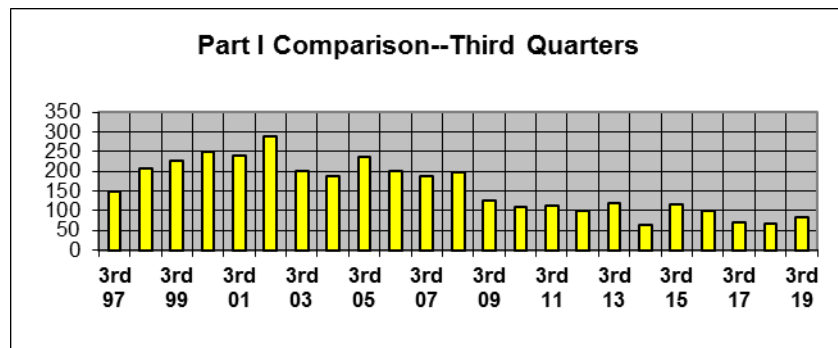

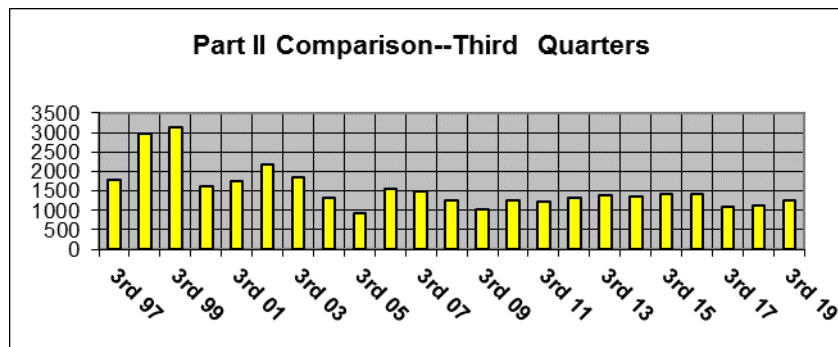

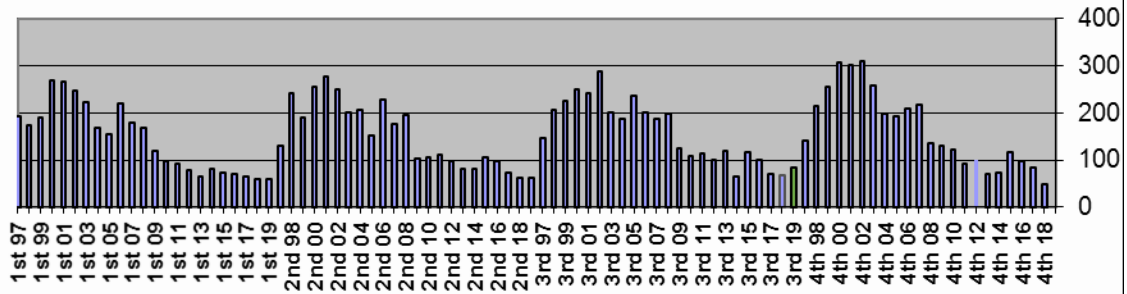
This chart shows the level of Part 1 crimes reported during the third quarter of each year from 1997 through 2019.



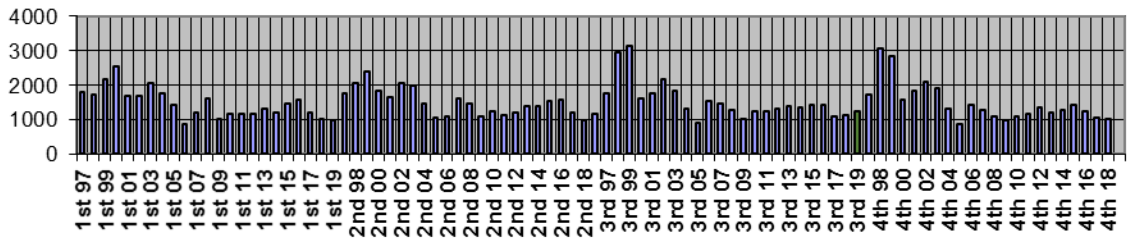
This chart shows the level of Part 2 crimes reported during the third quarter of each year from 1997 through 2019.



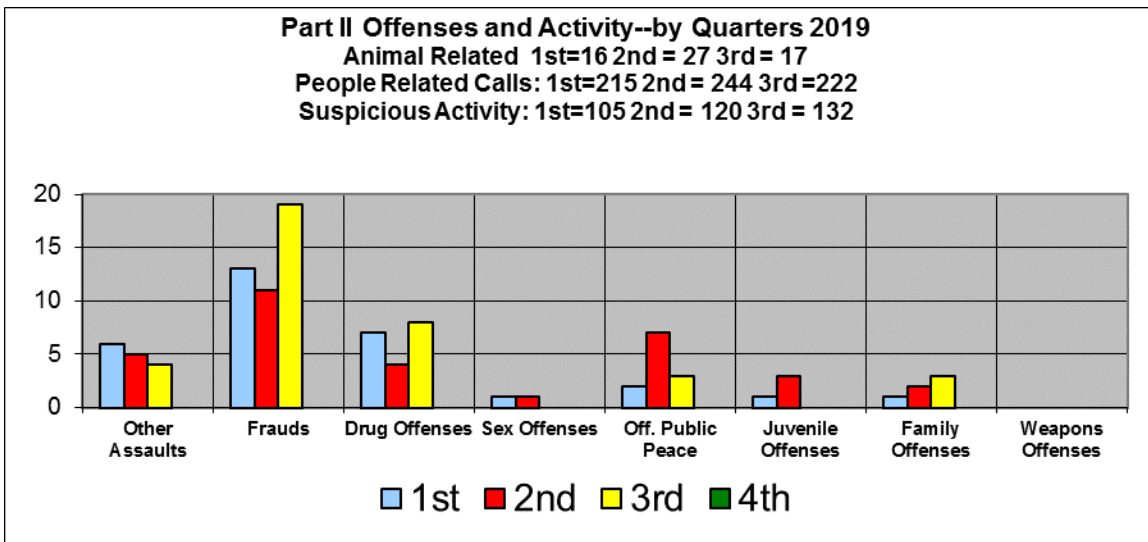
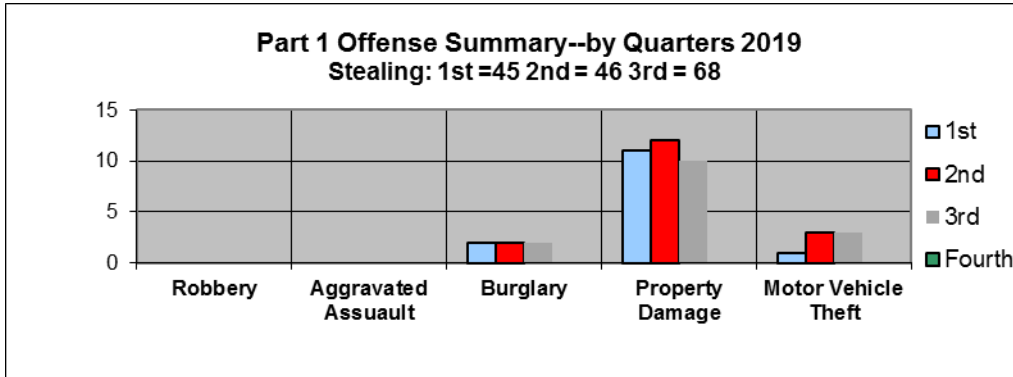
Part I Offenses for 1997 to 2019 by Quarters



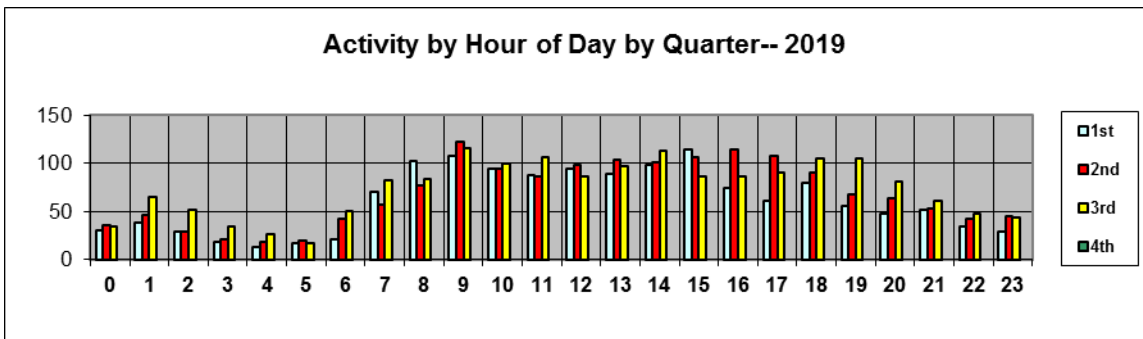
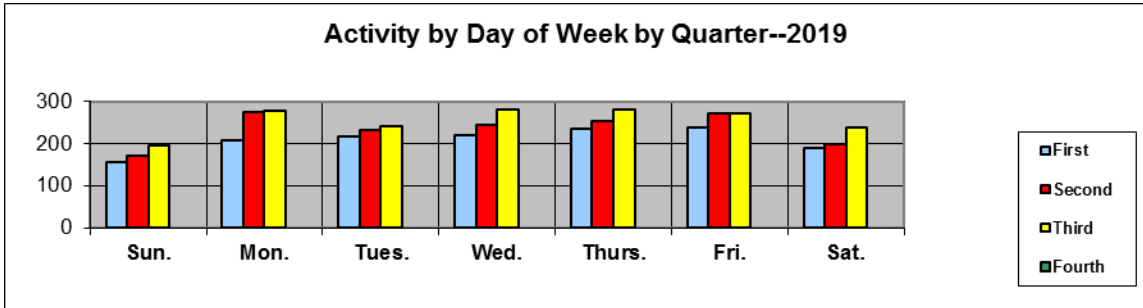
Part II Offenses for 1997 to 2019 by Quarters

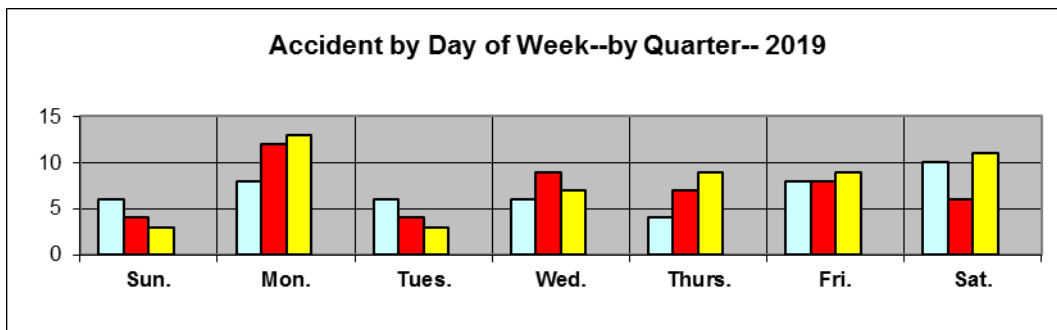

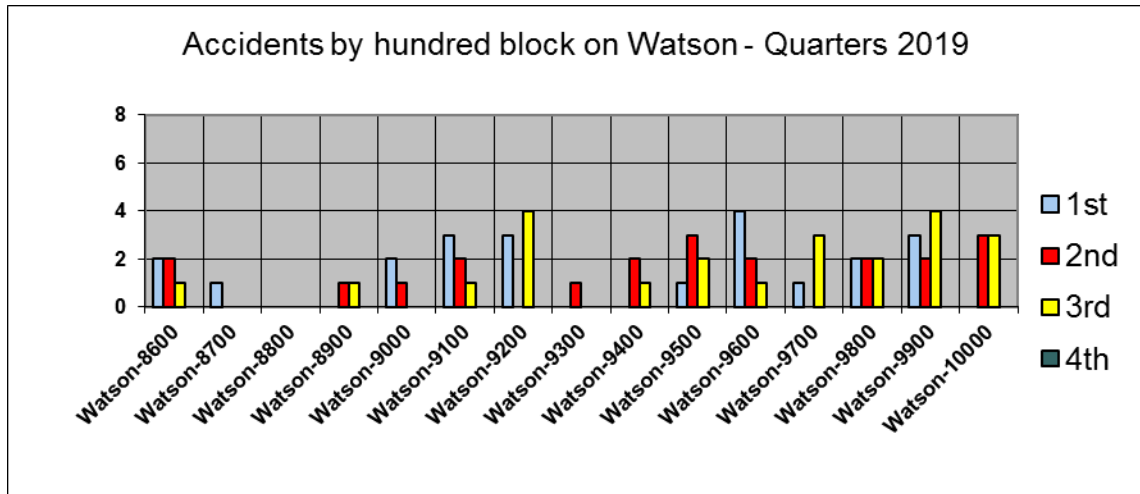
