Subject: September 2019 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of September 2019. In September 2019, there were 24 Part I offenses and 424 Part II offenses, for a total of 448. This compares with 22 Part I offenses and 329 Part II offenses for a total of 351 in September 2018.

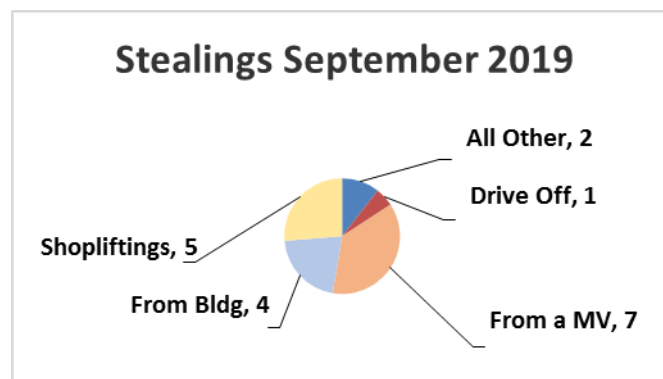
Stolen vehicle: A vehicle was stolen from a gas station on Big Bend by an adult female known by the vehicle owner. Vehicle has been recovered and suspect questioned.

Tampering with motor vehicle: There were two offenses involving vehicles that were unlocked and entered by persons unknown.

Property damage: There were two incidents involving graffiti damaging city property and private property.

Stealing offenses numbered nineteen in September 2019.

Stealings were of the following classifications in September 2019:

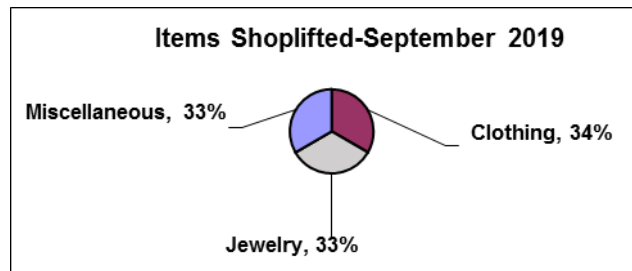


Shopliftings accounted for five of the nineteen stealing events in September 2019. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores.

Of the shopliftings, three were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 100% of the clearances.

Part I offenses numbered 24 in September 2019.

**Part II offenses:**

In September 2019, there was one assault report involving one male assaulting another. There were five fraud offenses involving identity theft, forgery and fraud. There were three drug offense arrest made for possession of a controlled substance. There were three offenses against public peace arrests for disorderly conduct and resisting arrest. There were sixteen traffic accidents. There were eight animal calls with one involving felony animal abuse. There were 80 people related calls and 49 suspicious activities investigated by police. There were two domestic violence calls investigated by police. There were 257 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II offenses totaled 424 in September 2019.

### **Ward Incident Summary:**

In Ward One in September 2019, stealings numbered three; the offenses occurred on Anchorage, Park Crestwood and Watson Road involving a theft from an unlocked vehicles, a stolen iPad from an apartment and cash and checks stolen from a residence. There were three fraud offenses reported involving an unlawful use of a credit card, identity theft and forgery. There were six traffic accidents and two animal related calls. There were fifteen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on four different streets. There was one family offense reported involving domestic violence. There were 67 miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 106 calls for service in Ward one in September 2019.

In September 2019 in Ward Two, there were ten stealings at addresses on Watson Road, Rusdon Drive and Greenview Drive. At one of the addresses, an unlocked vehicle was entered and a handgun was stolen from it. There was one property damage involving graffiti on playground equipment owned by the city. A motor vehicle theft occurred when a vehicle was unlawfully stolen by a female suspect who was known to the vehicle owner. A resident of Buxton Drive was the victim of a forgery offense when his debit card was stolen and used by a female suspect. There was one drug offense made when a male suspect was stopped by police and found in possession of a controlled substance. There was one offense against public peace arrest when a male suspect failed to yield to police, he was charged with resisting arrest by flight. There were seven traffic accidents and two animal related calls. One of the animal calls involved a felony animal abuse charge against a male subject. Sixteen people related calls were handled and suspicious activity calls numbered seventeen and occurred on nine different streets. There were 103 miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 160 calls for service in Ward two in September 2019.

In September 2019 in Ward Three, there were two stealing offenses that occurred on Watson and Grant Roads. The thefts involved stolen fuel. There was one drug offense that was discovered after police stopped a man and found drug paraphernalia. A patron of a bar on Watson Road was arrested and charged with disorderly conduct and resisting arrest. There was one traffic accident and 30 people related calls handled by

police. Suspicious activity calls numbered eleven and occurred on ten different streets. There were 41 miscellaneous police service calls. Police handled 91 calls for service in Ward three in September 2019.

In September 2019 in Ward Four, there were four stealing offense that occurred on Royal Arms, Red Oak, Harwich and Del Vista involving unlocked vehicles. There were two tampering with motor vehicles offenses involving persons entering unlocked vehicles. A male subject was arrested on Hemingway and charged with assault and property damage for ramming his car into another car. There was one fraud offense that was reported by a resident of Hemingway involving a Craigslist scam that listed her house for sale. There was one drug offense that was discovered after police stopped a man and found him in possession of marijuana. Police investigated two traffic accident and responded to nineteen people related calls during the period. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on six different streets. There was one family offense investigated involving domestic violence. There were 46 miscellaneous police service calls.

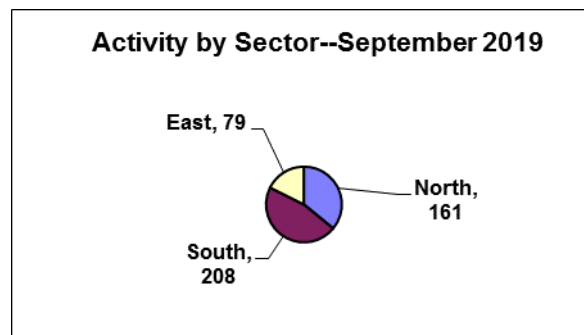
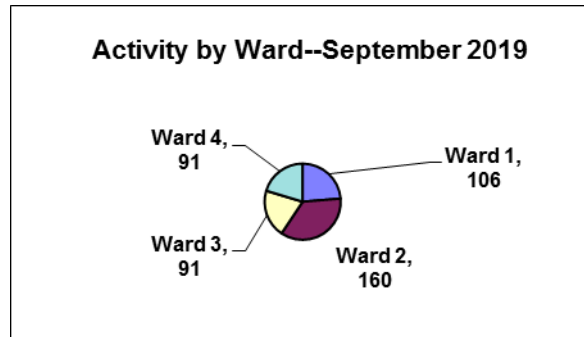
Police handled 91 calls for service in Ward four in September 2019.

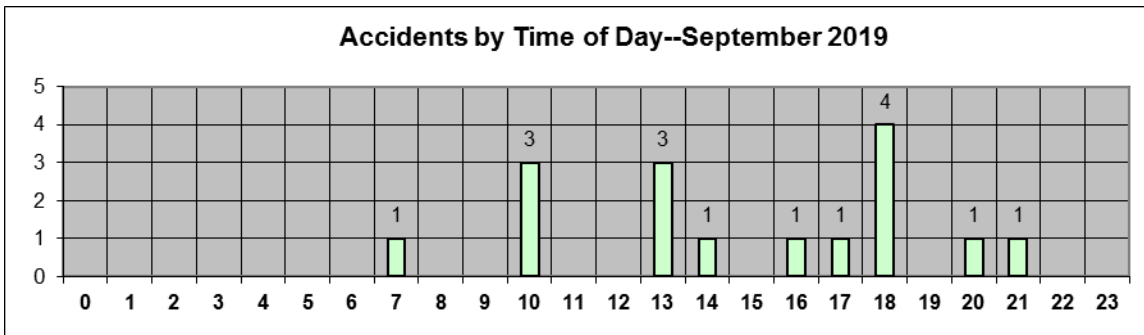

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



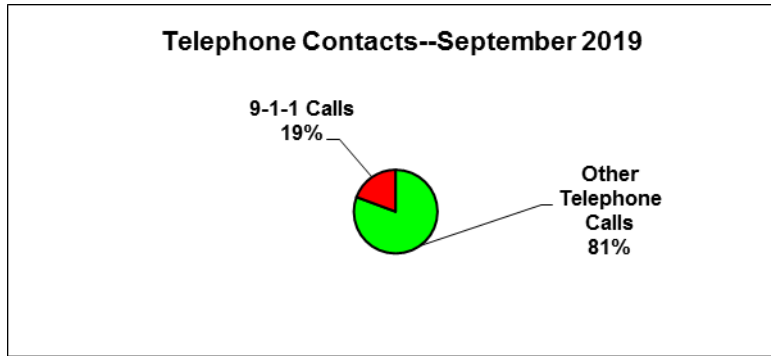
**Offense Comparison:**
