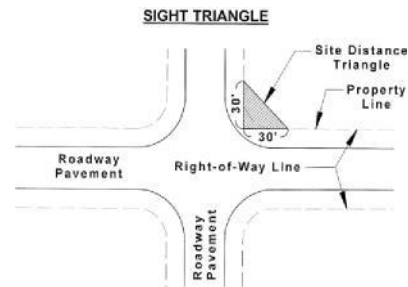

SPACE REQUIREMENTS

The Property Owner **MUST** be certain that adequate space exists for planting a tree before submitting an application. All trees must be planted in an acceptable space, therefore, the following space requirements must be met:

- 1.) The planting area or tree lawn, typically the grass area between the street and the sidewalk, must be a minimum of five (5) feet wide.
- 2.) Trees shall be planted in the middle of the tree lawn if there is a sidewalk.
- 3.) Trees shall not be planted closer than ten (10) feet to any curb if there is not a sidewalk.
- 4.) Trees shall not be planted within twenty-five (25) feet of street lights.
- 5.) Trees shall not be planted within ten (10) feet of street inlets, manholes, or fire hydrants.
- 6.) Trees shall not be planted within thirty (30) feet of an existing tree.
- 7.) No trees shall be planted directly underneath overhead utility lines or above buried utilities. Utilities will be marked prior to planting, if utilities cannot be avoided, the tree cannot be planted.
- 8.) No trees shall be planted within the sight triangle at an intersection. (see below).

<input type="checkbox"/>	Spring Snow Crabapple <i>Malus 'Spring Snow'</i> 20 ft. Yellow fall color - White flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Lacebark Elm <i>Ulmus parvifolia</i> – 40ft., Yellow/red fall color – flowers insignificant
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ginko (Princeton Sentry, male only) <i>Ginko biloba</i> – 45 ft., Yellow fall color – Green flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	American Hornbeam <i>Carpinus Carolinia</i> 30 ft. Yellow/brown fall color - lime green flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Japanese Lilac Tree <i>Syringa reticulate</i> (Ivory Silk) 15 ft., Yellow/green fall color - showy white flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Amur Maple <i>Acer ginnala</i> - 20 ft., Red fall color – Yellow/white flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Norway Maple <i>Acer platanoides</i> – 40 ft., Yellow/orange fall color – Yellow/green flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Red Sunset Maple <i>Acer rubrum</i> – 40 ft., Orange/red fall color – Red flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Trident Maple <i>Acer buergerianum</i> 20/30 ft. Yell orange fall color, green flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eastern Redbud <i>Cercis canadensis</i> (single stem) 20 ft. Yellow fall color - pink flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Robin Hill Serviceberry <i>Amelanchier 'Robin Hill'</i> (single stem) 25 ft. Yellow/orange fall color - white flowers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Red Rage Tupelo <i>Nyssa sylvatica 'Haymanred'</i> - 35 ft. Red fall color - Flowers insignificant
