Subject: November 2019 Public Report

This is the report for the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of November 2019. In November 2019, there were 22 Part I offenses and 406 Part II offenses, for a total of 428. This compares with 9 Part I offenses and 328 Part II offenses for a total of 337 in November 2018.

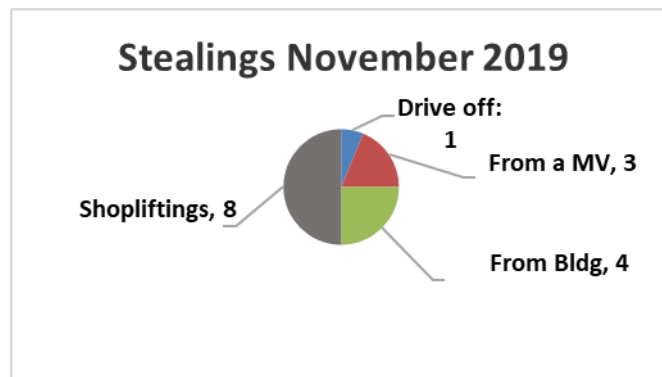
**Burglary:** There were four business burglaries reported where forced entry occurred and property was unlawfully removed.

**Property damage:** There was one property damage report where a mail box was damaged.

**Stolen vehicle:** A male suspect stole a vehicle that was parked at a gas station along Watson Road, the vehicle has been recovered by police.

Stealing offenses numbered sixteen in November 2019.

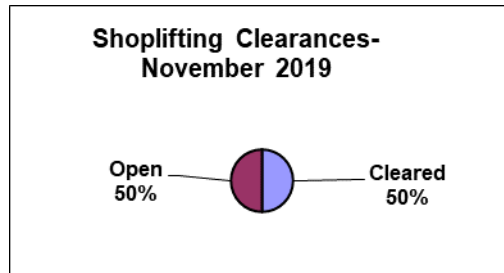

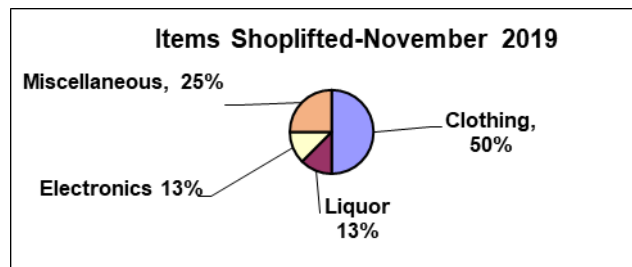

Part I offenses numbered 22 in November 2019.

**Part II offenses:**

In November 2019, there were three assault reports during the month. Arrests were made in all three cases. There were four fraud offenses involving identity theft, forgery and fraud. There were four drug offenses; four arrests were made for possession of a controlled substances. Three of the drug arrests were made after lawful traffic stops. There were twenty-one traffic accidents, three of these accidents involved drivers who left the scene after the crash. There were six animal calls handled by police. There were 95 people related calls and one juvenile call investigated. Police addressed 50 suspicious activities reports. There were 222 miscellaneous police calls handled by the police department.

Part II offenses totaled 406 in November 2019.

### **Ward Incident Summary:**

In Ward One in November 2019, there were 3 stealings that occurred at a grocery store of Watson Road. There was one fraud offense involving forgery of a check, police are still investigating. There was one drug offense made after a traffic stop on Sappington Road. There were six traffic accidents and three animal related calls. There were twenty-four people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered fifteen and occurred on eleven different streets. There were 51 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 104 calls for service in Ward one in November 2019.

In November 2019 in Ward Two, burglaries numbered two and occurred at closed businesses along Watson Road. There were ten stealings at addresses on Watson Road, Big Bend Blvd, Chatwood Terrace, and Westglen Dr. There was one motor vehicle theft offense that occurred at a gas station on Watson Road. An assault occurred when a male assaulted another person who he did not know on a parking lot off of Big Bend Blvd. Victims of forgery offenses had their card cards used by unknown suspects on Big Bend Blvd and Etherton. There were two drug offense arrests made by police subsequent to traffic stops, occupants were found in possession of a controlled substance. There were nine traffic accidents and one animal related call. Thirty-one people related calls were handled as well as one juvenile offense. Suspicious activity calls numbered twenty-two and occurred on ten different streets. There were 74 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 156 calls for service in Ward two in November 2019.

In November 2019 in Ward Three, burglaries numbered two and occurred at closed businesses along Watson Road. There were three stealing offenses that occurred on Watson and Grant Roads. Two subjects were arrested for domestic violence / assaulting another at locations on Glencrest and Royal Arms. There was one drug offense that was discovered after police stopped a man and found drug paraphernalia. There were five traffic accident and twenty-two people related calls handled by police. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on six different streets. There were 56 miscellaneous police service calls.

Police handled 98 calls for service in Ward three in November 2019.

In November 2019 in Ward Four, there was one property damage offense on Garber Road when someone struck a mailbox damaging it. There was one fraud offense that was reported by a resident of Manda Drive involving an unknown suspect stealing their identity and making fraudulent purchases. Police investigated one traffic accident and responded to two animal related calls. There were eighteen people related calls during the period. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on four different streets. There were 41 miscellaneous police service calls.

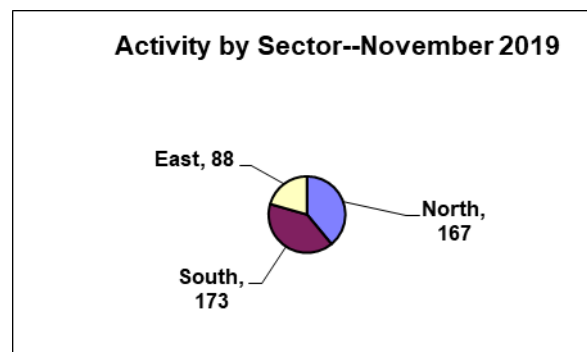
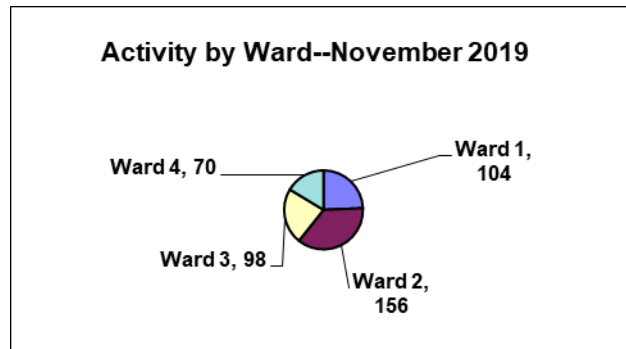
Police handled 70 calls for service in Ward four in November 2019.

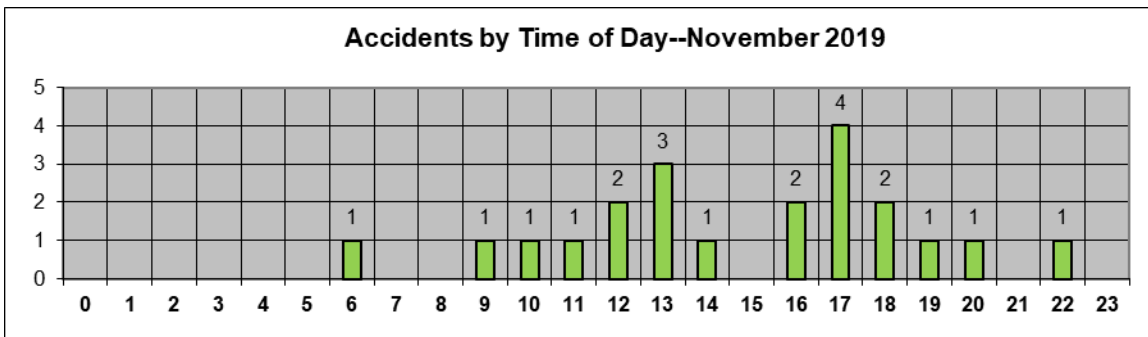

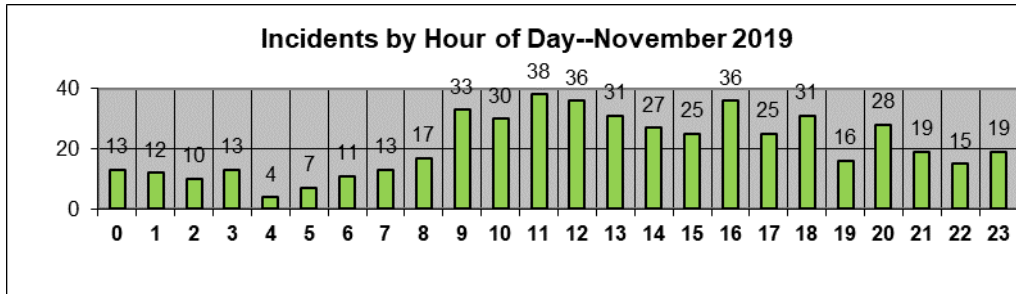
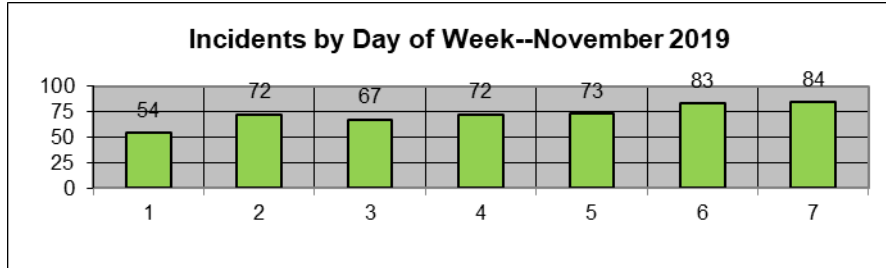
**Arrest Information:**

Twenty-three persons were taken into custody in November 2019. The ethnicity and gender of the persons taken into custody was: One juvenile female was taken into custody during the month.



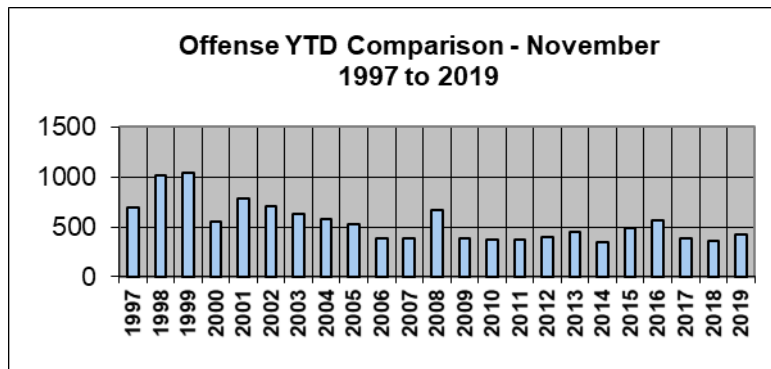

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



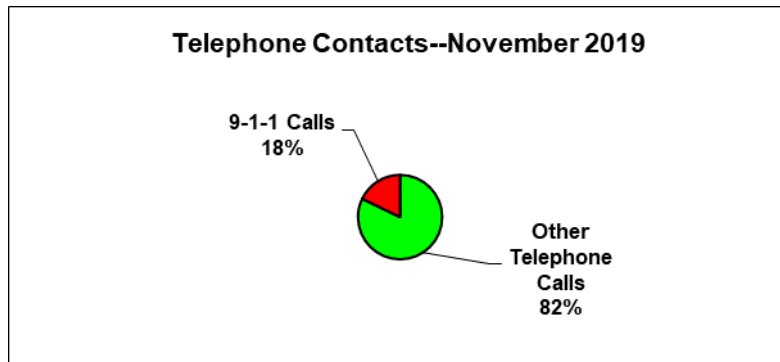
**Offense Comparison:**
