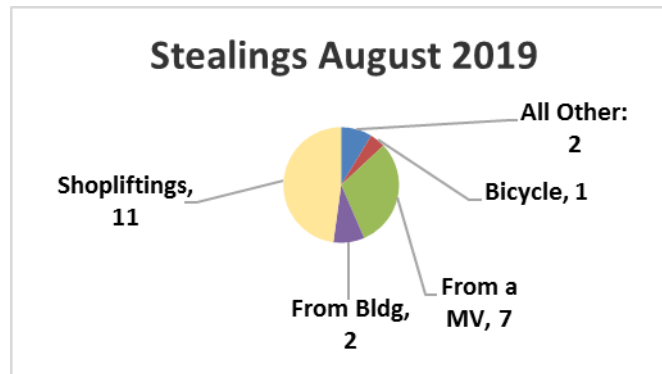
Subject: August 2019 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of August 2019. In August 2019, there were 24 Part I offenses and 407 Part II offenses, for a total of 431. This compares with 21 Part I offenses and 412 Part II offenses for a total of 433 in August 2018.

Tampering first degree. This offense involved a subject who resisted arrest and was in possession of a controlled substance.

Stealing offenses numbered twenty-three in August 2019.

Stealings were of the following classifications in August 2019:

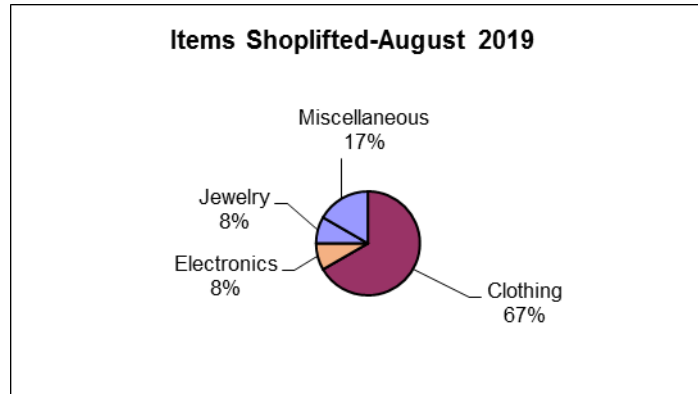


Shopliftings accounted for 11 of the twenty-three stealing events in August 2019. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores.

Of the shopliftings, eight were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 100% of the clearances.

Part I offenses numbered 24 in August 2019.

Part II offenses:

In August 2019, there were two assault reports, one involving verbal threats and the other occurred when a shoplifter was fleeing a business after an attempted theft. There were five fraud offenses involving identity theft, credit card fraud and bad checks. There was one drug offense arrest made for possession of a controlled substance. There were eighteen traffic accidents. There were three animal calls and 67 people related calls. There were 42 suspicious activities investigated by police. There were 268 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II offenses totaled 407 in August 2019.

Ward Incident Summary:

In Ward One in August 2019, stealings numbered seven; two offenses occurred on Liggett involving thefts from unlocked vehicles; four occurred at business along Watson and one from an apartment complex near Watson. Tampering first degree - this offense involved a subject who resisted arrest and was in possession of a controlled substance at a business in the 9600 blk. of Watson Road. There was one assault reported that occurred when a shoplifter was fleeing a business after an attempted theft on Watson Road.

There was one fraud offense reported involving an unlawful use of a credit card at a gas station in the 9600 blk. of Watson Road. One person was stopped by officers and arrested after being found in possession of a controlled substance. There were four traffic accidents and two animal related calls. There were thirteen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on six different streets. There were 59 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 96 calls for service in Ward one in August 2019.

In August 2019 in Ward Two, there were twelve stealings at addresses on Watson Road and Liggett Avenue. In the two thefts on Liggett, property was removed from unlocked automobiles. One of these automobiles had a firearm stolen from it. Two fraud offenses occurred at a department store on Watson involving identity theft and fraudulent use of a credit device. There were thirteen traffic accidents and one animal related calls. Twenty-one people related calls were handled and suspicious activity calls numbered seventeen and occurred on fourteen different streets. There were 107 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 173 calls for service in Ward two in August 2019.

In August 2019 in Ward Three, there were three stealing offenses that occurred on Watson, Appomattox and Grant. The theft on Grant involved over one thousand dollars in tools stolen from a locked van. One assault report was taken from an employee of a gas station on Watson where a customer threatened her. There was one fraud offense that was reported by a business on Watson involving credit card fraud. There was one traffic accident and 34 people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls

numbered five and occurred on five different streets. There were 67 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 100 calls for service in Ward three in August 2019.

In August 2019 in Ward Four, there was one stealing offense that occurred on East Watson involving a theft from a Church. There was one fraud offense that was reported by a resident of Glenwood involving credit card fraud. We responded to twelve people related calls during the period. Suspicious activity calls numbered thirteen and occurred on nine different streets. There were 35 miscellaneous police service calls.

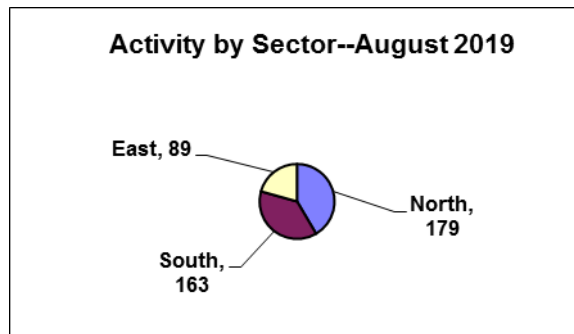
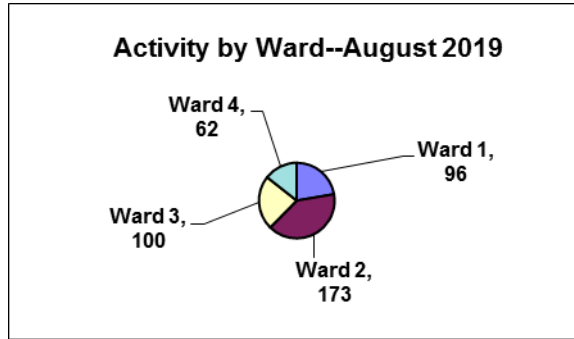
Police handled 62 calls for service in Ward four in August 2019.

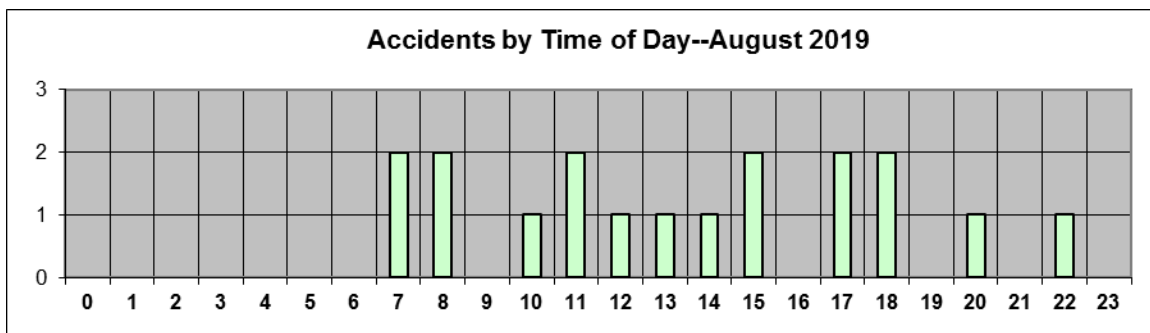

The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was:

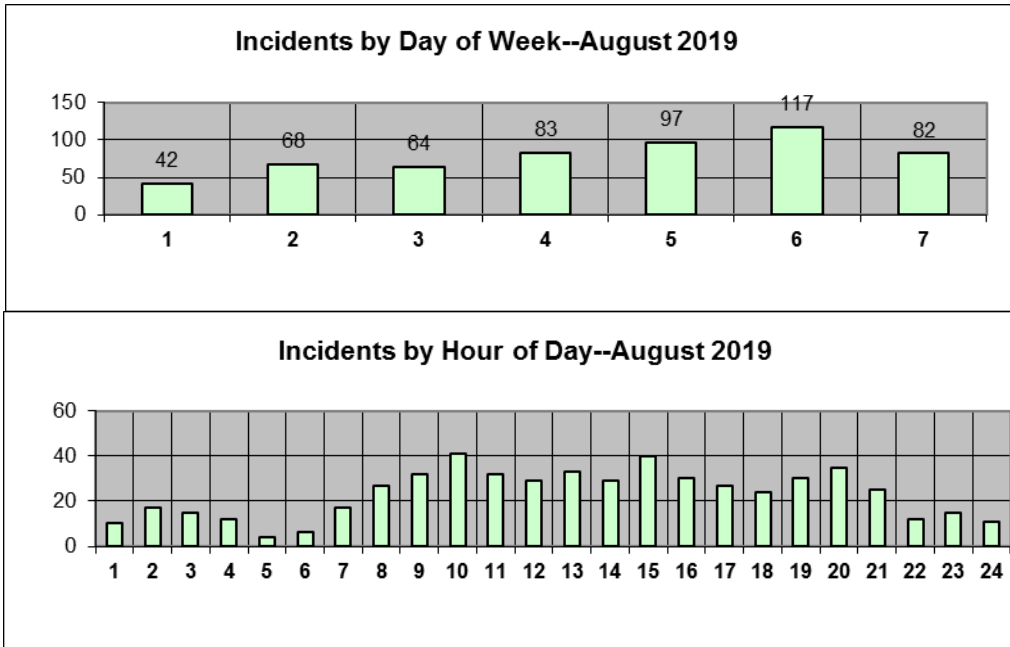

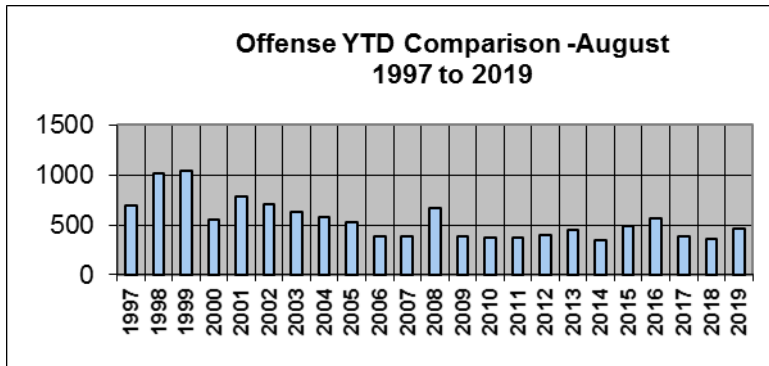

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



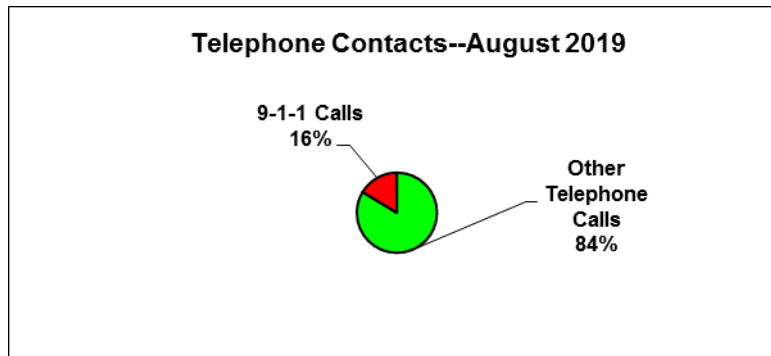
Offense Comparison:
