Subject: October 2019 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of October 2019. In October 2019, there were 24 Part I offenses and 394 Part II offenses, for a total of 418. This compares with 16 Part I offenses and 353 Part II offenses for a total of 369 in October 2018.

Burglary: A church located on Sappington Road was broken into and items were stolen. Detectives are investigating.

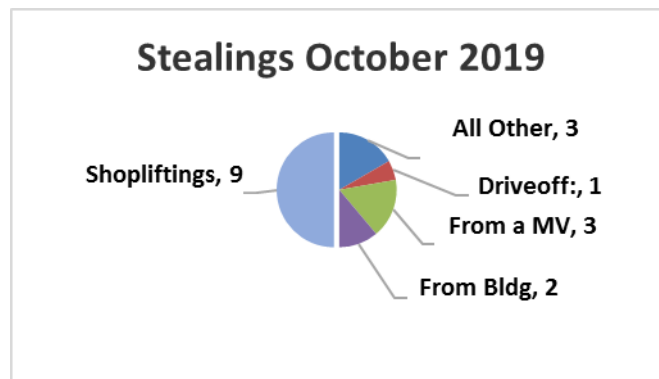
Property damage: There were three separate incidents of vehicles being damaged, one door screen was damaged on a residence.

Stolen vehicle: An unlocked vehicle was stolen from a driveway on Westglen Drive.. Vehicle has been recovered by police.

Tampering with motor vehicle: There were two offenses involving vehicles that were unlocked and entered by persons unknown.

Stealing offenses numbered eighteen in October 2019.

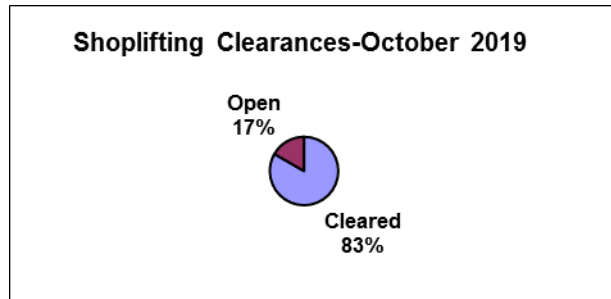

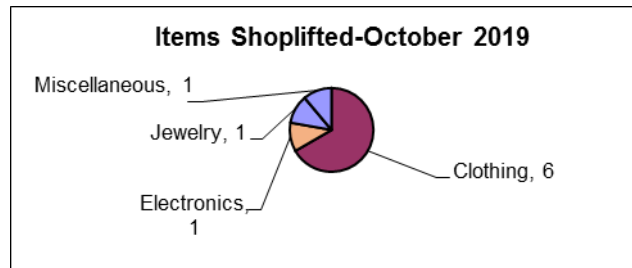
Shopliftings accounted for nine of the eighteen stealing events in October 2019. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores.

Part I offenses numbered 24 in October 2019.

Part II offenses:

In October 2019, there were two assault reports involving one female who assaulted a cashier at a gas station on Watson Road, the other assault involved threats being made to a male employee of another business. There were five fraud offenses involving identity theft, forgery and fraud. There were five drug offenses; four arrests were made for possession of a controlled substances, and one offense of illegal shipping a controlled substance is being investigated. There were twenty-three traffic accidents, five of these accidents involved drivers who left the scene after the crash. There were thirteen animal calls handled by police. There were 76 people related calls and two juvenile call investigated. Police addressed 39 suspicious activities reports. There were 229 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II offenses totaled 394 in October 2019.

Ward Incident Summary:

In Ward One in October 2019, stealings numbered one and occurred on Hutchins Drive with an arrest being made. There were two drug offense's made, one of these offenses involved the illegal shipping of a controlled substance. There were six traffic accidents and six animal related calls. There were fifteen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered fifteen and occurred on nine different streets. There were 52 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 98 calls for service in Ward one in October 2019.

In October 2019 in Ward Two, there was one burglary that occurred at a church on Sappington Road. A suspect has been investigated, charges will be brought to the attention of the prosecuting attorney. There were twelve stealings at addresses on Watson Road and Big Bend Blvd. There were two property damage offenses. One involving a rock damaging a window screen at a residence on Greenview Drive, and the other when a female driver left the scene of an accident, damaging a power pole on Sappington Road. A motor vehicle theft occurred when an unlocked vehicle was stolen from a driveway on Westglen Drive. An assault occurred when a male threatened an employee of a gas station on Watson Road. A victim of a forgery offense had his debit card stolen and used by an unknown suspect on Big Bend Blvd. There were two drug offense made by police subsequent to traffic stops, occupants were found in possession of a controlled substance. There were eight traffic accidents and one animal related call. Twenty-one people related calls were handled, suspicious activity calls numbered thirteen and occurred on eight different streets. There were 96 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 160 calls for service in Ward two in October 2019.

In October 2019 in Ward Three, there were two stealing offenses that occurred on Whitehaven and Missy Court. A female was arrested for assaulting an employee of a gas station of Watson Road. There were three fraud offenses investigated by police, these involved fraudulent use of a debit card and forgery. There was one drug offense that was discovered after police stopped a man and found drug paraphernalia. There were six traffic accident and 28 people related calls handled by police. Suspicious

activity calls numbered six and occurred on four different streets. There were 46 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 94 calls for service in Ward three in October 2019.

In October 2019 in Ward Four, there were three stealing offense that occurred on Glenwood, East Watson and Pine Spray Drive. There were two tampering with motor vehicles offenses; one involving persons entering one vehicle and the other a person kicking a vehicle. There was one fraud offense that was reported by a resident of Trillium Drive involving an unknown suspect fraudulently cashing a \$2,900 check. Police investigated three traffic accident and responded to twelve people related calls during the period. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on five different streets. There were 25 miscellaneous police service calls.

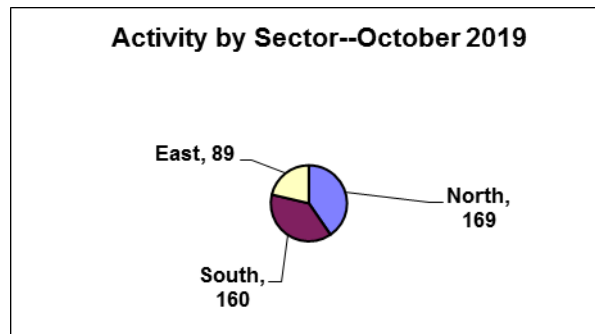
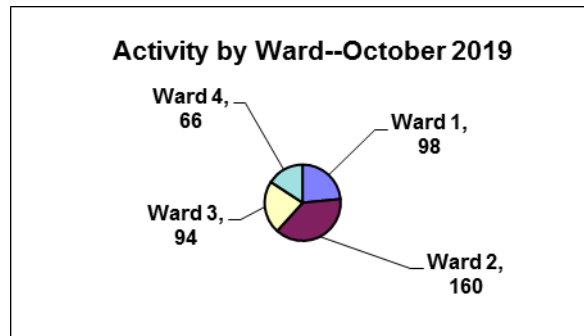
Police handled 66 calls for service in Ward four in October 2019.

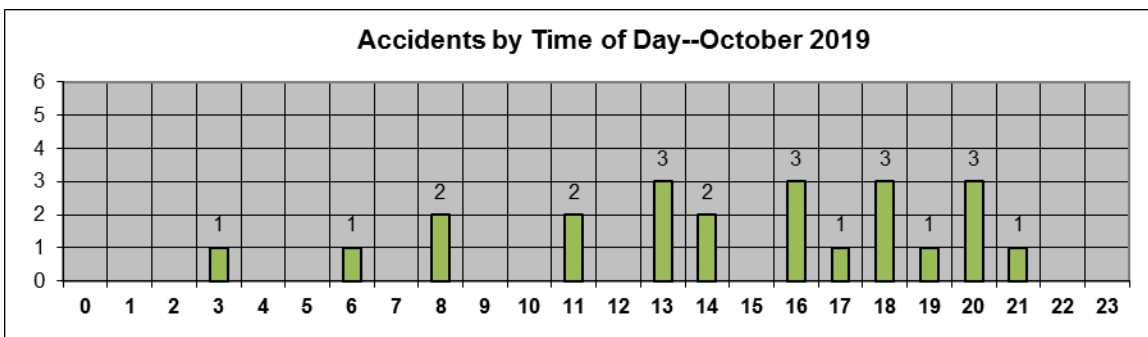

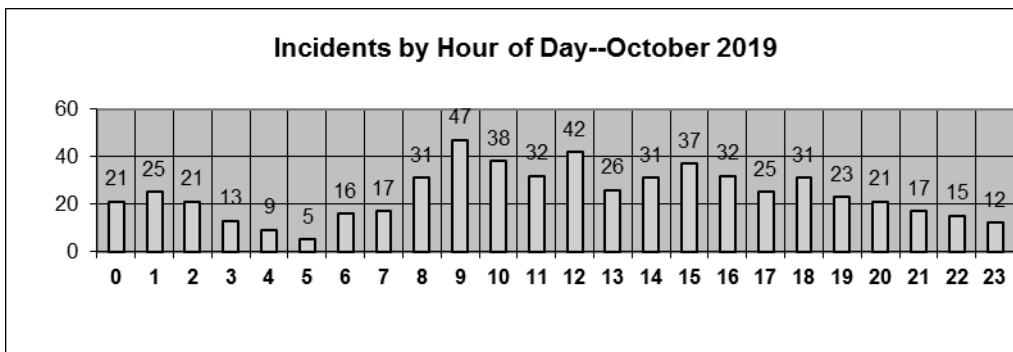
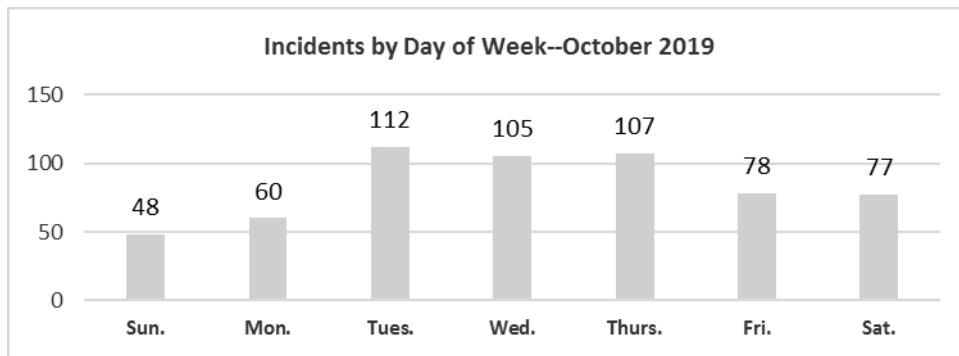
Arrest Information:

One juvenile female was taken into custody during the month.



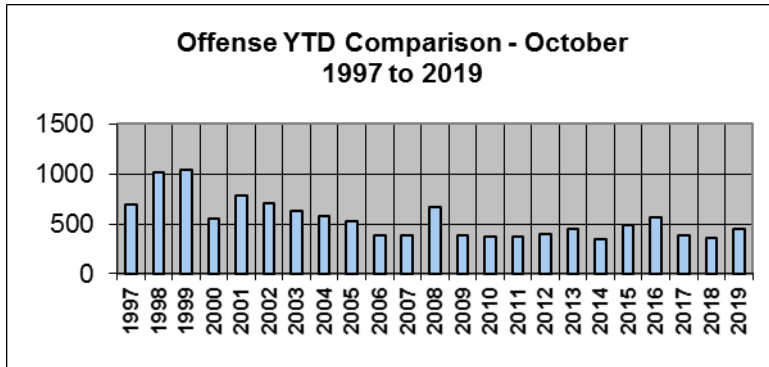

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



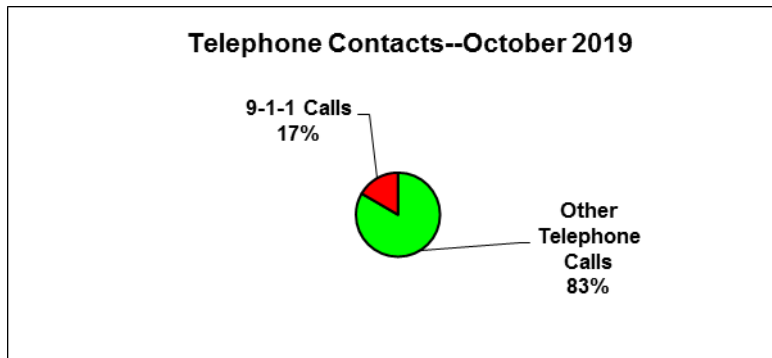
Offense Comparison:
