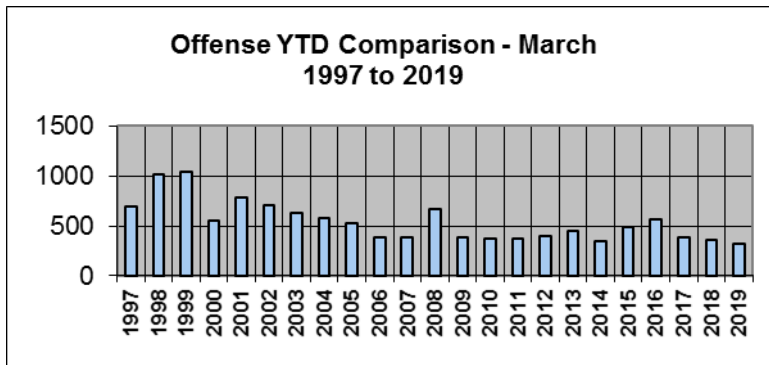

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



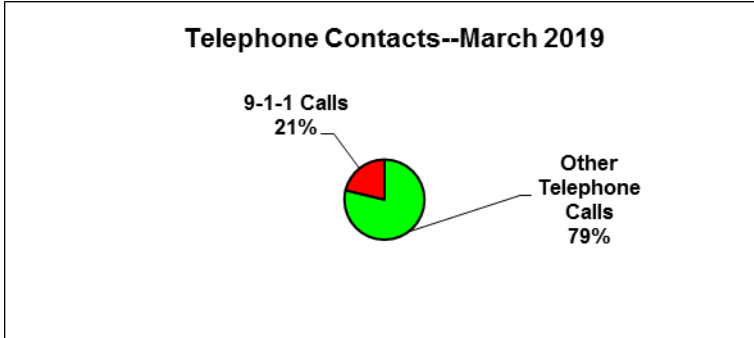
Offense Comparison:
